KELSEY'S GIRLS

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INT. CHURCH BASEMENT - LATE AFTERNOON

Downstairs in a typical church basement there is a COUNTRY GOSPEL JAMBOREE taking place on a good sized stage. There is a banner that reads "ANNUAL COUNTRY GOSPEL JAMBOREE" across the front of the stage. The crowd is medium size but attentive. DAISY and GLADYS COOPER(both 65+, spinsters) are manning a bakesale table at the back of the hall. They are sneaking deserts and drinking coffee. We take in their self-righteous attitudes right away. GENE PERLEMAN(55ish- bald, short) is onstage in the middle of his song, "I'm Getting Old" with the audience singing the echo lines along with him. He has his ventriloguist dummy, "CHESTER" with him. (Chester is a Mortimer Snerd dummy with the front tooth removed to make him look somewhat normal). The five KELSEY GIRLS (SARAH-17, CHRIS-16, BROOK-14, SAM-12, & ALLY-11) are back stage right, with their housekeeper/nanny TESS (50ish, Scottish, feisty). They are somewhat nervous. She is trying to encourage them. ROBIN KELSEY(40ish, always has a pastor's collar on) is back stage left with the ANNOUNCER(50ish, smart-aleck). Robin is seated on a stool nervously rehearsing the chords he needs to play for the girl's song.

GENE (SINGS)

I'M GETTING OLD

Gene MOTIONS to Chester to repeat the line along with the audience does but his dummy refuses. Gene is getting FRUSTRATED.

AUDIENCE (SINGS) I'M GETTIN' OLD

GENE OR SO I'M TOLD

AUDIENCE

OR SO I'M TOLD

INT. STAGE LEFT

The announcer PEERS out at Gene and Chester as they perform. He talks with Robin.

GENE (V.O.) I GOT PARTS IN ME THAT ONLY WORK PART TIME

ANNOUNCER

That is weird.

Robin peers out at them.

ROBIN

What is?

GENE (V.O.) I AIN'T BEEN SOLD ON GETTIN' OLD

ANNOUNCER Gene and his dummy Chester.

GENE (V.O.) BUT MY BEST BEFORE DATE TELLS ME

ANNOUNCER They have a fight or something?

GENE (V.O.) I AM WAY PAST MY PRIME

ROBIN No one knows. Chester hasn't said a word since Gene's wife took off with the UPS man.

As Gene sings the announcer and Robin exchange a look. Robin grabs his stool and heads further upstage to rehearse his chords.

INT. ONSTAGE WITH GENE AND CHESTER

GENE MY HEARING AIDS GO IN A DRAWER, MY TEETH GO IN A GLASS MY BIFOCALS IN A CASE, AND PREPARATION "H" GOES UP MY-

The audience laughs. The Announcer enters the stage.

ANNOUNCER Whoa, Gene! This is a family show!

The announcer stays on stage to interact with Gene and encourage the crowd.

INT. BACKSTAGE RIGHT

Tess gives the girls a pep talk as Gene performs on stage.

GENE (V.O.)	TESS
I'VE GOT LIVER SPOTS	Alright girls, it's almost
AND VERTIGO AND	time. Wait! Where's Sam?

GENE (V.O.) FEET THAT SMELL LIKE CRAP (sarcastic) EV'RY TIME I PSYCHE MYSELF UP In the bathroom. Where else? HIGH

ALLY

GENE (V.O.) I HAVE TO TAKE A NAP TESS I'll get her. Sarah? Maybe go and see how your father is holding up, okay? (Sarah nods)

INT. ONSTAGE

Gene pretends to fall asleep by snoring loudly.

ANNOUNCER Gene. Gene, wake up!

GENE I'M GETTING OLD (audience repeats) OR SO I'M TOLD (audience repeats)

Off stage right Tess can be seen parking a big metal pot and washcloth on the floor just behind the curtain.

INT. STAGE LEFT

Sarah steps out from behind a black curtain and walks towards her father. As a force of habit she FIDDLES with a necklace she always wears. It is a gold chain with a crucifix and a small key that once belonged to her mother. Robin sees her and shakes his head.

GENE (V.O.) THEY TELL ME ALL MY WORK ON EARTH IS DONE ROBIN This was a bad idea. I can't remember half the dang chords!

GENE (V.O.)	SARAH
I AIN'T BEEN SOLD	You'll do fine. Just pretend
ON GETTIN' OLD	you're giving a sermon.

Sarah KISSES her dad on the cheek and heads back to stage right.

GENE (V.O.) SO I'LL JUST SING MY SONGS AND BE KIND TO EV'RYONE...

Robin nervously walks to the curtain and peers out at the stage. The music fades completely down in a dream like extended moment with Robin:

ROBIN'S P.O.V.

A young man (with a clerical collar) and a beautiful young woman are singing onstage. They are very happy. Just as the young woman turns to look towards Robin (stage left)the two of them vanish and are replaced by Gene and the Announcer. Robin shakes his head in disbelief. GENE (V.O.) THEY WON'T LET ME DRIVE AND THEY WON'T LET ME HAVE A GUN

INT. ONSTAGE

Gene finishes up his song with gusto. The announcer joins him in singing the last line.

GENE SO I'LL JUST SING MY SONGS

GENE/ANNOUNCER AND BE KIND TO EV'RYONE!

The audience applauds with enthusiasm.

ANNOUNCER (V.O.) Gene Perleman! Thank you Gene and uhh...Chester...

Gene exits stage left.

ANNOUNCER

Ladies and gentlemen it's time to introduce you to the pillar of this community. He's the reason we hold this Jamboree every year. Pastor Robin? Why don't you come out here?

There is no movement from stage left.

ANNOUNCER (CONT'D) Gene? A little help, please.

INT. STAGE LEFT

Robin looks at Gene.

ROBIN Touch me and I swear...!

ANNOUNCER (V.O.) He's a little gun shy after ten years.

INT. ONSTAGE

The Announcer is center stage. As he talks he moves to be in position to EXIT stage left.

ANNOUNCER

Well! Please give a warm welcome back to our stage Pastor Robin Kelsey and the Kelsey Girls!

The audience applauds as the five Kelsey Girls ENTER from the right side of the stage. Gene PUSHES Robin onto the stage so he is positioned upstage left of the girls. Robin has his stool and guitar.

ANNOUNCER (CONT'D) Aww now don't they look cute in their little uniforms-

Sam takes one look at the crowd and RUNS to stage right where Tess is waiting with a bucket.

ANNOUNCER (CONT'D) Oops, looks like we lost one.

Sam THROWS UP in the bucket with a big sound effect. The crowd reacts.

ANNOUNCER (CONT'D) Ooo, that is nasty.

Sam throws up again. Tess wipes her mouth with a rag. Sam re-joins her sisters who briefly comfort her as the song intro plays.

ANNOUNCER (CONT'D) And she is back! What a little trooper.

The announcer leaves stage left.

"Okay!"

THE GIRLS (SING) GOD HAD A PERFECT PLAN TO HUMBLE PART OF EVERY MAN THE DAY THAT HE CAME UP LITTLE GIRLS

SARAH: HE GAVE US WEAPONS OF OUR OWN
CHRIS: THAT SORT OF LEAVE US WHEN WE'RE GROWN
GIRLS: AND WE CALL THEM OUR
LITTLE GIRL STRING OF PEARLS
ALLY: WE CAN STAND AND LOOK LIKE THIS
(They strike the innocent pose)
FOR HOURS LONG EACH DAY
(They gather around Robin)
GIRLS: TO CIRCLE 'ROUND A DADDY'S FROWN
AND MAKE HIM SAY

DAD

THE GIRLS (pretending to cry) WE CAN TURN THE WATER ON FROM A SNIFFLE TO A RUSH REDUCE A STRONG DETERMINED MAN TO A BIG OL' PILE OF MUSH

ROBIN pretends to cry uncontrollably.

INT. AT THE BACK OF THE HALL.

Gladys and Daisy shake their heads in disapproval.

THE GIRLS (V.O.) CHRIS, BROOK, ALLY: WE STOMP OUR FEET WHEN WE ARE MAD SAM: A MOTHER'S NO MEANS GO TO DAD CHRIS, BROOK: WE WRAP HIM ROUND OUR FINGERS OH SO TIGHT

EXT. TOWN OF GRACE - CONTINUOUS

As the girls sing establishing shots of the seemingly "perfect" town of Grace are seen. There is no garbage on the streets. There is one pub with a sign on the door that reads "Gone Hunting". SHERIFF TABER(40, small town female sheriff) is writing out a ticket for a car parked in a handicap zone with no permit.

> THE GIRLS (0.S.) SAM: CAUSE BREAD HAS A BUTTERED SIDE SARAH: AND A DAD WILL BURST APART WITH PRIDE GIRLS: WHEN HIS LITTLE GIRL HUGS HIS NECK WITH ALL HER MIGHT

INT. JAMBOREE AUDIENCE

Several teenage boys elbow each other as they watch the girls intently.

THE GIRLS (O.S.) (CONT'D) CHRIS: WE CAN STARE DOWN ANY BOY AND CRUSH HIS LITTLE HEART GIRLS: THEN BUILD HIM RIGHT BACK UP AGAIN BY PRETENDING HE IS SMART

INT. ONSTAGE

Chris is enjoying all the attention, so much so that she misses some of the choreography. Sarah gives her a dirty look.

THE GIRLS SAM: WE SMILE AND TURN HIS FACE ALL RED SARAH, BROOK: AND MAKE HIM WORK ALL WEEK GIRLS: TOTE OUR BOOKS AND DO OUR CHORES FOR A KISS UPON THE CHEEK

INT. JAMBOREE AUDIENCE

The Teen-age boys all CHEER and wave their fists. Gladys and Daisy show up beside the boys with looks that could kill. One boy elbows several of his buddies. He points at the ladies and the boys settle right down.

INT. ONSTAGE

THE GIRLS YEP, GOD MADE LITTLE GIRLS WITH BUTTONS, BOWS AND GOLDEN CURLS FOR DADDY'S TO GO ON AND ON ABOUT OUR LOVE IS LIKE A SUNNY DAY AND WHEN WE DON'T GET OUR WAY WE CURL OUR MAGIC BOTTOM GIRL LIP AND POUT (The GIRLS hum the first two lines of "Jesus Loves Me" in three part harmony)

EXT. OUTSIDE CHURCH - continuous

While the girls perform an establishing shot of "GRACE COMMUNITY CHURCH" is seen as well as the adjoining CEMETERY. In the cemetary is a gravestone that reads "Anne Marie Kelsey".

INT. ONSTAGE

During this last verse the audience is seen from the girls P.O.V. There are many smiling faces.

THE GIRLS YEP GOD HAD A PERFECT PLAN TO HUMBLE PART OF EVERY MAN THE DAY THAT HE CAME UP LITTLE GIRLS SARAH,CHRIS: HE GAVE US WEAPONS OF OUR OWN THAT SORT OF LEAVE US WHEN WE'RE GROWN GIRLS: AND WE CALL THEM OUR LITTLE GIRL STRING OF PEARLS

The girls position Robin center stage for a big finish.

THE GIRLS (CONT'D) YEP, GOD GAVE US OUR LITTLE GIRL STRING OF PEARLS. OH GOD BLESS OUR LITTLE GIRL STRING OF PEARLS!

ANNOUNCER Let's hear it for the Kelsey Girls!

APPLAUSE. The teenage boys JUMP to their feet. The girls bow. Chris steps forward for an extra BOW as the boys cheer louder. Brook pulls her back and they all exit stage right. ANNOUNCER (CONT'D) I just know your momma is watching from heaven and she's mighty proud.

Robin gives the announcer a dirty look then leaves stage left.

ANNOUNCER (CONT'D) Sorry Robin. Folks, before we send you home the ushers are gonna take up the love offering-

INT. STAGE RIGHT

Gladys, Daisy and WILMA FARMER(60+, big lady) are holding flags, ready for their entrance.

ANNOUNCER (O.S.) -and as they do here's Gladys, Daisy and Wilma Farmer with their salute to the greatest hymns of all time! (aside) May God have mercy on us all.

A big orchestral background CD plays an intro for the medley. Gladys, Daisy and Wilma march onto the stage carrying flags that say "Grace Community Church". They do elaborate flag waving and movement as they belt out snippets of big hymns.

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. CHURCH STAGE -- LATER THAT EVENING

A Few volunteers are CLEANING up after the concert. Tess walks out from a side door. She is carrying several offering baskets and an old travel suitcase. She sorts through the meagre offering, TOSSING black identical buttons into one of the baskets. Robin sits down and sees the buttons.

> ROBIN Oh this is encouraging. What am I supposed to do with... five buttons?

TESS Maybe they were getting ready to throw in the shirt off their back.

ROBIN Then they should have kept the buttons on the shirt. I could have worn it. Alright, Tess... Give me the news. What's the count?

TESS Ooo... wait for it... sixty four dollars, eighty seven cents and-

TESS/ROBIN

Five buttons.

ROBIN (smiles with pain) Oy! Minus the cost of the shirts you made... And my girls get nothing new to wear to school.

TESS We'll make due. Your wife left plenty of clothes to pass down to them even if most of them were handed down to her.

Tess takes a fairly full button jar out of the suitcase and TOSSES in the 5 buttons one at a time.

ROBIN Yeah... well good thing you were there to stop me from throwing out everything she owned!

TESS

Robin-

ROBIN Sorry, I know, I know. That was a long time ago.

TESS Than why does that sore spot rear its-

ROBIN Look, Teresa. I'm tired. Let's not do this, okay?

TESS Fine. I won't say another thing.

Tess STACKS the baskets and bangs the button jar back into the suitcase then slams the lid hard. She starts FOLDING CHAIRS with as much noise as possible while Robin closes his eyes and leans back in his chair.

ROBIN Pretty loud for someone who isn't talking right now.

TESS I'm curious. Do you even know how long it's been?

ROBIN

I don't care.

TESS

Ten years!

ROBIN

I said-

TESS Did you hear me?! Ten years! I'm tired too you know. When are you gonna forgive that dead wife of yours and find a new mother for those girls?

ROBIN

I have forgiven her. I've just never forgotten what she did.

TESS (partial aside) Ooo, the gospel according to Robin Kelsey.

ROBIN

I heard that.

TESS Well good! Cause I hate mincing words! Robin, it's time you-

ROBIN It's time for me to teach a bible study. A men's bible study. Take the girls home. Please.

Robin exits. Tess finishes cleaning up as she sings.

TESS (SING) I'D LIKE TO CROWN HIM WITH MANY CROWNS THAT MAN UPON HIS THROWN HARK HOW THAT HEAVENLY "FATHER' DROWNS ALL MUSIC BUT HIS OWN.

Tess gathers all her stuff and attempts to walk out. She keeps on dropping items as she sings.

TESS (CONT'D) AWAKE MY SOUL AND SCREAM FOR HE WHO IS SO STUBBORN AND KEEP ME LORD FROM COMMITTING THE SIN I SHALL NOT KILL FOR THEE!! EXT. THE ROAD JUST BEFORE THE KELSEY RANCH -- LATER

Tess is DRIVING the girls home in an old beaten up minivan.

BROOKLYN Ugg, what is that smell?

SAMANTHA

Wasn't me.

SARAH

Me neither.

ALLY

Chris!

CHRISTINE

No way!

ALLY

Way!

TESS Girls! It was the van. This fine piece of machinery passes more gas then herd of dairy cows.

CHRISTINE Or the boys basketball team.

There is a stunned silence. They all laugh.

INT. CHURCH SUNDAY SCHOOL ROOM - CONTINUOUS

Robin is READING his bible to a room with several men. They are listening to him at various levels of attention. One man ELBOWS an older one, waking him up in the process. Robin pretends he doesn't see this. Gene comes in late. He sits Chester on a small chair facing the corner with his face to the wall like he's being punished.

> ROBIN Mark 12 verse 25 "When the dead rise, they will neither marry nor be given in marriage. They will be like the angels-CHURCH MEMBER 1

Wait. You're saying, (pointing up) up there I won't be married to Phyllis? ROBIN

That's right.

CHURCH MEMBER 1 (aside) No wonder they call it heaven.

Several men stifle their laughter. One of the guys hits Carl on the arm playfully.

ROBIN Gentlemen... Now... let's turn to Proverbs 21 verse 19 - "Better to live in the <u>desert</u> than with a quarrelsome, ill-tempered wife...

CHURCH MEMBER 2 How far to the nearest desert?

The men laugh.

GENE That's not funny.

Gene wipes his eyes with a hanky.

CHURCH MEMBER 2 Aww cheer up Gene, you still have Chester!

They all laugh at Gene's expense.

INT. KELSEY HOME OLDER GIRL'S BEDROOM - LATER

The Girls enter the oldest girls bedroom. They are arguing.

CHRISTINE We should have sang more then one song.

BROOK But we only know one song...

SARAH That isn't in the hymn book.

CHRISTINE That's my point.

SARAH

Uhh...

CHRISTINE

We need to do the songs that momma wrote. I still hear folks talk about her.

BROOKLYN You mean behind Papa's back.

SARAH Chris, you and I both know what he would say.

BROOKLYN Hey! Maybe he's forgotten the songs she used to sing.

SARAH Uhh, Brook? If Papa doesn't remember them they're gone for good. Who do you think played for her?

Brook goes to make a comment than realizes she's right.

ALLY I say we write some new songs... of our own.

SAMANTHA

Yeah!

SARAH

Yeah right.

CHRISTINE Hey, if mom could write music maybe it's in our blood.

SARAH Hmm. You never know.

BROOKLYN My first song would be about horses.

CHRISTINE I'd write a song about love.

SARAH You mean a song about boys.

CHRISTINE

Same thing.

BROOKLYN

Hey Sam, what would you write a song about?

ALLY Sam? Write a song? There's a joke.

SARAH

Ally!

ALLY

Sorry! If she wrote one it would have to be one about not puking her guts out every time she has to sing in front of people.

SARAH

Allyssa Anne Kelsey, you apologize!

ALLY For what? It's true!

SAMANTHA

If you <u>must</u> know, Ally Cat, I hear songs is my head all the time.

ALLY

Yeah, right.

BROOKLYN

So what would you write a song about, right now?

SAMANTHA

That's easy. It would a song about the clothes we get to wear on the first day of school!

CHRISTINE

You mean-

THE GIRLS

Hand me downs!

The girls all plunk themselves on Sarah's bed as they sing. They act out this song with all manor of melodramatic flare.

GIRLS (SING) WHEN GOD MADE EVE SOME CLOTHES TO WEAR WHAT MADE ADAM STOP AND STARE? DID EVERYTHING FIT HER JUST RIGHT? NOT TOO LOOSE, AND NOT TOO TIGHT WHEN ADAM TOOK HER INTO TOWN WE'RE BETTIN' NO ONE EVER SAW HER IN A HAND ME DOWN!

The girls rush to the foot of Sarah's bed to an OLD TRUNK containing hand me downs owned by their mother. They open the trunk and begin tossing clothing everywhere. They find the clothing pieces that each of them sing about. SARAH: HAND ME DOWN THOSE FADED BLUE JEANS
SAM: AND THAT LEATHER MINI SKIRT
BROOK: IS THAT A RHINESTONE JESUS ON THAT POLYESTER SHIRT?
CHRIS: HAND ME DOWN THOSE KNEE HIGHS
AND THAT VELVET HALTER TOP

THE GIRLS

ALLY: AND THAT VELVET HALTER TOP SAM: ALL THOSE ONE PIECE SWIMSUITS GIRLS: WILL THIS NIGHTMARE EVER STOP?

SARAH: HAND ME DOWN THOSE SEXY BLOOMERS
SAM: THEY'RE SO VERY VERSATILE
BROOK: ALONG WITH PINAFORES AND CORSETS,
BROOK,ALLY: THEY MIGHT COME BACK IN STYLE

CHRIS: HAND ME DOWN THAT LIME GREEN PANT SUIT SARAH: AND THAT 80'S EVENING GOWN GIRLS: WE ENVY EVE OUR SISTER CAUSE SHE NEVER EVER WORE A SINGLE HAND ME DOWN!

Ally pulls out a DRESS from the girl's closet. She holds it up to her neck while STANDING on Sarah's bed. As the girls sing they use this dress as a prop.

> THE GIRLS (CONT'D) TAKE THIS ONE OUR MOTHER WORE SHE BOUGHT IT FROM A "DISCOUNT" STORE WE LET IT OUT, WE TOOK IT IN, RAISED THE HEM, WAS THAT A SIN?

Ally pretends to float away with the dress as the girls wave goodbye to her.

THE GIRLS (CONT'D) SAY HELLO TO YOU MY FADED DREAM AND GOODBYE AND FAREWELL TO ANY SELF ESTEEM

Tess enters the room. The girls use her as a seamstress dummy by holding various hand me downs up to her.

SARAH: HAND ME DOWN THOSE WOOLEN SWEATERS EVERY GRAMMA USED TO KNIT CHRIS: FORGET ABOUT YOUR FIGURE THAT'S HOW THEY'RE SUPPOSED TO FIT

SARAH: HAND ME DOWN THOSE PURPLE HOT PANTS BROOK: AND THAT TYE-DYED PEASANT DRESS SAM: GOTTA LOVE OUTDATED FASHION GIRLS: WHEN DRESSIN' FOR SUCCESS.

Tess walks around the room, attempting to catch every piece of clothing as the girls toss them in the air.

SARAH: HAND ME DOWN THAT LOVELY MUUMUU WITH THAT CHANTILLY LACE
BROOK: PLEASE PULL IT UP AND OVER TO COVER UP MY FACE
CHRIS: HAND ME DOWN THOSE PLAID BELL BOTTOMS
GIRLS: I'LL DREAM OF CALVIN KLEIN

ALLY

If you think you've got it bad (sings)TRY BEING LAST IN LINE

THE GIRLS BROOK: HAND ME DOWN THOSE DAISY DUKE SHORTS CHRIS: ALL THE BOYS WILL STOP AND WAVE SARAH: AS WE SEND OUR FATHER GIRLS: TO AN EARLY GRAVE

The girls pile Tess with tons of clothes. The pile grows high enough to cover her face.

THE GIRLS (CONT'D) YEP, IT'S COVERALLS AND JUMP SUITS AND LOOKING LIKE A CLOWN THERE'LL BE A WAR IN HEAVEN IF WE GET UP THERE AND ALL THEY HAVE ARE HAND ME...

FATHER NO MORE HAND ME DOWNS PLEASE OH LORD NO HAND ME DOWNS NO FROWNS, NO CRAZY, WINKIN' BLINKIN' STINKIN' HAND ME DOWNS!

On the very last note the girls all COLLAPSE on Sarah's bed. Tess is so overloaded with clothes she tosses them all on top of the girls, completely burying them in the process.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES - NEXT DAY

Brook is SITTING on the fence staring at the stables. Sarah and Chris walk up to her. Brook points at the stables as they talk but Sarah SHAKES her head with a definitive "no" and walks away. Brook looks at Chris for support. After some thought Chris decides to side with Sarah. She walks away from Brook as well. Brook stands and studies the building for a moment then heads for the house.

INT. KELSEY HOME HALLWAY - LATER

The Kelsey main floor hallway has pictures hanging on the walls that don't seem to match the weathered spaces that were left by previous pictures. In a family photo the name "Anne Kelsey" has an obvious black line through it and her face has been torn out of the picture. Tess is stirring a pot on the stove while she sings to herself.

TESS I'M A SOFT SPOKEN LASS WITH NOTHIN' TO BOAST WHO LOST HER POOR MAN WHEN HE GAVE UP THE GHOST

She hears a dog barking. She looks out the window and from her P.O.V. She sees Robin pulling up to the house in his car. She calls the girls for supper.

TESS (CONT'D) Girls! Suppertime!!

INT. KELSEY HOME HALLWAY

The girls come piling down the stairs. Everyone HEADS for the dining-room.

INT. KELSEY HOME DINING-ROOM

From a dining-room P.O.V. Robin is seen hanging up his coat on a set of hooks on the wall. He walks into the dining-room and sees the girls all seated. He sits down at the head of the table.

ROBIN You know the drill.

They all bow their heads.

ROBIN (CONT'D) Heavenly Father, bless this food to our bodies, that we may be made strong for Your work and for Your service. Amen.

GIRLS

Amen.

The Girls start PASSING around bowls of food without talking. Robin notices this almost right away.

ROBIN Seems kind of quiet in here tonight.

They girls exchange glances.

ROBIN (CONT'D) I trust everyone had a good day?

No reaction.

ROBIN (CONT'D) Fall colors are really starting to show...

The girls study their food.

ROBIN (CONT'D) Yep... So much for summer... G'bye summer... Hel..lo...fall... Oh... Ummm... after careful thought I've decided to have an operation... to become a woman. (bows his head)

The girls can't help but react. Ally laughs out loud.

ROBIN (CONT'D) Thank you Ally. I knew I wasn't dining alone.

Sarah gives Ally a stern look to keep quiet. Tess walks in with a jug and pours everyone a glass of juice.

ROBIN (CONT'D) Still, pretty quiet in here tonight. Not that I'm complaining.

The girls all look at each other nervously.

TESS Sam, would you please pass me your cup?

Sam passes Tess her glass.

TESS (CONT'D)

Thank you.

Tess clears her throat at Brook who has worn her BASEBALL CAP to the dinner table. Brook reluctantly GIVES UP the cap. Tess whacks her once on the head and walks back into the kitchen, donning the cap as she does. More silence.

> ROBIN Oh, I see... This is going to be one of those meals where we silently contemplate the blessings of God in our lives.

ALLY (throaty laugh in disgust) Yeah, right.

SARAH

Ally!

AT T.Y What? ROBIN Allyssa? Is there something you'd like to discuss at the dinner table? ALLY (standing) Yes! Sarah pulls Ally back down to her chair. SARAH No! ROBIN No? (the girls all look sheepish) Alright. Let's hear it. AllY starts to speak but Sarah puts her hand over her mouth. ROBIN (CONT'D) Sarah, let her speak. SARAH You sure about this? ROBIN Sarah. SARAH Okay... but I warned you. Sarah takes her hand off of Ally's mouth. Ally stands up. ALLY Papa! School starts next week and we want new clothes! ROBIN I see. Anyone else? Brook slowly raises her hand up high. ROBIN (CONT'D) (surprised) Brooklyn? CHRISTINE (partially under her breath) I wouldn't if I were you, girl.

Let her speak.

Ally gets frustrated waiting for Brook.

ALLY (standing up) Brooklyn wants us to-

ROBIN Ally?! Will you let your sister speak for herself?

Ally reluctantly sits back down in her chair.

CHRISTINE Only if you stuff a sock in her mouth.

ROBIN

Chris!

CHRISTINE

Sorry, Ally, (aside) I meant a pair of socks.

Sam puts up her hand and speaks.

SAMANTHA Uhhh, I'm okay with last years clothes.

CHRISTINE Me too... for the record.

ALLY

You liars!

ROBIN

Ally! Brooklyn? I believe you had something you wanted to say?

BROOKLYN

(startled)
Me?... Oh...uhh...right!...Uhhh
 (starts to hyperventilate)
I... umm... move... that we... take
the locks off the stables and bring in
horses to board... to help... with the
family... budget.

There is a stunned silence. Brook gets nervous and PUTS her hands over her head for protection from her sisters. They glare at her. I see.

Robin bangs his cutlery down on his plate. He gets up and LEAVES the room. Chris watches for his exit then whacks Brook across the back of the head.

CHRISTINE Aw, nice going Brook!

BROOKLYN

Oww!

Ally whacks Chris in the same way.

ALLY Yeah, nice going Brook!

CHRISTINE

Oww!

SARAH Look who's talking!

INT. KELSEY HOME HALLWAY

Robin is leaning on the wall with his HEAD BOWED as he hears the girls arguing.

ALLY (O.S.) Hey! I just said what everyone else was too chicken to say!

CHRISTINE (O.S.) Oh yeah? Well Sarah should'a kept your big mouth shut!

BROOKLYN (O.S.) Fat chance of that.

The Girls continue arguing. They don't see Robin come back in the room. He shakes his head at what his girls have been forced to deal with. He WIPES his eyes. Sarah sees him first and tries to quiet everyone down.

SARAH Girls... GIRLS!

They continue arguing. Ally picks up the cue from Sarah and gives a LOUD HORSE WHISTLE.

SAMANTHA Oww. I hate it when you do that! ALLY

Sorry.

Robin leans over Brook using the back of her chair.

ROBIN

Brooklyn?

BROOKLYN

Yes, Papa?

ROBIN

I take it you are aware of some horses that need a place to board?

BROOKLYN

Yes, Papa.

ROBIN And these are horses you know?

BROOKLYN

Yes, Papa.

ROBIN Horses you've ridden?

BROOKLYN Yes, Papa, I mean, no! Aww, crap!

ALLY Ooo, somebody's in trouble.

SARAH

Ally, shush!

ROBIN

Well, than Miss Brooklyn Leah Kelsey? Tomorrow morning you get to see how much elbow grease it will take to muck out stalls that haven't been cleaned in over ten years!

BROOKLYN (aside, but thrilled) Yes!!

ALLY (clueless) Told ya. Trouble.

Christine slowly puts her hand up.

I... uhh... might be as guilty as Brook.

ROBIN (imitating Chris) You...uhh... might be as guilty as Brook?

CHRISTINE

Yeah.

ROBIN

Same horses?

CHRISTINE

Yep.

ALLY Same horses my butt! She's talking about the same cowb-

Chris panics and elbows Ally. Robin tries not to think about what he may have missed. He rolls his eyes.

ALLY (CONT'D)

Oww!

ROBIN Alright! The two of you will organize the rest of these volunteers to help.

SAMANTHA

Wait a minute.

ALLY What volunteers?

BROOKLYN

Woohoo! Ladies!? We got poop to scoop and stables to get ready!!! (chanting) We're gonna board some horses. Gonna ride some horses, riding six wide horses. WOOHOO!!! Hi-O Silver, Away!

The WILLIAM TELL OVERTURE plays as we see Brook race out of the room all excited. She comes back into the dining-room pretending to ride a horse by using her hands to make the hoof noises against her legs.

BROOKLYN (CONT'D) Come on ladies! Giddy up, Giddy up GIDDY UP! The girls reluctantly rise up with the look of "too much work is coming" on their faces. One by one they half heartedly thank Robin. Brook grabs her father by the neck and almost strangles him with joy.

BROOKLYN (CONT'D) Thank you Daddy! Thank you, thank you, thank you, thank you, thank you!!!

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. THE KELSEY LIVING ROOM - LATER THAT EVENING

Robin is trying to read his bible but having great trouble. He is MUMBLING incoherent words. Tess enters and plunks herself down on the couch. She grabs a magazine to thumb through.

TESS The girls are all in bed. Do you know how hard it was to get Brook calmed down enough so the rest of them could finally close their eyes?

ROBIN I can believe it.

TESS And how is Robin doing?

ROBIN

Well... I have attempted to read this
one page... Oh...
 (seeing he has his bible upside
 down, he turns it around)
nearly a dozen times.

TESS Been there, done that, bought the Tshirt.

ROBIN (slams the bible shut)

Tess, I've broken one of my most sacred rules.

TESS

When?

ROBIN

Today.

TESS Aww, and I missed it?! Funny. TESS No really. Which red letter "sacred" rule did you break? I'd like to put it in my diary. ROBIN Would you mind?! TESS Sorry. ROBIN If you really want to know... it's something I've tried very hard to teach the girls. TESS

That being...?

ROBIN

The Tummy test.

TESS

The what?

ROBIN

The tummy test. The knot in my gut. The feeling that opening up those stables is the worst decision I have ever made!

TESS

Are you serious?

ROBIN Yes! Any advice?

TESS Oh, you want my advice?

ROBIN

Not really. But right now you're all I got.

TESS Gee, I feel so special.

ROBIN You know what I mean.

ROBIN

TESS

Robin, I have been with this family ever since my husband died. To be honest you'll have to pardon me if I'm beside myself - twice! I can't remember the last time I actually witnessed a measurable "crack" in that mighty exterior known as Robin Kelsey.

ROBIN

That's not fair and you know it ...

TESS

Hey, don't get me wrong. Your faith, your strength, your passion? Like a rock and everyone knows it. Always been there, and always will be.

ROBIN

Then why does your flattering character reference feel like a slap across the face?

TESS (Casual about it) Oh, you picked up on that.

ROBIN

Like a fifty pound bag of horse manure.

TESS

Oww!

ROBIN Sorry. How about bagpipes filled with haggis and golf balls?

TESS

Ay! Robin, the truth is? Giving advice to you is a bit above my pay grade.

ROBIN

I suppose. Oh...uhh...speaking of pay... You saw what the Jamboree brought in...

TESS

(acting out)
Aww, don't give it another thought.
I'll have my reward...

Tess sings melodramatically around him.

ROBTN "IN THE SWEET BY AND BY" Oh, dear Lord, she's going to sing.

TESS (CONT'D)

TESS (CONT'D) But I am keeping track of the wages you owe me.

ROBIN TESS (CONT'D) "WE WILL MEET ON THAT And she continues to sing. BEAUTIFUL SHORE"

> TESS (CONT'D) You wanna know how much?

> > ROBIN

No.

TESS Didn't think so. "IN THE SWEET BY AND BY WE WITL-

Robin leaves as her back is turned.

TESS (CONT'D) MEET ON THAT... BEAUTIFUL SHORE"...

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES - LATER THAT EVENING

Robin is sitting at an outdoor picnic table opposite the stables. He stares intensely at the double doors and the big chain and lock that keeps them securely shut. He falls asleep. In a DREAM LIKE STATE the lock falls off and the big doors swing open. An old family car speeds out of the stables. ANNE KELSEY(27ish, beautiful) is driving. In the passenger seat is COLIN PEARSONS (32ish, handsome, horse trainer). Robin is confused as he WAVES for them to stop. The car heads down the Kelsey driveway, swerving as it does. In a very determined effort Robin RUNS down the driveway after the car.

DISSOLVE TO:

EXT. OMAR ROAD BEND

Robin runs uphill to a sharp bend in OMAR road which overlooks a canyon lake. He comes to a POLICE road block. Red and blue lights are SPINNING at the scene of an accident. Robin attemps to JUMP over the roadblock. He comes crashing down on his back.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES

Robin is startled awake. He feels his back for pain that has long since healed itself. He gets up and walks to the corral fence. He attemts to hoist himself up to sit on the top of the fence but

slips and lands on his butt. He looks around to make sure no one saw him and carefully climbs up and sits on top of the fence.

INT. KELSEY HOME UPSTAIRS HALLWAY - LATER THAT EVENING

Chris Kelsey SNEAKS across the upstairs hallway and looks through the big window with a pair of BINOCULARS. She sets a candle down of the window ledge. Through her P.O.V. Robin is seen sitting on the fence across from the stable doors. She signals her sisters to join her.

CHRISTINE

Psst!

The four girls TIP-TOE down the hallway and join Chris. They each have candles. All the girls are dressed in granny nightgowns. Chris hands the binoculars to Sarah, who looks out at Robin.

> SARAH Yep, he's down there alright. ALLY What's he doing? SARAH Just sitting there, staring. SAMANTHA At what? SARAH The stables I quess. BROOKLYN Is that a good sign or a bad sign? SARAH I don't know. Wait, wait! He's on the move. CHRISTINE About time. SARAH He's in front of the big stable doors. ROOKLYN Go Papa, go! SARAH He's lifting up the big lock, pulling ever so slightly on the chains ...

AND... he's walking away.

THE GIRLS

Aww..

BROOKLYN Please don't tell me he changed his mind!

SARAH No... I don't think so... Wait! Okay, he's back.

BROOKLYN

Thank God.

SAMANTHA What's he doing now?

SARAH Whoa. He just kicked one of the doors.

CHRISTINE

With what?

Sam BOPS Chris on the top of her head.

SAMANTHA

His head.

CHRISTINE Sorry. Dumb question.

From Sarah's P.O.V. ROBIN is seen, hoping on one foot.

SARAH And now he's hopping on one foot... in great pain.

ALLY

Let me see!

Ally grabs the binoculars and pushes Sarah aside. She holds the binoculars close to her eyes and ends up looking at the wrong spot.

ALLY (CONT'D) I don't see him.

Sam moves Ally's head so she is looking at the same spot that Sarah was.

ALLY (CONT'D) Oh wait. There he is. Hey... he's on the ground.

SARAH

Ouch.

BROOKLYN Bet he slipped on the wet grass.

ALLY Now he's standing back up... Making sure no one saw him fall down. Brushing off his pants... This is kinda funny.

Chris takes the binoculars from Ally and PUSHES her aside.

CHRISTINE My turn. Looking... Ah! Okay... Papa is... he's pacing... back and forth.

SARAH

What for?

CHRISTINE

Who knows?

BROOKLYN Do all men act like this?

CHRISTINE

I sure hope not. Wait! He's holding the lock once again. He's staring... staring... And he bangs it hard against the door and walks away! (the girls all groan)

BROOKLYN

So close.

CHRISTINE Should we go help him?

SARAH

Not a chance. Whatever he's battling, he's gotta do this on his own.

ALLY

I bet he just lost the key for the lock.

Brook takes the binoculars in disgust.

BROOKLYN

Maybe. My turn. Okay girls... we've got serious movement. He is marching up to the door like a man on a mission. He appears to be talking to (MORE) BROOKLYN (CONT'D) himself, nope scratch that. He is making gestures towards the All Mighty. Looks like he's trying to strike up a bargain of some sort. Whoa, whoa, whoa! He's taking out a key... (the girls are excited) And he drops it!

THE GIRLS

Aww...

BROOKLYN He's fumbling for it. Searching... searching... He has it in his hand!? Yes! He is on his feet... wait...wait... Back up the truck! He has unlocked the door!!!! Ladies? The Kelsey stables are open for business!!

THE GIRLS Yay! Woohoo (ad lib) The GIRLS high five each other.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES

Robin looks up and sees the dancing lights in the window. He half smiles, sighs, and limps towards the house.

INT. THE KELSEY STABLES -- NEXT MORNING

Chris is reading a novel with one hand as she half-heartedly SWEEPS with the other. Brook Is working hard to get the stables ready. Sam and Ally are sweeping away cobwebs. Tess walks in and is hit by the smell.

> TESS Whoa!... holy horse crap! There's a blast from the past.

CHRISTINE Should have been here earlier.

TESS No thank you. You know girls, your mother loved these stables more than you can possibly imagine.

BROOKLYN Who wouldn't? Nothing better than the smell of a barn and horsesCHRISTINE

And Cowboys!

ALLY You mean, like Toby Jackson!!

CHRISTINE Shut up you little snake!

ALLY

(teasing) Toby and Christine going for a ride Hoping he'll take her for his bride.

Chris picks up a bucket of WATER to throw on Ally, who takes a defensive stance with her mop. Tess intervenes.

TESS Whoa, easy there girls, one mountain at a time here.

Sarah comes in CARRYING an old wooden box.

TESS (CONT'D) Ooo, what'd you find, Sarah?

SARAH No idea. Probably some old tack.

BROOKLYN

Let me see.

BROOK takes the box.

BROOKLYN (CONT'D) Nope. Too light.

She hands it back to SARAH.

TESS Well, breakfast is ready.

SAMANTHA Good I'm starving!

TESS Sarah, you coming?

SARAH I'll be right there.

They all exit the stables.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES

TESS Ay, what a glorious day!

Ally sneaks up behind Chris and PUTS A FROG down her shirt, then heads towards the house. Chris has a fit and starts RUNNING, waving her hands. Brook RUNS after Chris to try and help. Sam and Tess look at each other and shake their heads.

INT. KELSEY HOME KITCHEN - MOMENTS LATER

ALLY enters before everyone else and immediately begins READING the bible that is always sitting on the kitchen table. Robin looks up from his paper. Ally smiles innocently. He is proud of her.

INT. THE STABLES -- CONTINUOUS

SARAH has the box on the floor. She tugs on a small lock that keeps the box shut. She contemplates using a hammer sitting on a shelf. A force of habit makes her tug at her mother's necklace. Besides a crucifix there is a small key she has never paid much attention to. Curious, she takes the necklace off and tries the key. She can't believe it but it OPENS the lock which she carefully removes. She opens the box anxiously and peers inside.

SARAH

What the...

She pulls out a picture of Anne's favorite horse followed by a bobble head horse ornament. She bops the head with her finger and giggles. She pulls out several horse ribbons and some trophies.

SARAH (CONT'D)

Wow. Go mom!

Sarah reaches in and pulls out five identical books. She can't believe what she has found. She opens one and sees a picture of Ally and her name.

SARAH (CONT'D) Allyssa Anne Kelsey.

She sets Ally's diary down in what will become a chronological order. She opens each one and sets them beside each other.

SARAH (CONT'D) Brooklyn, Samantha...

Sarah is amazed that she has opened three out of five diaries without finding hers yet. She carefully opens one more.

SARAH (CONT'D)

Christine.

Sarah holds the last diary. She studies it, is almost afraid to open the front cover.

INT. KELSEY HOME KITCHEN - CONTINUOUS

The family is sitting at the table. They are waiting for Sarah. Tess pours out juice and hands the cups down the line.

ROBIN

Tess?

TESS I thought she'd be right behind us.

ALLY I'll go find her, Papa.

ROBIN

No, I'll go.

Chris gives a look of "I'll get even" to Ally which she pretends not to see.

INT. THE KELSEY STABLES

With determination Sarah takes a deep breath and opens the diary. Inside the cover is a baby picture of Sarah and a birth announcement "Sarah Roseanne Kelsey, Born September 1, 1993." She turns the page and hears her mother's voice:

ANNE (V.O.)

"Dear Sarah,"

Sarah closes the diary in shock. She opens it again.

SARAH

"Dear Sarah,

ANNE (V.O.) Today I became a mother for the very first time!

ANNE/SARAH My joy is indescribable! You are my first born.

SARAH My precious Sarah. I see myself in you already...

Sarah holds the book to her chest and takes a deep breath of both joy and sorrow. She chokes up as the words are read.

ANNE (V.O.)

This diary is something I look forward to giving to you on your 18th birthday, God willing..."

SARAH Oh Mamma, I miss you so much. Papa took down all your pictures. I can just barely remember your face.

ROBIN (O.S.)

Sarah!

Sarah gasps, smells the diary, wipes her eyes, and then puts everything back in the box. She looks around in fear. She covers the box with hay then sits on it as Robin WALKS into the stables. She fakes a smile.

> ROBIN (CONT'D) Sarah, Tess has breakfast on the table. We need to say grace.

SARAH I'm... I'm not hungry.

ROBIN Not hungry? You? Since when?

SARAH I'd... rather not talk about it. Uhh... Girl stuff?

Robin doesn't handle this information well.

ROBIN Oh...enough said.

SARAH (looking rather guilty) Yeah.

ROBIN You sure you're okay? You look a little... flushed.

SARAH I'm fine. Just not hungry. I think I'll keep on working if that's okay.

Sarah picks up a broom and starts SWEEPING.

ROBIN I thought Brook was the horse fanatic, oh and Chris now as well. SARAH She is... I mean they are. But I used to ride too... at least back... when mom-

ROBIN

Don't wear yourself out.

Robin leaves. Sarah looks out the window to make sure he is gone then PULLS off the hay and opens up the box again. She pulls out the diaries, setting them down in order. She opens Chris's diary.

> SARAH "Dear Christine, welcome to the family. I know you'll be the greatest little sister Sarah will ever know"... (laughs) Yeah... Umm... mom? I think she would have preferred an older brother...

She reads a bit then sets Chris's diary down and picks up Brook's diary

INT. KELSEY HOME KITCHEN - CONTINUOUS

Robin sits down at the table.

ROBIN Ally? Would you please say grace?

ALLY Dear Heavenly Father, thank you for this food. You rock! Amen.

Robin goes to say something but the girls are already passing the dishes. Tess looks at Robin and laughs.

INT. INSIDE THE STABLES - CONTINUOUS

Sarah opens Brooklyn's diary.

SARAH "Dear Brooklyn..."

INT. HOSPITAL ROOM - FLASHBACK

Anne is lying in her hospital bed writing in Brook's diary.

SARAH (V.O.) Today we were graced with a third daughter. Your father...

INT. HOSPITAL MATERNITY WARD

SARAH (V.O.) Your Father thinks we're are being tested by God.

INT. HOSPITAL FAMILY ROOM.

Anne is seated in a wheel chair. Robin is looking out a window. The DOCTOR is bracing them for bad news. He puts his hand on Anne's hand. She attempts to comfort him by putting her hand over his.

> DOCTOR I wish I had your faith.

He pats her hand and walks out of the room. Anne wheels over to Robin. She puts her arm on his and he stares out the window.

INT. INSIDE THE STABLES - CONTINUOUS

SARAH What the...I don't remember any of this. (panics)) I have to find out if she lives! (she frantically turns the page in Brook's diary.) "Dear Brooklyn, welcome home!" (relieved) Oh, thank God!

EXT.KELSEY RANCH - FLASHBACK

Robin is getting set to take a picture of Anne on horseback. She is holding Sarah(3yrs old) who is holding onto Chris(2yrs old), who is holding onto baby Brook.

ROBIN Okay, everyone say cheese!

ANNE/SARAH/CHRIS

Cheese!

Robin takes the picture.

ROBIN Wait, one more, just in case.

INT. KELSEY HOME KITCHEN - CONTINUOUS

The family is finishing breakfast.

BROOKLYN I think we should board at least a dozen horses!

ALLY May I be excused?

ROBIN Yes you may. And who will take care of this mighty herd?

Ally takes her plate to the kitchen. She hands it to Tess. As the rest talk she puts her shoes on to go outside.

CHRISTINE (O.S.) We have it all planned out.

ROBIN (0.S.) We? Chris, what exactly, do you know about horses?

BROOKLYN (O.S.) Yeah Chris, what exactly, do you know about horses?

CHRISTINE (V.O.) I... know I should be helping Tess with the dishes.

Ally heads out the door.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY HOME

As Ally walks away from the house the sound of dishes crashing is heard.

TESS (0.S.) Chris, stop trying to help me, please!

INT. THE KELSEY STABLES - CONTINUOUS

Sarah closes Sam's diary.

SARAH Samantha Mae Kelsey... May God give you the gift of courage to go along with that amazing voice.

She kisses Sam's diary.

SARAH (CONT'D) Man... these diaries read like a fairytale... without the happily ever after part...

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES - CONTINUOUS

Ally overhears Sarah talking in the stables. She sneaks up to the window but she isn't quite tall enough to see into it.

> SARAH (V.O.) Alright. Last one. "Dear Ally...

ALLY

Dear Ally?

Ally looks around for something to stand on. She spots a rickety old egg crate.

INT. INSIDE THE STABLES - CONTINUOUS

As Sarah reads Anne appears holding a baby.

ANNE

...Welcome home little one. God has given us a fifth ray of sunshine in you, our precious Allyssa Anne Kelsey. Your Father has figured out how to stop God from punishing him any further. He has officially given up his quest for a son."

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES

Ally positions the egg crate against the wall.

SARAH (V.O.) Hmm. Too bad. Number six might have been the charmer. Number five sure ain't.

INT. INSIDE THE STABLES

We see Ally slowly pull herself up to see in the window.

ANNE I know he loves all five of his girls more than his own life. As the youngest member of the family Ally, you will have four sisters to love and care for you.

AllY slips and falls off the bucket. Anne and the baby slowly fade away. Anne looks at Sarah as she fades.

SARAH We're trying mamma. Lord knows we're trying.

She thumbs through Ally's diary revealing nothing but empty pages.

SARAH (CONT'D) Yikes. I better hide this from Ally.

Sarah starts putting EVERYTHING back in the box, starting with the diaries. Ally opens the door and SNEAKS UP on Sarah. She taps her on the back, scaring her in the process.

ALLY Hey Sarah! SARAH Allyssa Anne Kelsey! You scared the crap out of me! ALLY Horse crap? SARAH Funny. ALLY Who were you talking to? SARAH You see anyone? ALLY Why'd you skip breakfast? SARAH None of your business. ALLY Oh yeah? What'cha reading? Sarah keeps Ally from seeing any of the contents of Anne's box. SARAH Nothing. ALLY Let me see. SARAH No! ALLY I'll tell Papa. SARAH Tell him what? ALLY Tell him... Sarah's hiding something out here. Something really, really-

SARAH Ally! Go play with your friends, okay? ALLY And who will do my share of the chores? SARAH I will. ALLY Hah! Now I know something's up. I was just testing you! SARAH Go and play! ALLY No! Chris, Brook and Sam enter the stables. BROOKLYN "No," to what? SARAH I told her I'd do her share of the chores. SAMANTHA What? SARAH You can go too, Sam. CHRISTINE No way! SARAH Trust me. (she gives Christine and Brook a gesture) Go on, you two. SAMANTHA O...kay... I won't look a gift horse in the mouth. Sam leaves through the door. Sarah is pushing Ally towards the door as well.

> ALLY Just as long as that gift horse doesn't bite you in the

Sarah pushes Ally out the door before she can finish.

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ALLY (O.S.) (CONT'D)
(Muffled sound)
Oh, HI PAPA!
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Sarah opens the door in horror. Ally is face to face with her.

ALLY (CONT'D)

Got ya!

SARAH

Argh!

Sarah slams the door shut. Chris and Brook are already pulling stuff out of Anne's box.

SARAH (CONT'D) One of these days!

BROOKLYN Uhh... Sarah? What's going on?

SARAH I have something to show you.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES - CONTINUOUS

Ally and Sam are walking away from the stables.

SAMANTHA Don't you wanna know what they're up to?

ALLY You think I won't find out?

Sam stops. She doesn't know whether to be amazed or upset with Ally.

INT. INSIDE THE STABLES

Brook and Chris are holding their diaries. They open the covers.

CHRISTINE This is dedicated to me.

BROOKLYN

So is mine.

SARAH These diaries were written by none other than... Anne Marie Kelsey. Who?

SARAH

Our mother?

CHRISTINE

Wow.

BROOKLYN I forgot we even had one.

SARAH

Trust me. We do...uhh...did.

They study the books.

BROOKLYN This is kind of freaky.

SARAH

How so?

BROOKLYN Reading a book written to me by someone I don't even vaguely remember.

CHRISTINE

Yeah. I have this tiny picture of her in my mind but I don't know if I just made that up.

SARAH

Well... here's a way we can to get to know her.

CHRISTINE

You think so?

SARAH

I know so. But we have to keep these a secret.

CHRISTINE

From who?

SARAH

Who else?

The girls all say a different name all at once.

THE GIRLS

SARAH: Papa! BROOKLYN: Ally! CHRISTINE: Sam. BROOKLYN

Sam? Why Sam?

SARAH Because she can't keep a secret from-

THE GIRLS

ALLY KAT!

SARAH

Pinky swear?

The girls all join pinkies in a promise bond.

THE GIRLS

Pinky swear.

INT. ROBIN'S CHURCH OFFICE - LATER

Robin is reviewing a passage in his bible for a sermon.

ROBIN Resist the devil and he will flee from you...

He surveys a nonexistent congregation then lets his sermon rip loose.

ROBIN (CONT'D) RESIST the devil and he will FLEE from you!

He is buzzed on an intercom phone by his secretary, CLARE(45ish).

CLARE (O.S.) Pastor Kelsey. The Cooper sisters are here to see you.

ROBIN Thank you Clare. (carries on with his sermon) The devil is here to see me and I shall resist him!!

Robin thinks about this then buzzes Clare in sheer panic.

INT. OUTSIDE ROBIN'S OFFICE. - CONTINUOUS

The Cooper sisters are seated outside Robin's office waiting to see him. They hear Robin through Clare's phone speaker.

ROBIN (O.S.) The Cooper sisters!? Why didn't you warn me?! Daisy nods at Gladys then EXITS out to the sanctuary where there is a secondary entrance to Robin's office. She wants to cut him off at the pass.

CLARE (trying not to laugh) I'm sorry sir. I was in the washroom when they came in.

ROBIN (O.S.) Tell them... tell them...

INT. ROBIN'S CHURCH OFFICE

Robin sees the doorknob to his office turning. He has his coat halfway on.

ROBIN

Ahh!

Robin heads for the sanctuary door exit but the doorknob is turning as well. Daisy and Gladys enter his office at the same time, trapping Robin.

ROBIN (CONT'D)

Aw, crap!

GLADYS Pastor Robin. We're so glad you're in.

DAISY We won't take up much of your time.

They enter and SIT down in the chairs in front of Robin's desk. He reluctantly takes off his coat.

> ROBIN (aside) That'd be a first.

> > GLADYS

Excuse me?

ROBIN Uhh, thirst. Can I get you ladies something to drink?

DAISY Oh don't bother about us however, some tea would be nice.

Robin hangs up his coat.

GLADYS

And we wouldn't say no to any decent cookies you may have... as long as they're not baked by that Ida Jackson. The woman uses too much salt. Bless her heart.

Robin talks to Clare on the intercom.

ROBIN

Clare, tea and some un-salty cookies, please.

CLARE (O.S.)

Yes Pastor.

DAISY That's probably what killed her husband. Bless his heart.

GLADYS Daisy! The man died of a heart attack.

DAISY (annoyed) I know that Gladys.

GLADYS Well, you can't say "bless his heart" when the man's organ blew apart like a hand grenade. Bless his heart.

ROBIN (aside) Oh Lord, take me now, please!

DAISY Pastor Robin...you're probably wondering why we're here.

Clare walks in with a tray of tea and cookies.

ROBIN The thought crossed my mind. (aside) Along with several others. (takes the tray)) Thank you Clare. (aside to Clare) SAVE YOURSELF!

Clare hurries out in a partial panic.

DAISY Why do you keep mumbling? Is there something wrong with you?

ROBIN I'm sorry. I'll try and speak more "clearly".

DAISY Well, good. The reason-

GLADYS

Daisy, let me. Pastor Robin, we understand you are planning on reopening your stables and bringing in horses.

ROBIN Word travels fast.

DAISY

Gladys, let me. We think this is a grave error in judgment.

ROBIN And why is that? (aside)

Dare I ask.

GLADYS

It's quite simple, really. Old wounds that have long since been buried should stay buried. Your wife, bless her heart, did a terrible thing to you and those girls.

DAISY A scandalous thing!

GLADYS

And now you want to have your girls immerse themselves into the same sort of wild expressions-

DAISY

Not proper for young ladies.

ROBIN

Specifically my daughters...

GLADYS

As a man of the cloth standards must be set-

DAISY

In stone.

ROBIN

I see.

GLADYS We're glad you agree.

ROBIN

When did I-

DAISY So you'll tell your girls you've changed your mind?

ROBIN

They want to board some horses. Since when-

GLADYS Horses need training which means "cowboys" and that spells one thing for those girls of yours.

ROBIN And what would that be, exactly?

DAISY

The bible says that we are to avoid even the appearance of sin, lest we be drawn into it's snares and passions!

GLADYS

Into the very depths and lust-filled desires of the...

Both ladies have to fan themselves with their hands.

ROBIN

Look ladies, I appreciate what you're trying to-

GLADYS

Toby Jackson!

ROBIN

Who?

DAISY The widow, Ida Jackson! Her nephew.

ROBIN

Oh, right.

GLADYS He trains horses. ROBIN So? GLADYS AND riders. ROBIN Well, good for-DAISY It seems he's been giving riding lessons to a certain daughter of yours? ROBIN Brooklyn told me all about it. Christine admitted to the same. GLADYS (shocked and angry) You mean you knew? ROBIN Uhh...As of last night... yes. GLADYS Oh!!! It's already begun. Daisy! We're too late!! ROBIN Too late for what? DAISY THE LIES! THE DEBAUCHERY! ROBIN I beg your-GLADYS Those girls went behind your back nearly all summer long! ROBIN Only because they knew I'd say no. GLADYS (totally shocked) Oh! The appearance of sin! DAISY COMPLETE REBELLION!

GLADYS

(angry)
What do you have to say for yourself
and those daughters of yours?!?

ROBIN Uhh...more tea, anyone?

EXT. OMAR ROAD - LATER THAT AFTERNOON

An old beaten TRUCK and horse trailer wind down OMAR road towards the Kelsey ranch. TOBY(19-22, handsome, cowboy) is trying his best to change gears and keep his truck on the road.

TOBY Come on Bessy. Second gear, your favorite. Come on! Do it for Toby, you piece of junk!

Robin is DRIVING his car behind Toby's truck. He honks his horn in hopes of signaling the truck to pull to the side and let him pass. Toby is oblivious to anything around his because of the noise from his truck and motor. Robin sees an opening to pass and goes for it.

INT. INSIDE THE STABLES - CONTINUOUS

The Girls are finishing the clean up.

SARAH That's it. I am done! All this cleaning better be worth the trouble.

Sarah flings a big rag over her shoulder.

BROOKLYN Are you kidding me? There is nothing better than a real live horse!

CHRISTINE Except a real live cowboy!

SARAH Chris, do you ever think of anything besides boys?

BROOKLYN Nope, has a one track mind and she's proud of it!

CHRISTINE So what if I am?

SARAH I wouldn't let Papa hear you talk like that.

CHRISTINE Hey, one of these days we're all gonna be gone.

Outside the stables the sound of an OLD TRUCK sputtering and backfiring, can be heard as it approaches the Kelsey ranch. Horse sounds and a dog barking are also heard.

BROOKLYN Not me. I'm staying here to run this ranch.

CHRISTINE

Seriously?

BROOKLYN Wait! Listen! I hear horses!

CHRISTINE Forget them. Toby Jackson!

Chris and Brook fight to get out the door first. Sarah has a broom in her hand and rag over her shoulder as she walks out of the stables.

EXT. THE KELSEY STABLES

Ally and Sam come running across the yard. Toby's truck barely pulls in front of the stables, coughs, and then promptly DIES a horribly loud death. Toby gets out of his truck and gives it a big kick. Robin is walking towards Toby.

> TOBY You stupid, stupid truck! I should take you out and shoot you! Put you outta my misery!

> > BROOKLYN

Toby.

His truck blows it's rad cap and steam spews out of the radiator. Brook and Chris notice Robin but Toby doesn't.

> TOBY Oh yeah! Go ahead and blow a rad cap. SEE IF I CARE!!

> > CHRISTINE

51.

Toby!

TOBY

If I was a cussin' man you know what I'd say to you? You God forsaken SON-OF-A-

Sarah COVERS up Sam's ears. Sam covers up Ally's ears at the same time. Brook jumps in quick before Toby makes a bad impression. Robin has walked up to within SEVERAL FEET of Toby'S backside.

BROOKLYN Toby Jackson! I'd like you to meet Pastor Robin Kelsey-

Brook SPINS Toby around.

BROOKLYN (CONT'D)

-our father!?

TOBY Our father? Who art a... a... pastor? (his voice goes high pitched)

ROBIN I see my...uh...fame hasn't exactly preceded me.

Robin looks at the girls. They look away.

ROBIN (CONT'D) So... Toby. You're Mike Jackson's nephew?

TOBY

Yeah. I came here to help my aunt with the ranch after his heart attack.

Chris moves in beside Toby and starts to SMELL his shirt. Robin doesn't see her actions however Brook does and she's embarrassed.

ROBIN

He was a good man. Sorry to see him go.

As Chris smells his shirt she looks like she's just died and gone to heaven. Brook pulls her away from Toby before Robin sees what she is doing.

TOBY

(nods) Yeah.

ROBIN But... that was early July and here it is the end of August.

BROOK (aside to Toby) Careful. It's a trap! ROBIN (tugging at his collar) All those Sunday mornings... TOBY Yeah, uhh...sorry...I... CHRISTINE Papa! Can we at least welcome the man to our home before we try and get him saved?! ROBIN Well, you can stay for lunch if you like. TOBY Thank you, sir. ROBIN If you call for a tow truck by the time we finish eating-TOBY Uh... no sir. ROBIN Beg your pardon? TOBY Ol'Bessy just needs some TLC. ROBIN "Ol'Bessy" here needs a complete overhaul. TOBY If I could borrow some tools in a

ROBIN

couple of days I'm sure-

Look Toby, let me be right up front - I won't have a young man, your age in a house - full of -

SARAH Papa! There's a bedroom, upstairs, at the back...

Robin glares at her. Toby notices Sarah for the first time.

SARAH (CONT'D) ... of the stables. Needs some cleaning.

Sarah holds up her broom. Robin knows he's being cornered. Chris JUMPS right in. Sarah rolls her eyes.

CHRISTINE Ooo me, Me, ME!! I mean...

Chris grabs the broom and rag from Sarah and cuddles up to TOBY.

CHRISTINE (CONT'D) I'll do it, Papa.

Brook looks at Sarah and they both roll their eyes. Sam and Ally giggle.

ROBIN

(sighs) Toby. How long will it take to make that piece of junk road worthy?

TOBY

A few days. A WEEK, tops. I...I could give riding lessons in exchange for-

Chris tosses the rag which lands on top Brook's head. She pulls it off with disgust.

ROBIN

One week.

The exhaust on Toby's truck backfires.

TOBY It... might take me... two weeks.

ROBIN

(big sigh) Fine, "two weeks" or I tow it up Omar road and push it right into Canyon lake! Agreed?

TOBY Yes, sir...uhh, no sir.

ROBIN Girls? Please help Mr.Jackson with the horses.

THE GIRLS

Yes, Papa.

TOBY Is he always this scary?

BROOKLYN You caught him on a good day.

Toby gulps hard. He notices Sarah again as he opens up the back of the horse trailer. The girls all look in. They gasp at the beauty of the horses. (ad lib)

ALLY

Aww, what is that smell!?

Ally turns away from the trailer in disgust while Brook reaches down and scoops up some horse manure. Chris sees her and does the same.

TOBY

That is the smell of-

CHRISTINE/BROOK

Payback!

They smear Ally's cheeks with with horse manure. Ally is shocked but has a look of "this means war".

EXT. KELSEY RANCH CORAL - LATER THAT AFTERNOON

Brook is having a riding lesson. Chris is trying to get on her horse with very little cooperation from the horse.

TOBY

Lookin' good. Heels down.

Brook nods. Tess brings Toby a GLASS of iced tea. As he takes the glass he studies Sarah who is now sitting on the fence watching her sisters.

CHRISTINE Hold still you stupid horse! Toby, help me!

TOBY (preoccupied) Lookin' good. Heels down.

CHRISTINE My heals are on the ground!! Tess can't help but watch Toby as he keeps looking over at Sarah. She elbows him then points at Chris. She walks back to the house. Toby RUSHES over to help Chris.

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. KELSEY HOME KITCHEN - EVENING

On the Kelsey home fridge there are several pieces of elementary school artwork. One prominent picture shows stick drawings of the five Kelsey girls holding hands with Robin in the middle. Below him it reads "mommy" with a diagonal line through it and "Daddy" printed below. To the side of the drawing is an arrow that says "kitchen" this way and a stick figure of Tess holding a plate of food.

INT. OLDER KELSEY GIRLS BEDROOM - LATER THAT EVENING

The three older girls are reading from their respective diaries. They are wearing granny night gowns and reading to each other.

> BROOKLYN "Dear Brooklyn, today you and I got to go for a ride together. You held the reins while I held onto you. You smiled from ear to ear!"

TESS (O.S.) Girls, lights out!

BROOKLYN

(quietly) Imagine riding a horse with your own mother. What I would give to ride with her today.

SARAH

What I'd give to have her here, right now.

Chris closes her diary in frustration.

CHRISTINE

I'm sorry Sarah but these are just words... From a part of my life I can't connect with for some reason. I can't feel her, I can't...

SARAH

What if we pray?

BROOKLYN

Pray for what? She's been dead for ten years.

SARAH Maybe God can... help us.. with... a vision of what she was like.

A single gust of wind breeze blows into the room making the CURTAINS wave in a big way.

BROOKLYN That was just the wind, right?

CHRISTINE What if it wasn't?

SARAH Only one way to find out. Okay Lord, we're ready.

THE GIRLS (SING) SARAH: FATHER TAKE HER WORDS AND WRITE THEM ON MY HEART CHRIS: HELP US MAKE BELIEVE WE'VE NEVER BEEN APART

BROOK: WE BEG YOU ON THIS EVENING IN SEPTEMBER **GIRLS:** HELP US NOW TO FIND HER AND REMEMBER:

HER FACE, HER VOICE, THE SOUND OF HER PRAYERS TO YOU, OH GOD HER HANDS, HER EYES, THE SMELL OF HER HAIR

SARAH: WHAT MADE HER LAUGH, CHRIS/BROOK: WHAT MADE HER CRY? SARAH: WHAT MADE HER LONELY, BROOK: WHAT MADE HER SIGH? SARAH: WHAT MADE HER SING, CHRIS/BROOK: WHAT MADE HER SMILE GIRLS: WHAT MADE HER HOLD HER BREATH JUST FOR AWHILE?

SARAH/CHRIS: MAMMA CAN YOU FEEL ME? MAMMA CAN YOU FILL ME? BROOK: TAKE ME WHERE YOU ARE GIRLS: SO I CAN TOUCH YOU

MAMMA I AM WAITING, ANTICIPATING ALL THE LOVE I KNOW WILL MAKE IT RIGHT

> OH MAMMA CAN YOU SEE ME? MAMMA CAN YOU FREE ME? OF THE HURT OF LEAVING ME SO LOST AND WONDERING HOW MY LIFE COULD BE IF YOU WERE HERE WOULD I BE MORE LIKE YOU OR LIKE MY FATHER

THE GIRLS (SING) (CONT'D) MAMMA, CAN YOU HOLD ME MAMMA DO YOU KNOW ME WOULD YOU HAVE SURRENDERED IF YOU KNEW THAT THERE'D BE NO TOMORROW ONLY PAIN AND SORROW MAMMA DO YOU MISS ME HALF AS MUCH AS I MISS YOU?

SARAH: MAMMA, CAN YOU HOLD ME? CHRIS: MAMMA DO YOU KNOW ME? BROOK: WOULD YOU HAVE SURRENDERED GIRLS: IF YOU KNEW THAT THERE'D BE NO TOMORROW ONLY PAIN AND SORROW MAMMA DO YOU MISS ME HALF AS MUCH AS I MISS YOU?

The three of them finish the song sitting on the floor leaning on each other as they stare out the window. The curtains move one last time as we:

FADE OUT:

INT. CHURCH - NEXT DAY - MORNING

The congregation is in the middle of the song, "Down By the Riverside". Toby is drumming. Sarah is on piano. Brook is playing guitar and Chris is playing tambourine beside TOBY.

THE CHURCH GONNA MEET MY LOVING MOTHER DOWN BY THE RIVERSIDE DOWN BY THE RIVERSIDE DOWN BY THE RIVERSIDE

GONNA LAY DOWN MY BURDENS DOWN BY THE RIVERSIDE DOWN BY THE RIVERSIDE DOWN BY THE RIVERSIDE DOWN BY THE RIVERSIDE

The song ends but TOBY is so into it he forgets to stop. Christine SIGNALS him.

CHRISTINE

Toby!

He keeps on drumming.

CHRISTINE (CONT'D)

Toby!!

She pushes him off his stool. The congregation laughs.

ROBIN

Thank you girls. Nobody likes a show off Toby.

TOBY

Sorry.

The girls sit. Toby follows them. Robin looks over his congregation.

ROBIN Honor-- your Father and your Mother. Commandment number...?

TESS (shoots her arm up) Oh! I know this!

ROBIN Anyone? Toby?

TOBY Uhh... Eleven?

The congregation laughs. Ally slaps her head with her hand. Brook shows Toby ten fingers. Daisy has fallen asleep. Tess still has her hand up. Gene has Chester with him. They have matching suits on.

ROBIN

No.

TESS

Pick me!

ROBIN

Gene?

Gene stands up with Chester. He waits a second for Chester to respond for him then reluctantly speaks.

GENE

Number One.

ROBIN No, that's "You shall have no other Gods Before me".

GENE

Dang.

Robin sees that Daisy is asleep. He WALKS over to her.

ROBIN

Daisy!!

DAISY (wakes up, falls on floor) Oh! Dear Lord, my hair!

The congregation laughs. Gladys is embarrassed for her sister.

GLADYS

Pastor Robin, I believe it is commandment number nine.

ROBIN I believe it is not. Number nine is, "Thou shall not bear false witness against your neighbor".

CHURCH MEMBER 1 Too late for that.

GLADYS

Oh!

The congregation laughs.

ROBIN Settle down folks. Samantha?

SAMANTHA

What?

ROBIN "Honor your father and mother," is what commandment?

SAMANTHA

Uh....

ALLY

Six.

ROBIN Ally, is your name Samantha? You were close. Number six is "Thou Shall not Murder".

CHRISTINE Gettin' tougher every day.

ROBIN Christine Kelsey?

SARAH (coughs under her breath) Five. CHRISTINE

Wha-?

Sarah holds up five fingers. Chris takes Toby's hand and connects with each finger with her hand.

CHRISTINE (CONT'D) Oh, five. It's the fifth commandment.

ROBIN That is correct. That is not. You, sit here!

Toby moves to sit beside Brook. As he does he looks up and mouths "Thank you" to God. Chris pouts.

ROBIN (CONT'D) Thank you Sarah for helping your sister cheat so eloquently.

The congregation laughs politely.

ROBIN (CONT'D) Honor your Father and Mother. What does the bible really mean by the word "honor"?

TESS (raises her hand by reflex) Oh!

ROBIN (ignoring Tess) If we go back to the book of Genesis...

There is a loud horse whinny from the back of the church. Robin attempts to preach.

ROBIN (CONT'D) When horses roamed the land.

TOBY

Uh oh.

BROOKLYN

What's wrong?

ROBIN Cain was the first child to...

TOBY We have a visitor.

CHRISTINE

Who?

There is another horse sound.

TOBY Leo. I road him to church.

ROBIN ...challenge the authority of his parents...

BROOKLYN

So?

There is a further horse sound.

TOBY I don't think I tied him good enough.

CHRISTINE

Big deal.

TOBY I may have left the back door to the church open... for air flow...

GLADYS Oh dear Lord! What is that smell?

ROBIN (attempting to salvage his message) <u>Cain ignored everything</u> he had been taught-

ALLY Look! HORSE! RUN!

LEO (the horse) trots across the pulpit area and down the aisle of the church causing a huge commotion. Toby and Brook try and catch him causing even more commotion. Full pandemonium occurs complete with screaming, running and folks jumping over pews. Leo turns around and heads back towards the pulpit. Eventually Toby manages to jump on Leo and ride him out of the church.

> CHRISTINE Toby! What about me?!

> > DISSOLVE TO:

INT. AT THE BACK OF THE CHURCH - LATER

Robin is SHAKING HANDS with folks as they leave. Gene holds up Chester's little hand for Robin to shake.

GENE

Good service Pastor. After that horse showed up we nearly stayed awake for all of it.

ROBIN (sarcastic)) Thanks Gene, that means a lot.

Daisy and Gladys approach Robin with indignation.

DAISY

Pastor Robin.

ROBIN I know. You warned me.

GLADYS Oh, we shall have lots to say about this at the next deacons meeting. That you can be sure of.

DAISY We did feel your sermon was on the right track.

ROBIN You mean because of the horse? (the ladies are deadpan) Track?... Horse!!

GLADYS However, we felt it needed more brimstone and punch.

ROBIN You know Gladys, I agree.

GLADYS

Really?

ROBIN

Each week it dawns on me just how much PUNCH I hold back on. Have a lovely afternoon.

He shakes their hands and somewhat ushers them out the door.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE CHURCH - CONTINUOUS

GLADYS Daisy, I think we've just been insulted! DAISY

Horses in church. Next we'll be having pigs and chickens, two by two, a regular Noah's Ark!

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES - LATER

Sarah, Chris, Toby, and Brook are riding down the long driveway on horseback. Chris is having some trouble controlling her horse.

CHRISTINE Whoa, boy! Easy... Easy.

TOBY Don't let him get away with that. Tell him what you want.

The horse speeds up into a trot.

CHRISTINE I want him to stop b-b-b-b-bouncing me before m-m-m-my teeth fall out.

Toby looks at Brook. She heads off to help Chris. Toby looks at Sarah. Sarah points towards Chris.

SARAH Keep you eyes on the prize, cowboy.

TOBY

That's what I'm doing.

Sarah takes off leaving Toby by himself. He smiles.

INT. KELSEY HOME OLDER GIRL'S BEDROOM - LATER

Ally SNEAKS into the older girl's bedroom. She REACHES under Sarah's mattress and finds her diary. She opens it, shaking her head at her discovery. She SCANS the room for the next hiding place. She WALKS over to the dresser and pulls open the lowest drawer. She REACHES into the drawer and digs to the bottom of a ton of clothes and junk and pulls out another diary, which she tosses on the bed. She opens the closet then GRABS A CHAIR to help her get high enough to reach a concealed shoebox which she pulls down. She OPENS the box and pulls out a third diary.

ALLY

Amateurs.

She stacks all three diaries under her arm and storms out of the bedroom.

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. THE KELSEY STABLES - MOMENTS LATER

Sarah is brushing her horse. Chris is watching her.

SARAH

Chris, I know how to groom a horse. This isn't rocket science.

CHRISTINE Fine, then you won't mind if I take over?

SARAH

Be my guest.

Chris unties the horse and leads her out of the stables.

SARAH (CONT'D) Where you going?

From inside the stables Sarah hears the following conversation which fades out as they get too far away. Sarah tidies up the stall by putting the grooming tools away.

TOBY (0.S.) Perfect! Now that is a well groomed horse. Brook, you could learn something from your sister...

BROOKLYN (O.S.) Who? Wha- Are you kidding me? Who do you think taught her?

Sarah shakes her head. PAUSE. Ally comes into the stables. She sets two diaries down on a table, clears her throat, and reads aloud from Sarah's diary.

ALLY "Dear Sarah, today I became a mother for the very first time! My joy is indescribable! You are my first born. My precious Sarah.

SARAH ALLY KAT! Where did you get that?!

ALLY In the most pathetic hiding place on the planet!

SARAH How dare you! Sarah grabs the book.

ALLY (CONT'D) I found two more.

Ally points to the table.

SARAH Allyssa Anne Kelsey! You outta be ash-

ALLY

Where's mine?

SARAH What makes you think-

ALLY Oh, come on Sarah. Our mother started these the first day we were born. Hand it over.

Robin walks into the stables.

ROBIN

Hand what over.

Sarah hides the diary behind her back.

SARAH

Nothing.

Ally grabs the diary from Sarah and hands it to Robin.

ALLY

Here Papa.

SARAH

You little-

ROBIN

Sarah!

Robin looks at the diary. SARAH takes it back.

ROBIN (CONT'D) See me in my den after supper. Bring the diaries. All five of them.

Robin exits the stables. Ally takes one look at Sarah and runs off.

SARAH You better run you little-

A horse whinnies.

EXT. KELSEY RANCH CORAL - MOMENTS LATER

Chris is watching Toby as he ground trains a horse. Toby is somewhat embarrassed about being watched so carefully.

TOBY Don't you have homework to do?

CHRISTINE I'm doing it as we speak.

TOBY Oh yeah? What subject?

CHRISTINE

Anatomy.

INT. INSIDE THE STABLES - LATER THAT AFTERNOON

Sarah pulls out her mother's box in anger. She DUMPS OUT all the contents onto the floor including the two diaries belonging to Sam and Ally. She shakes the box and hears the sound of SOMETHING ELSE banging from side to side. She peers inside and notices an irregularity to the wooden bottom. She explores the outside of the box and notices a small pin holding the bottom in place. She PULLS out the pin and the bottom drops, revealing two more diaries. She examines them to see who they are dedicated to.

> SARAH These are mamma's personal diaries... Well... Papa? You asked for five diaries so that's what you're getting.

Sarah starts reading Anne's diary.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES - LATER THAT AFTERNOON

Sarah is explaining what happened to Chris and Brook. She shows them the five diaries. They nod and hug her in support.

INT. KELSEY HOME DEN - LATER THAT EVENING

SARAH knocks on the door. She is holding the five diaries.

ROBIN

Come in Sarah.

SARAH Papa, I can explain.

She holds the diaries closely to her heart.

ROBIN I wondered what happened to those.

SARAH I found them in the stables... in Toby's room.

ROBIN Sarah, when your mother... (starts again) As you know... I have tried to protect you girls, by-

SARAH But I don't see how--

ROBIN I had completely forgotten about her diaries.

SARAH

Papa, the reason I never gave Ally her diary... I... I... as trying to protect her. There's only a few pages written in hers...

ROBIN

That doesn't matter. The one thing that does matter is the amount of lying and deception that has somehow infected this family! God only knows what else has been going on behind my back. My sermon to "Honor Your Father" obviously fell on deaf ears.

SARAH

That's not true. What about honoring our mother?

Robin bangs the desk.

ROBIN

She is dead!

SARAH

Yes! And thanks to you she has been nothing but dead ever since the day she died!

ROBIN You think I don't know that!? You think it's been easy to protect you girls from the sins of that woman!?

SARAH Isn't that like playing God?

ROBIN Don't you preach to me!

SARAH Does God judge the sin or the sinner?

ROBIN Give me the diaries.

SARAH Papa, no. You don't--

ROBIN (banging the desk) NOW!

Sarah reluctantly puts the books on his desk.

SARAH Please don't do this.

ROBIN

While I have no right to destroy these I do have the power to keep them from you until the age your mother would have given them to you in the first place, had God not judged her the way He did.

Robin puts the diaries in the bottom drawer of his desk.

SARAH

But she-

ROBIN

By then you may be mature enough to handle what is in these. Do I make myself clear?

Robin pulls out a key and locks the drawer.

SARAH

But-

ROBIN

Sarah?

SARAH

Fine!

Sarah runs out of the room upset. She passes Tess, holding a laundry basket.

TESS Oh Sarah, I was about to do a load... of <u>laundry</u>.

Tess drops the basket on the floor and looks at Robin. He gets up and closes the door to the den before she can say anything.

INT.OUTSIDE ROBIN'S DEN - CONTINUOUS

Tess looks at the wooden door.

TESS Two inch thick door. Two and a half inch thick skull.

ROBIN (V.O.) I heard that.

TESS (to herself) You were supposed to...

INT. KELSEY HOME KITCHEN - LATER THAT EVENING

Christine and Brook are doing homework. Ally and Sam are playing a game of go fish. Tess is sweeping the floor. Sarah walks into the kitchen. She signals Christine and Brook.

> ALLY Do you have any 3's?

> > SAMANTHA

Nope. Go fish.

SARAH

(whispers) Meet me in the stables in ten minutes. Just the two of you.

BROOKLYN

What's up?

SARAH

Ten minutes.

INT. THE KELSEY STABLES - MOMENTS LATER Toby is fixing the leather straps on some tack. Sarah walks into the barn and is so fixated she is startled by him. SARAH Oh! Sorry Toby, I forgot you were here. Sarah grabs a broom and a dustpan and begins sweeping. TOBY No worries. Just trying to make some of this tack usable after all these years. Toby looks over and sees Sarah bent over at the waist sweeping dust into her dustpan. He can't help but notice her figure. TOBY (CONT'D) Whoa! How's your butt? (laughs) SARAH Easy cowboy. TOBY Sorry. Hey... is it too soon for another ride - Just you and me this time? SARAH I don't think that would make Chris very happy. TOBY Who? SARAH Christine? My sister? TOBY Oh... Umm... no, I mean... We're just friends. SARAH Right... TOBY She has a crush-SARAH A big crush.

TOBY Which I probably should have ... SARAH Yeah. You're a little late there, Romeo. TOBY And a little too old. I swear, I didn't encourage her. SARAH But you didn't discourage her either. With Chris, that's like saying, "go ahead and order the wedding invitations". TOBY Yeah... so what do I do? SARAH Cowboy, I have four sisters and no brothers. You're on your own. TOBY What about you? SARAH What about me? TOBY Would you... ever...you know... Sarah sees Brook and Chris coming towards the stables. We hear them arguing about a halter. CHRISTINE (V.O.) SARAH Brook gimme that back! Would I...? Better make this fast. Toby takes Sarah by the hand. BROOKLYN TOBY No! You don't even know how I'd really like to ask you to use one. out... sometime... Brook and Chris enter the stables. Sarah takes her hand back. TOBY (CONT'D)

Aww crap.

BROOKLYN It's a barn. What'd you expect? CHRISTINE Hey, you...uhh... promised me a riding lesson.

TOBY Yeah, some other night, okay?... I've got to go see a man about a... horse...

Toby picks up a saddle to take with him. Chris hangs onto a saddle strap as Toby tries to leave. He pulls hard and she finally releases her grip. She is hurt. She looks at Sarah.

> CHRISTINE What were you two talking about?

> > SARAH

Who?

CHRISTINE You and Toby! Who else!?

SARAH Chris, relax. It was nothing. Wait here.

Sarah pulls out her mother's box.

SARAH (CONT'D)

Watch this.

She unlatches the false bottom of the box revealing Anne's two diaries.

BROOKLYN More diaries? Are there a couple of siblings we don't know about?

SARAH No... these are mom's.

CHRISTINE

(amazed) No way! I take it Papa doesn't-

SARAH Even know they exist and he never will, right?

CHRISTINE As long as Ally doesn't find out.

SARAH

She won't. I'm guarding these with my life.

BROOK

So have you read them already?

SARAH

Only bits and pieces. Near as I can figure this one is pre-marriage, her life growing up as a teenager, you know. And this one starts at around the time she met our father.

CHRISTINE

000, juicy.

BROOK

No, yucky.

SARAH

Well, you wanted to know all about our mother? Yucky or not-

CHRISTINE

Here we come.

SARAH

The first half of this diary is mom getting pretty serious about two things in her life - number one -Robin Kelsey and number two - her dream of becoming a champion in show jumping.

BROOK

Whoa. Talk about two different worlds.

SARAH

Get this. Two weeks after her and Papa got married she inherited this entire ranch when her parents were killed by a drunk driver.

CHRISTINE

Oh, man.

SARAH

For some reason everything starts to change from that moment on.

BROOK What do you mean?

SARAH

Well, every time mom started to get anywhere in the horse world, winning awards, our beloved father would get her...you know...pregnant.

BROOKLYN

(disgusted) Eeyoo.

CHRISTINE I thought they had cures for that sort of thing.

SARAH It gets complicated. Mom talks about another man in her life, her horse trainer and coach - Colin somebody. Soap opera time. Jealousy, fighting, you name it... I'll skip ahead to where I left off. Five daughters later. Listen to this... "Today started with the most wonderful news

ANNE (V.O.) I had just finished a riding lesson with Colin..."

INT. THE KELSEY RANCH - JUST OUTSIDE THE STABLES - FLASHBACK Anne walks into the stables with Colin. He has his arm around her.

> COLIN Anne, I told you, you could do it! I think you're ready...

ANNE Are you kidding me?

COLIN

Well... as long as he doesn't get you pregnant again.

ANNE

Not this time. Five is it. Robin has finally given up on having a son.

COLIN So you can compete again? Get back to your first love for real this time? ANNE

Maybe. (pauses)) Ooo, I'd love to!!

Anne is so excited that she hugs Colin hard as they spin around. Colin is the first to see Robin walk in, facing off with them.

COLIN I'll...umm... catch up with you later.

ANNE

Okay.

Colin exits the stables.

ROBIN (sarcastic) B'bye!

ANNE Why are you looking at me like that?

ROBIN

Oh, I'm sorry. Am I making you feel uncomfortable?

ANNE

Wha- Look, Robin, Colin figured out where I was losing over three seconds on my jumps. He thinks I can still compete-

ROBIN

Your girls need you.

ANNE Is someone hurt?

ROBIN No, of coarse not.

ANNE Has Tess said-

ROBIN I need you. You have to choose.

ANNE Choose? Between who and what?

ROBIN Don't! Anne, it's him or me! ANNE

Your jealous of a horse!?

ROBIN What?! How dare you! You know what I mean!

ANNE

You... you're jealous of Colin? After all I've given you? Are you insane?

ROBIN

He loves you.

ANNE

And you know what? I love him, but not the way I love you. You're my husband.

ROBIN

Then choose!

ANNE Why, Robin? Why would you make me do this?

ROBIN

Anne! Are you so stupid, so naive, and so blind to not see what an entire town can see even with their eyes closed!?

ANNE

What town? You mean that back biting, back stabbing congregation of yours who wouldn't know God if He showed up on Sunday in a flaming robe and personally served them communion!?

ROBIN That is <u>not</u> fair and you know it!

ANNE I know the truth hurts!

ROBIN

CHOOSE! Him or me!

ANNE

But...

Robin storms away, angry.

ANNE (CONT'D)

Robin, wait!

INT. THE KELSEY STABLES - REAL TIME

BROOKLYN Whoa! This is better than a movie.

CHRISTINE I sure wish I could have met this Colin. He sounds like a real dream.

SARAH Chris... can we stay focused here?

ROBIN (O.S.) Sarah? Are you in here?

BROOK

Oh oh!

SARAH Shhh... To be continued...

INT. KELSEY PORCH - LATER THAT EVENING

Sam is trying to finish writing a song. Ally sneaks up behind SAm and scares her.

SAMANTHA GOD OF PEACE, HEAR MY HEART BREATHE IN ME YOUR SPIRIT YOU ALONE ARE MY GOD AND YOU RESCUE ME-

ALLY

Boo!

SAMANTHA Ally cat! One of these da-

ALLY Who were you singing to?

SAMANTHA

No one.

ALLY Bet you wish you were singing for Toby.

SAMANTHA

You're crazy.

ALLY Yeah right. I saw you looking at him. SAMANTHA

You did not!

ALLY I wonder what Chris would think?

SAMANTHA Ally, please don't say anything!

ALLY Hey, I can keep a secret-

ALLY/SAM

For a price.

ALLY

(smiles) I'll be in touch.

Ally heads into the house. Sam closes her eyes and tries to regain her joy.

SAMANTHA I FOUND IN YOU MY EVERYTHING WHEN I SURRENDERED ALL BUT YOU BECAME MY LORD AND KING WHEN I ANSWERED TO YOUR CALL

Sam taps her notebook with her pen and shakes her head in frustration. Toby approaches her.

TOBY Hey, that sounded pretty good!

SAMANTHA (embarrassed) You mean you were listening?

TOBY Well, yeah, I hope that's-

Sam runs off the porch behind a bush and throws up.

TOBY (CONT'D)

-okay...

INT. THE KELSEY HOME UPSTAIRS HALLWAY - LATER THAT NIGHT

Sarah tip-toes down the hallway to Sam and Ally's room. She puts her ear to the door. She hears them snoring.

INT. SAM AND ALLY'S BEDROOM

Sam and Ally are sound asleep. On a night table between them, are two glasses with different levels of milk and a plate with crumbs and a half eaten cookie.

INT. THE KELSEY HOME UPSTAIRS HALLWAY

Chris puts her ear to Robin's door. She hears him snoring.

INT. ROBIN'S BEDROOM

On Robin's night table there is a bottle of sleeping pills and a half cup of water.

INT. THE KELSEY HOME HALLWAY

Brook puts her ear to Tess's door. She hears snoring.

INT. TESS'S BEDROOM

On Tess's there is half a bottle of scotch and a empty glass.

INT. THE KELSEY HOME HALLWAY

Sarah tip toes down the stairs, followed by Chris and Brook. They head for the living-room.

INT. KELSEY LIVING ROOM.

Sarah turns on a small light and the girls gather around her. In the living room there is a sofa, a piano, a rocking chair and an easy chair. Sarah looks at her sisters and then opens Anne's diary.

SARAH

Ready?

CHRISTINE This is so exciting!

SARAH

Shh. Okay...before reading ahead I wanted to go back to find out what life was like on the ranch when there were only four in the family and no Tess.

BROOK You mean before I was born?

SARAH

Well, buzz ahead to just after. When mom finally brought you home Brook, I (MORE)

SARAH (CONT'D)

think she started to feel pretty overwhelmed. Papa was spending way too much time with church stuff...

CHRISTINE

(sarcastic) Really? That's surprising.

SARAH

... and with three kids to raise mom could only stare at the horses...

BROOK Ooo, that's not good.

SARAH

Yeah.

CHRISTINE What about Colin?

SARAH What about him?

CHRISTINE Mom home alone with three kids... lonely...? <u>Desperate housewife!</u>!

Brook and Sarah are shocked at Chris.

SARAH

I don't get any sense that her and Colin were ever more than just good friends.

CHRISTINE

Too bad.

Brook and Sarah give Chris dirty looks.

CHRISTINE (CONT'D) Sorry. Look, maybe she left that part out. Just thinkin' out loud here.

SARAH Anyway. She wrote a song right in her diary. Notes, chords <u>and</u> words.

BROOK What kind of song?

SARAH Something to help her cope with life. But I don't think she wrote it just (MORE) SARAH (CONT'D) for herself. I cried when I read these lyrics.

As the intro to the song "Why Can't I Feel You Jesus?" plays, Anne Kelsey <u>appears</u>. She is trying to comfort her baby as she sits in the rocking chair. She sings. The girls watch her in awe joining her in harmony on the chorus.

> ANNE SHE REMEMBERS A CHILD WHO WOULD RUN TO YOUR ARMS WITH TEARDROPS, BUTTERFLIES, AND STORIES THEN A PROMISE TO A YOUNG GIRL; HOW YOU'D ALWAYS BE THERE AND WITH ALL OF HER HEART SHE BELIEVED YOU

> ANNE AND THE GIRLS BUT NOW SHE CRIES, "WHY CAN'T I FEEL YOU JESUS?" DID I WANDER TOO FAR TO FIND MY WAY HOME? OH I KNOW THERE'S A HEAVEN ABOVE ME BUT I'VE FORGOTTEN WHY YOU EVEN LOVE ME" SHE CRIES, "WHY CAN'T I FEEL YOU JESUS? I'VE GOT TO FIND YOU SOMEHOW 'CAUSE JESUS, I NEED TO FEEL YOU NOW."

Anne walks towards the door. It opens. She exits the home.

EXT. THE KELSEY PORCH - CONTINUOUS

As Anne comforts the baby she looks out over the ranch. The girls follow her out side. She stares at the horses in the choral. It is a gloomy grey cloudy day.

SARAH (SING) IT FELT LIKE A MOMENT AND HER TRUE LOVE WAS GONE AND LIFE MEANT HER JOB AND THREE CHILDREN SOME DAYS IT'S ALL SHE CAN DO TO HOLD ON AND SHE'S NEVER FELT SO ALONE

Anne wanders back inside the Kelsey home. The girls follow her.

ANNE AND THE GIRLS AND NOW SHE CRIES, "WHY CAN'T I FEEL YOU, JESUS? DID I WANDER TOO FAR TO FIND MY WAY HOME? OH I KNOW THERE'S A HEAVEN ABOVE ME BUT I'VE FORGOTTEN WHY YOU EVEN LOVE ME WHY CAN'T I FEEL YOU, JESUS? I'VE GOT TO FIND YOU SOMEHOW 'CAUSE JESUS, I NEED TO FEEL..."

Anne crumbles to her knees in tears.

THE GIRLS SARAH: WITH CLOTHES TO WASH, AND BILLS TO PAY CHRIS: SUNDAY SCHOOL, AND NO TIME TO PRAY (MORE) ANNE "Peace, my child, just be still"

THE GIRLS

And she cries...

ANNE NOW I CAN FEEL YOU JESUS I NEVER WANDERED TOO FAR TO FIND MY WAY HOME

The girls lift Anne up to her feet. A light fills the room as they sing.

ANNE AND THE GIRLS WITH HEAVEN ALL AROUND ME AND ABOVE ME I KNOW JUST HOW MUCH YOU LOVE ME SHE CRIES, "NOW I CAN FEEL YOU, JESUS I KNEW YOU'D FIND ME SOMEHOW OH AND JESUS? IT'S SO GOOD TO FEEL YOU NOW.

As the song finishes we:

FADE OUT:

INT. ROBIN'S BEDROOM -- LATER

Robin is having a nightmare. He tosses and turns.

EXT. OMAR ROAD BEND

Robin runs uphill to a sharp bend in OMAR road which overlooks a canyon lake. He comes to a POLICE road block. Red and blue lights are SPINNING at the scene of an accident. Robin attemps to JUMP over the roadblock. He comes crashing down on his back. This time he gets up with determination, jumps over the barricade. He runs over to the accident but is stopped by Sheriff Taber. Robin yells!

ROBIN

INT. ROBIN'S BEDROOM

Robin bolts up in his bed as he yells.

ROBIN

ANNE!!

ANNE!

DISSOLVE TO:

Tess is making lunches for the girls to take to school while the girls clean up from breakfast. Toby is still finishing up his food as Chris fawns over him. Sam whispers to Ally. They giggle then head for their coats. Sarah and Tess watch Chris from a distance while they prepare for school.

TESS

That girl has it bad.

SARAH

Real bad. If he doesn't shut this down soon she'll be picking out China patterns. Chris! Come on, we're gonna be late for the bus.

CHRISTINE

Bye Toby.

Chris KISSES him on the cheek.

BROOKLYN

"Bye Toby"

As a joke Brook also kisses him on the cheek. Ally and Sam do the same.

ALLY

"Bye Toby"

CHRISTINE

Would you-

SAMANTHA

"Bye Toby"

SARAH

"Bye Toby"

Sarah goes to kiss Toby on the cheek but he turns his head and they ACCIDENTALLY KISS on the lips. The girls all laugh except Christine, who storms out.

TOBY

Oops.

Tess looks at Toby. He shrugs.

EXT. OUTSIDE GENE PERLEMAN'S FUNERAL PARLOR - LATER.

Robin drives into the parking lot of a modest funeral home.

INT. GENE'S FUNERAL PARLOR

Gene is working at his desk. In his office is a large casket and a tiny one beside it. He has his black funeral suit on. Chester has a matching black suit on as well. From Gene's P.O.V. Robin walks up to Gene's open office door and knocks as a curtesy.

> GENE Come in, Pastor.

Robin walks into Gene's office. He has his bible with him.

ROBIN

Gene.

CHESTER

Robin.

ROBIN Chester. I see you're talking now.

CHESTER

Yep.

ROBIN

Since when?

CHESTER None of your business!

Robin sits down in front of Gene's desk.

GENE

Chester! Have some respect.

ROBIN So. I'm here. What's up? Somebody die?

GENE

Uh, no... actually, it's been pretty slow.

ROBIN

Well, cheer up, Gene. Soon the holidays will be here with business for everyone.

Gene comes out from behind his desk and sits opposite Robin.

GENE Yeah...Uhh look.. Pastor Robin... you know I've always tried to avoid conflict. ROBIN That's fair to say...

GENE And God knows I wouldn't hurt anyone for love nor-

CHESTER Oh, would you stop tap dancing around for two minutes? You make my head spin.

Chester's head spins around 360 degrees.

ROBIN Uhh Gene? Look, I'm sorry but I have a lot of work-

GENE Last night... Chester and I started talking...

ROBIN (trying to be serious) O--kay...

CHESTER And we figured out why Edna left us.

ROBIN Why Edna left the two of you?

GENE

Үер.

ROBIN But she was married to--?

CHESTER Aww, who do you think, numb nuts!

ROBIN I was... just asking. Go on.

GENE

Edna, she had a problem-

CHESTER Oh don't sugar coat it! The woman was jealous!

ROBIN

Of?

GENE

Chester and me.

CHESTER Green with DEMON SLIME!

GENE If I had paid even half as much attention to her as I paid to him she never would have left us.

ROBIN And...I can't believe I'm going to ask this, but, Chester?

Chester leans towards Robin.

ROBIN (CONT'D) How do you feel about that?

CHESTER I...uh... suppose it's true but in my defense I was here first.

ROBIN Well, I'm just glad to see you two worked this out. Time to go-

Robin starts to get up but sits back down again.

GENE Uhh!...There's more.

ROBIN I figured there would be.

GENE Chester, I don't feel right about hurting people's feelings.

CHESTER Then Gene? Shut up and learn. Robin? Been talking to <u>God</u> about you.

ROBIN Oh, this ought'a be good.

CHESTER And He told me part of your ticker is harder than the back of my head.

ROBIN

Ticker?

CHESTER Your heart, dummy!

ROBIN Hey! It takes one to-

CHESTER Are you dissin' me!?

GENE

Chester, don't-

CHESTER You heard of prophesy?

ROBIN (Grabs a bible) Uhh duh...I've read about it.

CHESTER

Well here's one for you! Unless you get on your knees and seek God for the sins you've buried you're gonna lose more than you ever bargained for.

ROBIN

Sins!? Just who in hell do you think you-

Gene holds up Chester's right hand.

CHESTER THUS SAYETH THE LORD!

ROBIN Is that right!!? Well, thus SAYETH Pastor ROBIN! How much wood can a woodchuck-!

Robin grabs Chester and stuffs him into the tiny coffin. He slams the lid.

ROBIN (CONT'D) -Stuff! Gene! You got something to say to me than just say it!

CHESTER (O.S.) (muffled sound) Let me outta here!

GENE

Look Pastor, I'm... sorry for... uh.. wasting your... I... had no call to...Look, can I maybe buy you lunch?

ROBIN

Goodbye Gene.

Robin leaves, closing the door behind him.

GENE (O.S.) A cup of coffee?

EXT. OUTSIDE GENE PERLEMAN'S FUNERAL PARLOR.

Robin steps outside.

ROBIN A prophetic dummy. What in the Sam Hill is next?

EXT. THE KELSEY RANCH DRIVEWAY - LATER

The five Kelsey Girls are walking away from the school bus.

ALLY

Hey Sam. I've got an apple left over from lunch.

SAMANTHA

I've got a carrot.

ALLY

Race you to the horses!

The two of them run off. Sarah is withdrawn.

BROOKLYN

Today I am going to try my very first jump.

CHRISTINE Good luck. I'm still trying to figure out what it takes to post properly.

BROOKLYN That's easy. Concentrate on your horse instead of Toby Jackson.

CHRISTINE No promises. You coming Sarah?

SARAH No...I have some... homework I need to...

CHRISTINE Are you okay? You look like you wanna hurl or something. SARAH

No, I'm fine.

CHRISTINE Well, if you're catching something keep it to yourself.

SARAH You mean away from Toby, right?

CHRISTINE Couldn't have said it better myself.

SARAH Thanks for the sympathy. Go!

BROOKLYN First one to the stables gets the best saddle!

Brook runs off. CHRIS follows her.

CHRISTINE Yeah right. Cheater!!

Sarah slowly walks towards the house. She pulls Anne's diary from her backpack and reads the last page of it. In the background Tess can be heard singing "Nobody Knows the trouble I've seen" from the kitchen. When she's done one full chorus she comments:

TESS (V.O.) Aww, sing it again, Tess. You've got the voice of an angel!

INT. KELSEY HOME KITCHEN - MOMENTS LATER

Tess is rolling out some pie dough, oblivious of anyone else as she sings.

TESS NOBODY KNOWS THE TROUBLE I'VE SEEN NOBODY KNOWS BUT--

Tess looks up and sees Sarah walking into the kitchen and is slightly embarrassed.

TESS (CONT'D)

Sarah!

SARAH

Hey.

TESS There's fresh cookies. SARAH

No thanks.

TESS Let me guess, tough exam?

SARAH

No.

TESS Then what is it?

SARAH

It's nothing.

TESS Oh yes and pigs fly my dear...

SARAH I don't think I can talk about it.

TESS Might make you feel better.

Sarah studies Tess then SITS at the table.

SARAH

Okay... Tess... you ever read something you wish you hadn't only because knowing what you read means you have to do something about it?

TESS

Umm...no?

SARAH And you basically have no choice.

TESS

But we always have a choice my dear. Sarah, God will never allow you be tested beyond what you can endure.

SARAH

That doesn't exactly comfort me right now.

TESS Oh!! Does this have something to do with Toby? (She pokes Sarah playfully)

SARAH

No.

TESS (deadpan) Is this about your father? Sarah stares ahead. SARAH Yes... and no. TESS Okay... SARAH It's more about my mother...and my father. TESS Your mother? SARAH Yeah. TESS Sarah, don't believe everything you've heard about her okay? SARAH (laughs in desperation) That's an understatement. TESS Meaning what? How can I help? SARAH (breaks down crying) I don't think you can, Tess... This is something I have to do myself. TESS (handing her a kleenex) What are we talking here? SARAH I have to challenge my... TESS Your...? SARAH I have to take on my father. TESS Oh crap!

Sarah is sitting on the porch bench. Robin steps outside. He has a sweater on.

ROBIN Whew! Gonna freeze again. You warm enough?

SARAH

I'm fine.

ROBIN Tess said you wanted to talk to me?

SARAH

Yeah.

Robin sits in a chair near the bench.

ROBIN

So... talk.

SARAH Papa, I have to ask you some questions and bring up some stuff you probably won't like.

ROBIN Why not? Been the theme of my day.

SARAH But I need you to... to not get mad at me, okay?

ROBIN

Sarah-

SARAH

You promise?

ROBIN Look, what ever-

SARAH Just promise me you'll try.

ROBIN (put out) I'll do my best. okay!?

Sarah halfway crumbles with his insensitivity.

ROBIN (CONT'D) Wait, if this is about those diaries my mind is made up! When you turn 18-SARAH No, it's not about them. ROBIN Then what? SARAH Tell me... Tell me about... my mother. ROBIN Your mother? Sarah, where is this coming from? I've told you girls everything you need to know about her. SARAH (disgusted at him) Really, Papa? ROBIN Yes! SARAH Did you love her!? ROBIN Did I--? Of coarse I loved her! SARAH And did she love you!? ROBIN I--SARAH Well? Did she?! ROBTN I believe she did. At least at first! SARAH Five children! She gave you five bless-ed children! Wasn't that proof enough?! ROBIN Sarah, you're too young to understand. SARAH

Don't pull that on me!

ROBIN Pull what !? You don't know anything about love. Your mother lived two lives. In one of them she was so caught up in her fantasy world--SARAH She gave up everything for you! ROBIN You think so? Sarah, there is so much you don't know about her. SARAH So tell me! ROBIN And even less you know about -- him! SARAH You mean, Colin?! ROBIN So you do remember. SARAH Just barely. ROBIN Good. Let's keep it that way! SARAH But why? ROBIN Ask him! SARAH I can't! He's dead and buried along with my mother!! The two of them STAND and carry on the argument. ROBIN And that is where he's gonna stay! This has gone far ENOUGH!

Sarah studies him and CRIES OUT in frustration.

SARAH

Ergh! Did you ever, EVER, stop and consider how <u>blind</u> you might have been!??

ROBIN Blind? To what!? And watch what you say young lady!

SARAH

Blind to your own selfish, even sick definition of real love!

ROBIN

(seething) Honor your father-_

SARAH And jealous! Don't even get me STARTED!

ROBIN

Sarah!!

SARAH That's what you were! Envious and jealous of her, of him. Of the TWO OF THEM!

ROBIN

STOP IT!

Robin TURNS away from her.

SARAH You couldn't stand to see her as anything more than YOUR OWN PERSONAL SLAVE!

ROBIN

I said STOP IT!

Sarah turns Robin around to face her.

SARAH So you DROVE HER TO THE POINT OF-

Robin slaps her hard across the face. There is a stunned silence. Sarah runs off towards the stables.

ROBIN Sarah, wait! I'm sorry...I... Oh God! What have I done?

Robin sits back down on the bench in horror.

Toby is working on a saddle. Sarah runs into the stables, crying, into Toby's arms.

TOBY Whoa. Easy there. It's okay. I've got you.

Sarah allows herself to cry.

SARAH

I'm sorry-

TOBY Don't be. You're shaking.

SARAH

I'm okay.

Toby lifts up her chin and sees a red cheek where Robin had slapped her.

TOBY (angered) Who did this? SARAH It doesn't matter. TOBY It does to me. SARAH

Toby-

TOBY Your father do this?

Sarah looks away.

TOBY (CONT'D) He did, didn't he? I'd say it's time for a good ol'fashion ass-woopin!

SARAH

Toby, he could wipe you off this planet and not break a sweat.

TOBY Not if I run him over with my truck first!

PAUSE - they laugh.

SARAH I...uhh...I think I have a better plan.

TOBY

Oh oh.

SARAH I haven't told you what it is yet.

TOBY

You know what? Doesn't matter. I am your official knight in...jeans and cowboy boots.

Sarah studies him.

SARAH

Okay...

Sarah looks down the corrals and out the window. Robin is still sitting on the porch staring at his hands.

SARAH (CONT'D) There's something I, make that, "we" need to do.

TOBY Gettin' nervous.. but keep talking.

SARAH How's your truck doing?

TOBY She's off the critical list. At least when push comes to-

Sarah surprises Toby with a passionate kiss.

TOBY (CONT'D)

Shove...

SARAH Don't look so surprised.

TOBY I'm not. I'm just trying to put my tongue back in my mouth. Here.

Toby kisses Sarah this time. It's obvious they really like each other.

TOBY (CONT'D) Now that's a kiss.

Sarah smiles. She holds both his hands.

SARAH

Yeah... Look, ummm... tomorrow night is youth group but I'm staying home with a "headache". Tess has a "Woman's Aglow" meeting at the church.

TOBY And your Father?

SARAH

He's got couples marriage counseling. Those meetings go pretty late.

TOBY Sarah? Is this something you're gonna regret?

SARAH No...well... I guess that remains to be seen. Tomorrow night, okay?

TOBY I'll be here, waiting.

Sarah kisses him again then leaves. Toby takes a deep breath and starts working on a saddle.

INT. ROBIN'S DEN - NEXT DAY - EARLY MORNING HOURS

Robin's bible is resting on his chest as he sleeps in a big leather chair. He is having a bad dream. In a DREAM STATE Robin wakes up to someone banging heavily on the kitchen door.

> ROBIN Can someone get the door!?

No one answers. Frustrated, he gets up and storms into the kitchen.

INT. KELSEY HOME KITCHEN -- CONTINUOUS DREAM SEQUENCE

Robin approaches the back door as the banging continues. He opens it, somewhat annoyed. Sheriff Tabor is there for a second but she fades away. Robin steps outside and is immediately transported to the bend in OMAR ROAD.

EXT. OMAR ROAD BEND -- CONTINUOUS DREAM SEQUENCE

Robin is standing in front of the road block. In anger, he grabs the wooden rail and yanks it aside. Sheriff Taber turns and gives Robin a look of real bad news as she attempts to stop him from looking at the accident. Robin struggles with her. He pushes her INT. ROBIN'S DEN -- NEXT MORNING

Robin is face down on the carpeted floor of his den. He is startled awake by a scream.

a face-plant on the road. A female scream is heard.

CHRISTINE (O.S.) AHHH! Ally Cat! Will you keep your stupid frog outside!

TESS (0.S.) GIRLS! In five minutes the bus leaves with or without you!

Robin's hair is matted with sweat.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES - MOMENTS LATER

A school bus pulls away from the Kelsey ranch.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES - TIME PASSING.

The sun is seen setting and the moon rising. It quickly becomes dark. Robin drives up the driveway towards the house.

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. KELSEY HOME KITCHEN - LATER THAT EVENING Robin is on the phone. Tess is drying some dishes.

> ROBIN Okay... If you see her tell to call home. Thanks.

He hangs up.

TESS

More coffee?

ROBIN No, my guts are in a knot. Anymore caffeine and everyone will have to sleep in the stables.

TESS

Too much information... I'm sure she's okay. If she is with Toby then-

ROBIN Then he's a dead man. TESS

Robin-

ROBIN You know what I mean.

TESS I just hope we get to her before Chris does.

Chris WALKS into the kitchen, picks up a cloth and wipes the table.

CHRISTINE Before Chris does what?

ROBIN Umm... Look...Chris...

CHRISTINE What's going on?

ROBIN Sarah left...here... sometime during youth group.

CHRISTINE

So?

ROBIN She didn't leave a note or anything.

CHRISTINE She's been pretty upset-

ROBIN With me. I know.

CHRISTINE So? She'll be back.

ROBIN But no ones seen her anywhere. None of her friends.

TESS Chris! She left with Toby.

CHRISTINE

No, she didn't.

ROBIN She must have. His truck is gone.

Chris storms off. Tess heads off to see if she can calm her.

TESS

I'll go.

ROBIN Thanks. I'll be in my den.

As Robin walks into his den there is an URGENT KNOCK on the kitchen door, followed by banging. Robin stops in shock and heads for the kitchen. Robin sees the lights of a police car spinning outside, reflecting on the kitchen window. He pauses, then quickly opens the door revealing Sheriff Tabor who has a rather grim look on her face.

> ROBIN (CONT'D) Sheriff Taber?

SHERIFF TABER Pastor Robin... I have bad news.

EXT. OMAR ROAD BEND

Robin runs to the police barricade. He grabs it and hurls it aside. He takes one look at Sheriff Tabor. She tries to stop him. Robin pushes her aside. He slips on the road. In frustration he gets back up and carefully steps his way to the edge of the cliff. Sheriff Tabor hands Robin a beaten up old suitcase and a shirt with dirt on it. In the moonlight a large hole in the ice can be seen on Canyon lake. Robin is beside himself.

> SHERIFF TABER Robin, I am so sorry. First, Anne... and now... Worse yet, we can't even get down there till spring break-up. I told the county this cliff needs a barrier to stop-

Robin screams in anger as he hurls the suitcase down the canyon wall.

EXT. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY HOME

Robin storms to a small shed, opens the door and grabs a gas can. Sheriff Taber follows him towards the stables, trying to talk sense into him. The girls watch from the house. Brook sees what Robin is about to do and runs outside. Tess grabs onto her several feet from the house but Brook breaks free. Closer to the stables Sheriff Tabor is finally able to wrestle the gas can from Robin as Brook grabs his other arm. Robin hugs Brook hard as he goes to his knees in bitter tears.

DISSOLVE TO:

AMAZING GRACE plays on the bagpipes as the church fills up. A memorial board displays "In Loving Memory" and pictures of Toby and Sarah. Ally is crying. Sam is gathering her courage. Chris and Brook are torn and numb. Robin is comforted by the towns folk as they pass by him. Brook walks up to the pulpit.

BROOKLYN

Ladies and gentlemen, at this time our baby sister Samantha would like to dedicate a song she wrote for her big sister and to Toby. Sam?

Tess stands up with a big metal bucket. Sam shakes her head "no". Tess is touched at Sam for conquering her fear.

SAMANTHA

HEY LORD, CAN I BEND YOU EAR? IT'S BEEN A DAY AND I NEED YOU NEAR TEACH ME HOW TO KNOW YOU AND BE STRONG WHEN SO MANY I WAS COUNTING ON ARE ALREADY GONE

THE GIRLS SHE'S SINGING IN THE ANGEL CHOIR HE'S IN A GLORY BAND THERE'S A HOLY FIRE WARMED BY GOD'S OWN HAND

SAMANTHA IF THEY COULD HEAR ME I KNOW WHAT I'D SAY... HEY...

THE GIRLS

IT'S 10 A.M. AND ALREADY BEEN A LONG MISS THEM DAY AND THAT'S WHEN HEAVEN NEVER FELT SO FAR AWAY

Sam gets caught up in the loss of her sister and runs into the arms of Tess. Brook convinces Chris to take over the next verse.

CHRISTINE I WILL SEE MY LOVED ONES ALL TOO SOON BUT HEAVEN'S AS FAR AS THE MAN IN THE MOON

CHRISTINE/BROOKLYN HERE'S HOPING THEY HAVE NOT FORGOTTEN ME COME THE DAY I CLOSE MY EYES

THE GIRLS I WILL OPEN THEM AND SEE

HER SINGING IN THE ANGEL CHOIR HE'S IN THE GLORY BAND AND THERE'S A HOLY FIRE (MORE) AND WHEN THEY SEE ME I KNOW WHAT WE'LL SAY IT'S 10 A.M. AND ALREADY BEEN ONE GLORIOUS DAY NO WONDER HEAVEN ALWAYS FELT SO FAR AWAY

SAMANTHA THAT'S WHY HEAVEN FELT SO... VERY FAR AWAY.

There is a stunned silence in the room. The girls hug Sam. Robin stares at them in disbelief. As the music plays a reprise of Sam's song the girls each plant a kiss on the two pictures.

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. KELSEY HOME DECK - EVENING

Robin is sitting by himself. Tess comes outside to see if she can comfort him in any way.

TESS Pretty chilly out here.

ROBIN

Numbs the pain.

TESS

So what now?

ROBIN

Good question... Rather than burn down those stables... maybe it's time to move on. Get a fresh start somewhere far away from here.

TESS Sounds more like running away.

ROBIN

Maybe so.

TESS Is that the best thing for those daughters of yours?

ROBIN I don't know. Maybe... maybe not.

TESS Why not ask them?

ROBIN

I'm afraid to.

Afraid?!

ROBIN Afraid I'd say something or do something that would make them hate me as much as Sarah must have.

TESS She didn't hate you Robin. That's crazy.

ROBIN Is it? The last thing I did to her was slap her across the face. I've never laid a hand on any of my girls.

TESS Well too bad!... for Ally's sake.

ROBIN

They both laugh.

Tess, I'm lost. TESS For the moment. ROBIN And I'm... I'm... TESS Feeling pretty sorry for yourself? ROBIN I honestly can't help it. TESS

Robin, why don't you take some of your own advice for a change?

ROBIN

And do what?

TESS

Pray! Pray to God! Only this time stop doing all the talking and maybe do a whole lot more listening.

ROBIN I don't have the strength. TESS Well good. Cause the stronger you think you are the less you need of Him.

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. INSIDE THE FUNERAL PARLOR SANCTUARY - CONTINUOUS

Gene is sitting in the front row staring at the cross. Chester is beside him. He stares at at picture of his wife. As the intro of the song, "If My People Plays" Gene looks up and sees a light on the cross. He looks towards the street but no light is shining through. He sets Chester down on the pew and walks up to the pulpit and sings:

EXT. OMAR ROAD - CONTINUOUS

As the song is sung Robin gets out of his car and WALKS to the edge where Anne and Sarah both perished. The moon is full and bright. The ice on the lake glistens.

GENE (V.O.) IF MY PEOPLE, WHO ARE CALLED BY MY NAME WILL HUMBLE THEMSELVES AND PRAY AND SEEK MY FACE AND TURN FROM THEIR WICKED WAYS THEN I WILL HEAR FROM HEAVEN AND I WILL HEAL THEIR LAND

Robin contemplates ending his life. He is a completely beaten man. He tries to FALL FORWARD down the cliff but fails. During the next section of the song he SITS DOWN on the edge of the cliff. There is a reflection from the moonlight close to his hand. He reaches down and finds Sarah's necklace containing a cross and the key to Anne's box.

> GENE FOR I ALONE AM GOD AND I'M LONGING FOR MY CHILDREN TO COME HOME AT LAST TO WRAP THEM IN MY ARMS AND TAKE AWAY THEIR PAIN AND FEAR AND IN MY TENDER MERCY DRY UP ALL OF THEIR TEARS

Ext. OUTSIDE THE KELSEY STABLES

As the music continues Robin is now standing in the middle of the Kelsey ranch yard holding up the necklace. He is both broken and angry. Snow falls on him.

INT. INSIDE THE STABLES

Robin walks into the stables and hangs the necklace on the horn of one of the saddles that sits on a wooden rail. He folds over the saddle in tears.

Anne APPEARS and calls Robin's name. She is wearing a white flowing gown. Robin is startled at first. He stumbles towards her in complete humility and FALLS TO HIS KNEES before her, begging for her forgiveness. She strokes his head. Robin looks up and she takes his hand and they do a beautiful ballroom/ballet dance. During this dance FLASHBACK moments take place of Anne and Robins' life together - their wedding day, the birth of Sarah, going for a romantic walk, a kiss, Anne looking up at Robin as he preaches etc. Every lift in the dance should put them in a different space such as in the middle of a riding arena, a ballroom, the Kelsey living room, a field etc.

GENE

SO COME UNTO ME IF YOU'RE WEARY AND ALL ALONE AND I WILL GIVE YOU REST COME UNTO ME IF YOU'RE SAD AND BROKEN AND STAND BEFORE MY THRONE AND BE BLESSED

IF MY PEOPLE, WHO ARE CALLED BY MY NAME WILL HUMBLE THEMSELVES AND PRAY AND SEEK MY FACE AND TURN FROM THEIR WICKED WAYS THEN I WILL HEAR FROM HEAVEN AND I, I WILL HEAL THEIR LAND

As the song ends Anne gives Robin a kiss. He opens his eyes and she is gone.

INT. CHURCH SANCTUARY -- SUNDAY SERVICE - NEXT MORNING

The scene opens with everyone singing the last verse of the hymn, "Holy Holy Holy".

ROBIN Thank you all for coming out on this frosty Sunday morning and for your continuing words of comfort-

TESS

(standing) And casseroles.

ROBIN

-to me and my family. (pauses to review) I...have been your pastor at Grace Community church for as long as I can remember. This was all I ever wanted to do and in many ways all I really (MORE) ROBIN (CONT'D) cared about... But in seeking God's will, I fear a change is necessary. For both you and my family. It is time for someone else to lead you--

There is a MURMUR of disagreement.

ROBIN (CONT'D) I know... My friends... last night I prayed for God to show me my heart. Be careful what you pray for. I stand before you as someone who has failed God, my family and all of you.

There is another murmur of disagreement.

ROBIN (CONT'D) No, no. It's true. Eighteen years ago I stood here as a young proud seminary graduate. But what I became was an angry bitter man who in the end really only cared about himself while playing the part of your Pastor. Reveling in the power of telling everyone else how to live right for God. A God I shut out the day an amazing young beautiful woman became Anne Marie Kelsey, my wife. Ι knew I was unworthy of her love and because of that I became this jealous, pathetic excuse of a man. Demanding that she serve me, unconditionally. Give up all that she was, her hopes and dreams, her gifts. Give up everything to satisfy my own insecurity and my need to feel loved. Little did I know that the kind of love I was searching for could only be found in God. A God who loved me enough to sacrifice His only son for me and for you. In the end Anne died, but not as a judgment of God as I allowed myself and you to believe. No! Her car slipped on an icy road, and that's all.

GLADYS

(aside) Hmm! I don't believe that for one minute.

ROBIN But the real tragedy is all of us have used her death to feed and (MORE) ROBIN (CONT'D) nourish the darkest parts of our lives. Our own self righteousness!

There is a murmur of disagreement.

ROBIN (CONT'D) Friends, when God showed me exactly who I was I had only two choices left life or death. Today I choose life, for me and my fiv-... my four daughters.

MEMBER 1 We love you Pastor!

ROBIN And I love you as well. Only today I truly mean it.

GLADYS

Rubbish!

DAD

Yes, rubbish!

ROBIN

Gladys? Daisy? Do you have something to say?

GLADYS

We most certainly do. All this talk of being righteous like it's some horrible two headed monster!

CHESTER Yeah, Gladys and Daisy.

ROBIN

Not now, Chester.

DAISY The bible says to be perfect just as He is perfect.

Robin opens his bible.

ROBIN Yes. But!.. The bible also says-

GLADYS Pastor Robin! We have heard ENOUGH!

ROBIN

But-

GLADYS

Need I remind you and everyone here that the best clothes owned by your deceased wife were found scattered down that canyon wall. The woman was abandoning her family with that... that womanizing horse trainer, Colin Pearson!! Plain and simple irrefutable facts! And now, like mother, like daughter, the apple has grazed the tree on its way to the ground and once again caused this entire community nothing BUT GRIEF !! I challenge anyone in this room to contradict me. Anyone? Anyone at Hmm! all? I-

Sarah walks onto the church, followed by Toby.

SARAH

(shouts) I challenge that!

The congregation gasps.

ROBIN Sarah? SARAH!!!

Robin RUNS down the aisle and hugs her. Sam and Ally hug each other. Tess and Brook hug each other. Chris stares in unbelief. Robin sees Toby and can't help but show his anger. Toby backs away in fear.

TOBY

Pastor Robin, I-

ROBIN I trusted you! And this is how you REPAY ME?!

Robin lunges at Toby. Sarah pulls him back.

SARAH Papa, NO! No, it was all my idea. Please. I need everyone to hear something.

ROBIN

Hear what?

SARAH You'll understand in a moment. Please... Sarah motions for everyone to sit. She pulls out Anne's diary from her backpack, then sets it on the pulpit.

SARAH (CONT'D) Forgive our intrusion and accept my heartfelt apology for the sadness I've caused all of you and my family. Sometimes the decisions we make in a moment of great pain or...sacrifice... are the ones we end up regretting the most. That's why I'm here today, to make everything right.

The congregation murmurs.

DAISY Well! I think we've heard enough. Gladys?

Chester leans his face between the two ladies.

CHESTER Sit down and button up lady!

DAISY Oh shut up! You, you DUMMY!

Daisy slaps Chester with her glove.

SARAH

Thank you Mr.Perleman. I'd like to read from the last entry of my mother's diary if I may. Gladys? You wanted someone to challenge your belief?

Gladys looks away. Sarah opens up the diary to the last entry.

GLADYS

Hmm!

SARAH

"Dear Diary, in order to save my marriage to my beloved Robin I am giving up my horse training. As of this day I will devote my life to God, my husband, and my daughters. (*She looks up and recites from memory*) Colin has accepted a position to train horses and future Olympians at a stable near his only sister, who is not well and needs help in beating breast cancer. To cheer her up I am sending Colin home with a suitcase (MORE) SARAH (CONT'D) full of some of my favorite things to wear. (She looks back down at the diary) While Robin is at church I am going to brave the icy roads and drive Colin to the...airport."

Sarah closes the diary.

SARAH (CONT'D) Now. Would anyone like to challenge these last words of my mother?

Chester leans in and peers at Gladys. Her and Daisy bow their heads in shame.

ROBIN But Sarah... We...we thought you were dead.

SARAH I know and I'm so sorry.

ROBIN

But why?

SARAH (soberly) The truth, Papa?

ROBIN

Of coarse.

SARAH I wanted to destroy you! The same way you destroyed our mother.

Robin looks down in shame. He can't help but cry.

SARAH (CONT'D) But I couldn't live with myself. (she cries) Can you forgive me?

ROBIN

The question is - can you forgive me?

He walks over to her and they hug.

ROBIN (CONT'D) I have something for you... and your sisters.

Robin retrieves a binder hidden inside his own pulpit.

ROBIN (CONT'D)

This binder contains the songs your mother wrote. It's time we sang some of these.

SARAH

Oh Papa.

Robin hands the binder to Sarah.

ROBIN

There's a song she wrote a few days before she died. I'd like to sing it if that's okay. Maybe you girls could join me after you hear it once.

The girls all nod in agreement. Robin takes the binder from Sarah. As the music starts. The four sisters storm Sarah for a reunion hug.
