Linda, what do you want?

044 INT. LINDA'S HOTEL ROOM - DAY

Linda is fuming with anger.

LINDA (O.S)

Why did you leave without telling me? And why are you ignoring my calls?

PAT

I didn't know that I was supposed to tell you.

LINDA

Check your emails.

PAT

Check my emails for what? You phoned, why don't you just say what you want to tell me?

LINDA

I've resigned - find yourself another

PAT

You know the company policy. You have signed an employment contract stipulating that you must serve a month's notice - that will begin on the 3rd of January. Send a resignation letter to HR and serve the notice period.

LINDA (O.S)

Notice my foot. You pushed me to do this. You think I don't have feelings?

PAT

If you don't report for duty on the third, I will report you as absconded, and you will forfeit some of your benefits.

LINDA

Are you so hostile that you will punish your baby? I will take you to the CCMA.

PAT

Try me.

(Hangs up)

045 EXT. MZI'S HOME - DAY

Young men return home. There's a big feast to celebrate their return.

NELLY

Isn't that Lutho? (Mzi's son out of
wedlock)

PHINDILE

It's him. Why do you look surprised?

NELLY

Ischithamzi?
(Home wrecker)

PHINDILE

I actually encouraged Mzi to convince his mother to let him go. He has nothing to do with how he was conceived.

NELLY (V.O)

Mzi is lucky.

046 EXT. N1 ROAD - DAY

Mzi and his family are driving back to Cape Town.

KHALIPHA

Dad, I'm going to need R18000 for registration next week.

SANDILE

Oh mine is R12000.

MILLY

Did you find a school for me daddy?

PAT

Yes, Nelly can you please send me a reminder tomorrow to do the efts.

NELLY

Can I ask Mzi to give you more time to reimburse him? Where is all this money going to come from?

PAT

No, I will make a plan.

047 EXT. HOUSE - NIGHT

They arrive in Cape Town. Nelly and children take their luggage out of the boot. Pat remain in the car.

NELLY

Are you not getting inside?

No, I'll miss my flight.

He drives to the airport to catch his flight to Johannesburg.

048 EXT. UNIVERSITY CAMPUS - DAY

I'm sorry babes that came out wrong. This is a temporary arrangement. I'm starving can you please make something to eat.

NELLY

I'm tired, cook for yourself or call fast foods. Milly please pass me the paper.

Milly hands over the newspaper to her mother. She notices an advertisement for a finance manager.

NELLY (V.O) (CONT'D)

I'm applying for this one

"A WEEK LATER"

050 INT. APARTMENT LOUNGE - DAY

Nelly's phone rings, it's Zelda from SARFB, they advertised the position.

NELLY

Hello!

ZELDA

Good day ma'am, you have been short listed for the position of a finance manager. The interviews will be conducted on Monday, and you are required to be here at 10:00 am.

NELLY

Thank you, please text the address.

PAT

Where is Sandile?

Sandile enters - excited.

MILLY

Who?

SANDILE (O.S)

Misha

MILLY (O.S)

You're lying. Does he live in this complex?

Who's making you so crazy?

MILLY

He's an artist daddy.

SANDILE

He now owns a record company. I must find my CD. He wants to listen to my music.

PAT (O.S)

Sandile, you're not doing that rubbish again. You're here to study.

SANDILE

It's called Hip-Hop dad, and you can't tell me what to do. I am a man now.

PAT (O.S)

Get out of my house.

SANDILE (V.O)

You mean this box?

PAT

What was that? Listen here my boy. You can't talk to me like that.

SANDILE

I am not a boy.

NELLY (O.S)

Stop making noise. We've just moved in here and already neighbors are listening to you quarrel. Sandile listen to your father - education comes first. The music industry is full of obstacles. You need to have something to fall back on should things go wrong.

SANDILE

But mom, here you are sitting at home unemployed with your degrees.

NELLY

I have hope my son - have faith.

052 INT. KITCHEN - DAY

"IT'S A MONDAY MORNING"

PAT

Sweetheart I must leave before the traffic congestion.

(Kissing Nelly)

NELLY

Bye honey. Have a good day.

She rushes to the bedroom.

053 INT. BEDROOM - DAY

Nelly quickly dresses-up and leaves for her job interview.

054 INT. LOUNGE - DAY

"A WEEK LATER"

Nelly is watching a soapy. Her phone lying next to her on the couch rings.

NELLY

Hello Zelda

055 INT. ZELDA'S OFFICE - DAY

ZELDA

Good Day Ma'am. I have good news for you. You have been chosen for the job. I will email the appointment letter that you must sign.

NELLY

Thank you so much.

(Tears running down her cheeks)

056 INT.APARTMENT - NIGHT

They're all sitting around the table, enjoying a special meal. Nelly takes out a champagne bottle from the fridge.

SANDILE

What are we celebrating?

NELLY (O.S)

My new job.

Sandile and Milly jumps with joy, congratulating their mother.

PAT

What? Where?

NELLY

We shall be working for the same company from the beginning of next month.

PAT

How? Who offered you a job? Without an interview?

NELLY

I was interviewed last Monday. What is your problem? You seem not to be happy for me.

PAT

Why didn't you tell me? Do you know that I can be accused of nepotism?

NELLY

That's why I didn't tell you. Nobody can accuse you of nepotism when you were not part of the panel. Isn't that what you wanted - me finding a job?

PAT (V.O)

I never asked you to apply for a job at SARFB.

SANDILE (O.S)

Congratulations mom. Let's celebrate.

PAT

Well, congratulations.

MILLY

Congratulations mom.

Pat's phone rings non-stop. Linda is calling. Pat switches it off.

057 INT. LINDA'S BEDROOM - DAY

Linda is still in bed when she calls Pat again.

T.TNDA

You're less than a month in your position, but already hiring your wife. Isn't that nepotism?

PAT

Don't talk nonsense. I didn't even know that Nelly applied for that position. Let me work -bye.

SANDILE (O.S)

No, you can't do that. I've already budgeted.

NELLY

Who said I will give you my money?

SANDILE

What is yours is mine, and what is mine is not yours.

PAT

I must get a house with office space so that you can rather take work home, instead of spending hours with Moyo in the evenings.

NELLY

Are you jealous? I never thought a day would come where you will be threatened by another man.

PAT

You can't blame me. You're looking hot these days.

NELLY

I've always been hot, that's why you asked me to marry you. Don't worry my love. I'm only attracted to you.

PAT

Thank you.

(Kissing his wife)

062 INT. NELLY'S OFFICE - DAY

It's month end, and Nelly is checking accounts payable efts. One of them is the travel agent. On top of the batch is an invoice addressed to her husband, and stamped "paid".

NELLY (V.O)

This is an invoice for our trip to Mauritius.

(Noticing Linda's name)
Oh so he paid for Linda's flight
and accommodation too.

063 INT. APARTMENT LOUNGE - DAY

Nelly enters and finds Pat relaxed in the lounge.

NELLY

Explain this?

(Throwing the envelope to Pat)

PAT

Explain what? What is this?
(Opening the envelope)

Oh I paid for this trip - surely you don't think that I can expect the company to pay for my holidays.

NELLY

I didn't say that, I'm not stupid. What I want to know is why you paid for Linda's flight and accommodation, including massages.

PAT

I asked her to make the bookings. Maybe the travel agent made a mistake. Please don't make this a big deal. I'm sure there will be an explanation for this, let me handle it.

NELLY

It's very funny for you to say that when she pretended to be surprised to see us. I hope my suspicions are wrong for your sake.

064 INT. PAT'S OFFICE - DAY

Pat phones Linda. The phone is ringing.

065 INT. LINDA'S BEDROOM - DAY

Linda is still in bed, covered in duvet, when her phone lying on the bed side is ringing.

LINDA (V.O)

Who's phoning so early?
(Yawning as she answers the call)

PAT (O.S)

How can you book your flights and accommodation to my credit card? What were you thinking? Nelly has seen the invoice.

LINDA (O.S)

You left me with no choice, I was there for you. Why and how was I supposed to pay? Do you want me to tell your wife why you were in Mauritius? You told me not to call you, but you keep calling me. What's your case?

PAT

Do you know though that I can open a fraud case against you? What am I supposed to tell Nelly?

LINDA

You can do that if you want to end your marriage. It's not my problem that you decided to hire your wife.

She hangs up, switches off the phone, and pull the duvet over.

066 INT. NEW HOUSE - DAY

"THREE MONTHS LATER'

Pat bought a new house and Nelly and children are excited. However the excitement is too short as Nelly finds out about Linda's pregnancy on Instagram.

067 INT. BEDROOM - NIGHT

NELLY

Do you know that Linda is pregnant?

PAT

NELLY

Why did she end up in Mauritius? Pretend to be surprised to see us when she's the one who made bookings and erroneously booked her own flight and accommodation - paid by your credit card.

PAT

Where is all this coming from? Next thing you will accuse me of fathering her baby.

NELLY

Of course you are. Are you going to deny that?

PAT (O.S)

Who fed you all this nonsense?

NELLY

You will sleep in the guest room until Linda's baby is born and a DNA proves me wrong or you come clean now - the choice is yours.

(Showing him the door)

PAT

How are you going to explain that to the children?

NELLY

You have the explaining to do, not me.

PAT

Sweetheart, this is me. You can't do this to me.

NELLY

Come clean Pat, tell me the truth.

PAT

Please forgive me sweetheart. I didn't want you to find out about this thing like this, not now.

NELLY

Didn't we agree not to keep secrets from each other?

PAT

Yes baby we did. I promise to keep it like that.

NELLY

What are you planning to do?

PAT

NELLY (O.S)

What? What are you taking me for? A fool I guess.

PAT

Do you want me to neglect my child?

NELLY

I have nothing, and want nothing to do with Linda's child. He/she is not welcome in my house, and will have no relationship with my children.

PAT

Does that mean you forgive me? No divorce nor separation?

NELLY

Did you think that I will divorce you for Linda? No. I have invested in this marriage. I'm not going anywhere.

JOSHUA

Where's your father?

MATHEW

ZACH (his neighbor)

My mother said your father is rich. I think his name is Pat Khumalo or something. I saw him in the news.

Mathew runs home.

070 INT. BATHROOM - NIGHT

Mathew is standing in the shower, thinking about what Zach told him. Water is running. He turns off the shower, steps out, and dries himself. He puts on his pyjamas and gown.

071 INT. DINING ROOM - NIGHT

Mathew and his grandmother are having supper.

MATHEW

Grandma, do you know Pat?

GRANNY

Pat who? What is important about him?

MATHEW

Some rich darkie Zach was telling me about. Argh forget it grandmother. Can I please go and watch a movie in my room?

GRANNY

Yes, but don't stay up until late, we're attending the early morning service tomorrow.

MATHEW

Okay grandma.

(Hugs and kiss her good night)

072 INT. BEDROOM - NIGHT

Mathew enters in his room and shuts the door. He kneels down and prays: "Lord Jesus can you please help me. I want to meet my father. His name is Patrick, Amen." He jumps in bed and covers himself with blankets, and falls asleep.

073 INT. DINING ROOM, SUNDAY - DAY

Mathew prepares the table as his grandmother is almost finished cooking lunch. Grandma dishes the food, and they eat.

074 INT. CINEMA - DAY

Mathew is enjoying the movie. Grandma is fast asleep. She is snoring, and she farts.

MATHEW

Grandma, wake up. You're snoring.

GRANNY

Sorry my boytjie (Little boy)

The movie ends. Mathew helps his grandmother to get up. They walk out of the cinema.

075 EXT. MAIN ROAD - DAY

Mathew and his grandmother are driving back home.

GRANNY

Did you enjoy the movie?

MATHEW

Yes grandma, thank you.

GRANNY

You're welcome babe. Can I stop and get you something to eat or drink before we get home?

MATHEW

No grandma, I'm still full of popcorns. You didn't even eat yours.

GRANNY (O.S)

Did I buy two boxes? And you ate my popcorns?

MATHEW (O.S)

(Laughing)

You were fast asleep, and snoring.

GRANNY

(Also laughing)

No, they were both yours my baby - I'm just glad you enjoyed the movie.

"SIX YEARS LATER"

076 INT. GRANNY'S BEDROOM - NIGHT

Mathew's grandmother suffers from a cardiac failure while in her sleep, and pass on.

077 INT. GRANNY'S BEDROOM - DAY

Mathew enters with a cup of coffee as usual.

MATHEW

(Thinking she's just sleeping)

Good morning grandmother! Here's your coffee.

She doesn't respond. Mathew gets closer, and tries to wake her up. He realize that something is wrong with her, and runs out to call the neighbors.

078 INT. CHURCH - DAY

It's the funeral, Mathew is comforted by relatives and family friends.

079 INT. LOUNGE - DAY

SAM

You must pack all your stuff, you're coming with us. You can't stay alone here.

MATHEW

No Uncle Sam, I like it here. What about school? I'm not leaving grandma's house.

SAM

Mathew you're still young to stay alone. We are not going to debate this - go pack your clothes.

MATHEW

No I'm not, I know how to cook and clean the house - granny taught me. And remember when granny was in hospital, I stayed here, played with my friends during the day, and slept in Zach's house - so I'll do the same thing now. Don't worry, I can take care of myself.

STELLA (Sam's wife) (Not looking forward to have a teenager to look after)

Okay, let's try this for six months, and see how it goes.

MATHEW (O.S)

Yes, thank you Aunty Stella.

SAM

I don't like it, but okay - six
months it is.

"THREE MONTHS LATER"

080 INT. LOUNGE - DAY

Mathew is alone, watching a movie. An estate agent knocks at the door, and he opens.

SUZAN

Hi! I'm Suzan. I'm hired to sell this house. Can I come inside and take pictures?

MATHEW

This house is not for sale. Who sent you?

SUZAN

The owner, Sam is selling it.

MATHEW

This is my grandmother's house.

SUZAN

Did she leave a will?

MATHEW

Yes. I'll find it, come back next week.

081 EXT. HOUSE - DAY

Suzan leaves the property, gets in her car parked opposite the house and leave.

Mathew runs to Zach's house. He knocks at the door, and Zach opens the door.

082 INT. ZACH'S HOUSE - DAY

ZACH

What's wrong? You look like you've just seen a ghost.

MATHEW

How does a will look like?

ZACH

Don't tell me you don't know what a will is, it's an instruction by the deceased on how his or her assets must be divided among his family or friends. But to tell you the truth, I never saw it myself. Apparently you need a Lawyer to write it. Why do you want to know?

MATHEW

Uncle Sam is selling grandmother's house. The agent asked if grandmother left a will.

ZACH

What did you tell her?

MATHEW

I said yes, and told her to come back next week. Grandmother wouldn't like anyone to live in her house but me. She wouldn't want it to be sold either.

Zach's mother, Irene comes out of her room.

IRENE

What is the problem Mathew?

MATHEW

Uncle Sam is selling grandmother's house. Apparently it's only my grandmother's will that can stop him.

IRENE

That's true. You need a lawyer to apply for a court order that will prevent the sale, and investigate whether your grandmother has a will registered with the Registrar of Deeds. MATHEW

084 INT. MATHEW'S BEDROOM - DAY

Mathew packs few of his clothes. He counts the money left from the monthly allowance he receives from his uncle. It's only enough for a bus ticket to Johannesburg.

085 EXT. STREET - DAY

Mathew is waiting for a taxi - carrying his school bag. He stops the taxi to town, and he jumps in. Taxi arrives in town, and he gets off.

086 INT. BUS TICKET OFFICE - DAY

Mathew buys a ticket to Johannesburg. He takes the ticket and gets out.

087 EXT. BUS TICKET OFFICE - DAY

Mathew stands in the que as the bus is already loading. He gets in and take a seat. The bus departs, and arrives in Johannesburg on Monday morning.

088 INT. RECEPTION AT SARFB

Mathew is waiting for Pat. Pat arrives, walking with Nelly.

RECEPTIONIST (O.S)

Good morning Mr & Mrs Khumalo.

Mathew excited to see his father for the first time, but wondering what his reaction would be if he gets up and greet him. He sits anxiously.

Emily (Pat's PA) arrives.

RECEPTIONIST (O.S)

Emily, can you please take Mr Khumalo's visitor with you.

EMILY

Oh alright, come with me. What's your name?

MATHEW

Mathew

They get in the lift.

089 INT. LIFT - DAY

EMILY

You look tired. Where are you coming from?

MATHEW

I arrived this morning from Cape Town.

The lift stops on the fifth floor, and Emily leads Mathew out of the lift to Pat's office. Emily knocks at the door and enters the office, while Mathew is waiting outside.

090 INT. PAT'S OFFICE - DAY

EMILY

Good morning Mr Khumalo. You have a visitor.

РΑТ

Good morning Emily, how are you? Send him in.

EMILY

I'm fine Sir, thank you.

Emily steps out, and Mathew enters and close the door.

MATHEW

Good morning.

PAT

Good morning young man, how may I help you?

MATHEW

I'm your son Mathew. My mother's
name was Linda.

PAT

Where is Linda? She stopped phoning me, and I heard she was pregnant - but thought the baby wasn't mine.

MATHEW

My mom died giving birth to me.

PAT

I'm sorry to hear that. Who raised you? What brought you here?

MATHEW

My grandmother raised me. She also passed away recently, and my uncle is selling the house.

PAT

Can't you live with your uncle? I will support you - you can't live with me. You have to understand that you're born out of wedlock. Your mother knew I was married. I can't introduce you to my family.

MATHEW (O.S)

You're obviously not happy to see me. I didn't come here to stay with you. I can take care of myself. I thought you can help me save my grandmother's house. I need a lawyer.

PAT

Calm down, I can refer you to a friend in Cape Town. They take pro bono cases. Take this money.

Pat reaches for his wallet, takes out a bunch of notes, and hands it over to Mathew.

PAT (CONT'D)

Emily will book a flight to Cape Town for you.

(Calling Emily)

EMILY

Sir

PAT

Let me know how it goes.

Mathew exit to wait for a cab in Emily's office.

091 EXT. LANSERIA AIRPORT - DAY

Mathew boards a flight back to Cape Town.

092 INT. PLANE - DAY

Mathew is in the window seat, reading a magazine.

"TWO HOURS LATER"

PILOT

Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to Cape Town. The time is 16:45, and the temperature is 16 degrees Celsius.

His flight lands in Cape Town.

093 EXT. MATHEW'S HOUSE - DAY

The cab stops, and Mathew gets off. Zach sees him and runs to him.

ZACH

Where have you been? I looked the whole day for you. I also came yesterday, but I thought you were at Sunday school.

MATHEW

I went to Johannesburg.

ZACH

Oh, okay. Did you manage to convince your uncle not to sell the house? Or you're moving to Johannesburg to live with them.

MATHEW

No, my grandmother's house will not be sold. I took your advice and went to meet my father.

ZACH

What happened? Was he excited to see you?

MATHEW

No. That guy wants nothing to do with me. Instead he was concerned about protecting his family from me, like I was a virus. Then he threw me with money, and instructed his PA to book me a flight back to Cape Town.

ZACH

Fuck him. I'm sorry bra, but he's a dick.

MATHEW

Yep, but I'm glad I met him. He said something about pro bono lawyers.

ZACH

Oh, I'm sorry man I also have bad news. The sheriff delivered this letter this morning.

(Handing the document to Mathew)

MATHEW

What? An eviction order? So my uncle is trying to force me to go and live with them in Johannesburg. What about what I want? What about my studies?

MATHEW (O.S)

A journalist interviews Mathew, and take pictures.

095 INT. PAT'S HOUSE - DAY

Pat and his wife are sitting in the lounge, watching the news. The story about a teenage boy facing eviction two months before the examination is broadcasted.

NELLY

Wow! That is sad. Where do they expect the poor child to go? Live on the streets while preparing for examinations?

PAT

That is depressing. Can't we change the channel?

NELLY

No. Why are you so emotional?

PAT (O.S)

Have you forgotten that I also have a son out there?

NELLY (O.S)

Oh you know it's a son, when last did you meet him and his mother?

PAT (O.S)

Actually that is my son. His name is Mathew. Linda died giving birth to him and I only met him recently when he came to seek help with the same problem.

NELLY

So you thought I don't need to know about that. What are you planning to do?

PAT (O.S)

What am I supposed to do? You made it clear that you want nothing to do with him. So don't pretend to care.

NELLY

Of course I don't want him in my house. Find a place for him, you can even go and live with him.

PAT (O.S)

Then shut up.

101 INT. SAM'S OFFICE - DAY

Pat is watching the news. Emily enters with daily newspapers.

EMILY (O.S)

Your nephew's story is in the newspaper. Look "AN ORPHAN PASSED MATRIC WITH DISTINCTION AGAINST ALL ODDS"

PAT

I'm watching the news, thank you.

"TWO YEARS LATER"

102 EXT. BOOKSHOP, WATERFRONT - DAY

Mathew comes out carrying a book he just bought in a plastic bag. He looks at the change as he feels hungry. There's a restaurant opposite the bookshop.

103 INT. RESTAURANT, WATERFRONT

Sandile is having lunch with a friend and Mathew enters and sits in front of them. The waiter hands him a menu.

MATHEW

What is today's special?

WAITER

I'm sorry we have nothing on special today.

SANDILE

Is the rand low?

MATHEW

Yeah, I'm a student bra.

SANDILE

Well, today is your lucky day. Why don't you join us?

He stands up and grabs a chair for Mathew - introducing himself.

By the way I'm Sandile Khumalo.

MATHEW

Mathew Williams here, pleased to meet you. I've seen you on campus although we never spoke.

SANDILE

That's my twin - brother, I dropped out.

(Laughing)

Mathew keeps looking at Sandile, and thinking of the possibility of being brothers, as he looks just like Pat - same thought he had when he saw Khalipha at the campus.

SANDILE

106 EXT. GRAND WEST - NIGHT

107 INT. UCT MAIN HALL - DAY

(Both laughing)

LAUREN (CONT'D)

I came to look for an office space, and it happens to be right next to you.

MATHEW

It's my luck, what are you doing now?

LAUREN

I'm an interior designer.

MATHEW

Wow, perhaps we can share this office - there's enough space.

LAUREN

MH mm, not a bad idea.

MATHEW

No pressure. Go and think about it and give me a call when you made your decision. Or we can discuss it over dinner?

LAUREN

Alright, let me go and check the space next door - I made an appointment.

They exchange business cards, and Lauren exits.

109 INT. LAUREN'S STUDY - DAY

LAUREN (V.O)

110 INT. MATHEW'S BEDROOM - DAY

Mathew just came out of the shower - with a towel wrapped around his bottom. He's picking up a shirt to wear from his wardrobe.

MATHEW

Hey Lauren, I'm sorry I missed your call - I just came out of the shower.

LAUREN

I thought you had second thoughts, and avoiding my calls. I'm taking you up on your offer - if it still stands.

MATHEW

Does that mean we're having dinner tonight?

LAUREN

Sure, where?

MATHEW

At my house, I'll send you the location.

LAUREN

Okay. See you later then.

(Ending the call)

111 EXT. MATHEW'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Lauren parks her car on the drive way. Mathew is standing in the patio smiling — waiting for her to come out of the car. Mathew lose his breath as a gorgeous perfectly built Lauren steps out of the car with a beautiful smile. He gives her a warm hug, and they walk into the house.

112 INT. MATHEW'S HOUSE - NIGHT

He leads her to the dining room, pulls out a chair for her to sit.

MATHEW

Welcome to my house.

LAUREN

Thank you for inviting me.

He goes to the kitchen and brings food. They dig in.

LAUREN (CONT'D)

Hmmm it tastes good. So you can cook.

MATHEW

My grandmother taught me well.

LAUREN

So what are the terms and conditions for sharing the office space?

MATHEW

No visitors - only clients are allowed.

(Smiling)

LAUREN

I can live with that.

MATHEW

I'm joking - there are no conditions at all.

They done eating. Lauren helps Mathew clear the table.

113 EXT. MATHEW'S HOUSE - NIGHT

Mathew gives Lauren a good bye hug. She gets in her car, Mathew watching her as she drives away.

114 INT. MATHEW'S BEDROOM - DAY

Mathew is choosing a tie. He throws it on the bed. He slowly sits on the bed, open the bedside drawer and takes his grandmother's wedding ring, looks at it and cry. He stands up and walks to the other side of the bed, opens the bedside drawer and takes out an old business card. He dials the number.

115 INT. HOSPITAL - DAY

Pat is lying in bed, and the doctor is standing next to him writing notes in his file. The doctor exits. Pat's phone in his bedside drawer rings. He tries to reach out for it, struggles to get up, but doesn't give up. It keeps ringing.

PAT (V.O)

It must be an important call.

He finally manages to grab it.

PAT (CONT'D)

Hello

(Struggling to breath)

116 INT. MATHEW'S BEDROOM - DAY

Mathew still on the line, but quiet - not sure if he's doing the right thing. He ends the call, wears his tie and exit.

117 INT. CHURCH - DAY

Mathew and Lauren are getting married.

REV. SMITH

Lauren, do you take Mathew as your husband, to be faithful to him, honor and cherish him in sickness and in health, adversity and prosperity, forsaking all others as long as you live?

LAUREN

I do.

REV. SMITH

Mathew, do you take Lauren as your wife, to be faithful to her, honor and cherish her in sickness and in health, adversity and prosperity, forsaking all others as long as you live?

MATHEW

I do.

REV. SMITH

Is there anyone who has a reason to believe that we may not proceed with this wedding?

Silence.

REV. SMITH (CONT'D)

You may exchange the rings.

Mathew and Lauren exchange rings.

REV. SMITH

I now pronounce you husband and wife, you may kiss your bride.

They kiss.

118 EXT. CHURCH - DAY

Lauren throws a bouquet. They are driven away to the airport to catch their flight to their honeymoon.

"SIX MONTHS LATER"

119 INT. HOSPITAL - DAY

Lauren has given birth to a baby boy.

MATHEW (V.O)

This is a tough decision, but I'm doing this for you my son.

He takes out his phone and dials Pat's number. The response is "the number you have dialed is incorrect, please check and try again"

MATHEW (V.O)

Maybe he has a new number. Let me try his office number.

He googles SARFB. The first page is about the appointment of a new CEO following the death of the late CEO, Phathisizwe Khumalo, who died six months ago. He looks at his son crying. His wife confused.

LAUREN

What's wrong baby? You are scaring me.

MATHEW

My father died six months ago, and I didn't know. He never cared about me, but it hurts to find out about his death like this - long after his funeral. He denied me a relationship with him, and even denied me to pay my last respect.

LAUREN

(Also crying)

I will make sure that we find his grave, and visit it frequently - you shall have a spiritual relationship with your father.
