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FADE IN:

EXT. FREEWAY, 1977 - DAY

A NERVOUS LOOKING MAN, 30's, fiddles with his hi-tech 8-track car stereo as he drives his VW Bug on the freeway.

A School Bus full of Children passes. The Children wave and the man smiles back giving a nod.

He sticks a John Denver 8-track in.

WE HEAR: "Almost heaven---"

And then out of nowhere, A RED TRUCK cuts in front of the VW Bug.

The Nervous Man pumps the brakes to no avail. The brakes do not work! The VW Bug veers off into another lane and spins out of control. It rams into a call box on the side of the freeway.

The same RED TRUCK causes another car to slam on their brakes and the car rams into the school bus full of children. The school bus flips onto its side.

The school bus bursts into flames.

The Children on the bus begin SCREAMING.

The Nervous man immediately jumps out of his car, runs over to the bus, and begins to save the children on board.

He pulls all of them out and goes back one more time to make sure he got everyone.

The bus explodes.

DISSOLVE TO:

EXT. BUSINESS COMPLEX IN HEAVEN - DAY

Clouds float in and around a business complex in heaven. A HIGH-RISE is seen in the center of the complex.

Angels, not your typical looking angels with wings, but very up to date business looking types in suits carrying briefcases and laptops.

INT. HIGH RISE IN HEAVEN - DAY

Angels walk back and forth through the lobby. Each of them wears a NAME-TAG MADE OF GOLDEN WINGS. Each names begins with "Saint..."

DELBERT, a bumbling accident-prone guardian angel, prances into the lobby carrying a laptop computer in his hand. He looks down and sees his name-tag is crooked and tries to straighten it.

CU. OF NAME-TAG: SAINT DELBERT

Delbert's name-tag is made of SILVER rather than gold.

Delbert WHISTLES as he walks, not paying attention to where he is going, and runs smack dab into NICK, an egotistical get ahead no matter who's in the way kind of angel.

Delbert's laptop hits Nick in the arm and drops to the floor.

Delbert bends down to pick it up and falls down in the process. Nick pulls out his handkerchief and wipes his arm off.

NICK

Watch where you're walking Delbert?

Delbert picks up his laptop and stands back up.

DELBERT

I'm sorry Nick.

NICK

That's Saint Nick to you.

DELBERT

I'm sorry Saint Nick. I was---

NICK

Save it. Pay attention to what you're doing Delbert. That's not a toy you're carrying around there. You're lucky my suit wasn't damaged.

DELBERT

You're right. I need to pay better attention.

NICK

I'd hate to be your client Delbert. How on earth did you make it up here anyway?

DELBERT

Well, I don't know exactly.

NICK

Stop your senseless rambling and get back to work.

Nick shakes his head and walks away mumbling to himself.

NICK (CONT'D)
Somebody sure screwed up here.

DELBERT
Yes sir. I'm on my way.

Delbert makes his way towards the elevator and waits. A crowd of Angels pile on to the elevator as it opens, pushing Delbert to the back of the elevator.

INT. ELEVATOR - DAY

Delbert is pushed tightly against the back wall of the elevator. The FLOOR NUMBERS on the elevator are seen going up. It stops on 27.

Delbert slowly tries to make his way to the doors.

DELBERT
Excuse me. Coming through. This is my---

He annoys several Angels as he accidentally bumps into them on his way out of the elevator.

The elevator doors open up and they push Delbert out of the elevator.

INT. OFFICE LOBBY - DAY

Delbert flies out into the lobby and trips in front of the reception desk. His laptop falls to the floor again. The elevator door closes with the angels giggling.

RUTH, an older receptionist, looks down at Delbert from behind her desk. She smiles.

RUTH
Are you okay Delbert?

Delbert picks up his laptop again and stands up.

DELBERT
Oh...Yes...I'm just fine. Thank you Ruth. Are there any messages or anything?

Ruth looks down at her scheduling book.

RUTH
No, but you do have a board meeting at 2:00 this afternoon with the Big Guy.

DELBERT

Okay. Great. I'll be there then.

Delbert grins and walks to his office. He opens the door, turns to Ruth, smiles again, and then trips into his office.

Ruth shakes her head as though this has happened many times before.

INT. DELBERT'S OFFICE - DAY

Delbert sets his laptop down on his messy desk and then walks over to the window and attempts to open the blinds.

He accidentally grabs the blind rod too hard and breaks it in half. He fumbles with it and tries to put it back on, but he ends up breaking it in half again.

He shrugs his shoulders, tosses the rod into the garbage can, forces open the blinds and looks out the window.

He sees a bird's eye view overlooking the entire business complex in heaven. Golden streets are filled with Angels walking to and fro in a cloud like atmosphere. Delbert takes in the view as a golden sunlight reflects off his face.

DISSOLVE TO:

PRESENT DAY APPEARS ON SCREEN

EXT. UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA CAMPUS - ESTABLISHING - MORNING

The sunrise breaks through the mountains and over this picturesque college campus. We draw closer to an apartment complex in the background and gently into a bedroom

INT. KIRBY FALON'S ROOM - SAME

We enter the messy room of KIRBY FALON, early twenties, a creative-writing senior who sleeps soundly in his bed. He smiles as he dreams.

DISSOLVE TO:

EXT. DREAM SEQUENCE - DAY

Kirby rambles down the middle of the University of Arizona campus.

He is the only one there except for a girl he sees slowly walking towards him. This is JULIE MONROE, early twenties, a dream come true.

She approaches and then suddenly stops when she reaches Kirby. She gazes upon Kirby's eyes and smiles.

Kirby slowly leans over and kisses Julie. They embrace as though they are lifelong lovers...Soul-mates.

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. KIRBY'S ROOM - DAY

A RADIO ALARM CLOCK. It reads 6:45. The RADIO ALARM suddenly goes off MUSIC BLASTING. Kirby, undisturbed by the sudden alarm blast, grins as he slowly opens his eyes.

INT. KITCHEN - DAY

Kirby glides into the kitchen and opens up the refrigerator.

He sees a few bottles of beer, a half-empty bottle of ketchup and mustard, and a half-eaten bagel. He grabs the bagel and shuts the door.

He takes a look at the bagel and then takes a bite. He then walks over and sits down at the table.

DAVE, Kirby's roommate and 10th year senior, slowly walks into the kitchen. He sees Kirby eating the bagel.

DAVE
Any more bagels?

KIRBY
No, this is the last of them.

DAVE
This is not a problem.

Dave opens the refrigerator and grabs a beer. He closes the door and grabs a box of Trix off the counter. He grabs a bowl from a sink full of dishes and sits down next to Kirby.

KIRBY
You're not going to believe what
kind of dream I had last night?

DAVE
You had a wet dream? Awesome.

Dave begins to pour the Trix into the bowl.

KIRBY
No, I didn't have a wet dream. It
was something much better.

Dave opens the beer and pours it over his Trix.

DAVE

The only thing that could be better than a wet dream is actually laying the pipe. So which one was it?

Dave takes a bite of his Trix. Kirby looks at him in disgust.

KIRBY

How can you eat that?

DAVE

I just put the spoon to my mouth and munch. This stuff is loaded with the essentials. Protein and sugar. You can't buy better nutrition.

KIRBY

Well anyway, I met the girl of my dreams.

DAVE

You met the girl of your dreams in your wet dream?

KIRBY

I didn't have a wet dream.

DAVE

Then how you'd get lucky?

KIRBY

I didn't get lucky Dave. I just had a dream with the girl of my dreams in it.

DAVE

Oh.

Dave takes another bite of his Trix.

KIRBY

She was a vision of beauty Dave. I was walking on campus and our eyes just met. It was like two stars colliding, you know, like when two people find each other.

DAVE

That's nice.

KIRBY

She was like destiny written by the golden pen of heaven itself.

Dave nods his head.

DAVE

You need to get out more Kirby.
These creative writing classes you're
taking are really getting to you.

(Burps)

Speaking of classes, what time is
it? I got an 11:00 pottery class.

Kirby looks at his watch.

KIRBY

It's only 7:30.

DAVE

What the hell am I doing up so early?
You're the one with the 8:00.

Dave get's up from the table and starts for his bedroom.
Kirby grabs his backpack and heads for the door.

KIRBY

Meet you at cafeteria for lunch.

DAVE (O.S.)

Right. See you Romeo.

Kirby walks out the door.

EXT. UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA COLLEGE CAMPUS - DAY

Kirby crosses the street and walks onto campus.

The campus is full of hustle and bustle with Students walking
and riding bikes. Kirby listens to his I-Pod and walks along
occasionally glancing at the passing girls.

INT. DELBERT'S OFFICE - DAY

Delbert finishes looking out the window and walks over to
his desk. He opens up his laptop and turns it on.

ON LAPTOP SCREEN

Delbert watches as Kirby enters the lecture hall. Delbert
smiles and leans back in his chair. He leans too far back
and falls backwards onto the floor. His feet stand straight
up in the air.

INT. COLLEGE LECTURE HALL - SAME

Kirby walks into a large lecture hall and looks for a place
to sit. Numerous Students enter and sit throughout the hall.
Kirby finds a place to sit in back. He takes off his I-pod
and puts it into his backpack.

He pulls out a notebook and pen and glances around the lecture hall. He then notices Julie, (the college girl from his dream), hurry down the aisle and sit towards the front.

He sits up quickly and stares. Kirby watches her in a slow motion trance as Julie pulls her notebook out from her backpack and shakes her hair gently. Kirby closes his eyes and shakes his head in disbelief.

KIRBY

It's her.

Kirby slowly opens one eye at a time and focuses on Julie again.

A HIPPIE STUDENT, sitting next to Kirby, observes Kirby's behavior.

KIRBY (CONT'D)

Unbelievable.

Kirby pinches himself to make sure that he is not dreaming.

Hippie Student leans over to Kirby.

HIPPIE STUDENT

You alright dude?

KIRBY

Yeah. It's incredible isn't it?
She's actually there.

Hippie student looks at Kirby with a cat-like grin.

HIPPIE STUDENT

Dude, you've got to set me up with
your connection. It must be some
pretty righteous stuff huh?

Kirby looks at Hippie student strangely.

KIRBY

Sure, I guess you can call her
righteous, but I'm not about to set
you up before I even get a chance to
meet her.

Kirby looks back over at Julie. Hippie student looks confused.

HIPPIE STUDENT

I can dig it man.

INT. DELBERT'S OFFICE - DAY

Delbert tries to sharpen a pencil and is not having too much success at it. He does not notice his laptop where a GREEN LIGHT marked DESTINY keeps flashing.

INT. COLLEGE LECTURE HALL - AFTER CLASS

The PROFESSOR finishes up his lecture.

PROFESSOR

Remember next Thursday is our first exam of the semester. I suggest you all start to study now, it's a doozy.

He chuckles. None of the students respond.

PROFESSOR (CONT'D)

That's all for today.

The students begin to get up and leave. Kirby quickly gets up and tries to make his way up front to Julie.

Julie puts her notebook in her backpack. She stands and turns to leave. Kirby reaches the end of the aisle and stares at her. She stops.

JULIE

Can I help you?

Kirby just stands and stares. He then realizes he's just standing there and tries to speak.

KIRBY

I...Just...

JULIE

Okay. Could you please excuse me?
I have to get to my next class.

Kirby moves out of the way. Julie walks by him and makes her way out of the lecture hall.

INT. DELBERT'S OFFICE - SAME MOMENT

Delbert finally gets his pencil sharpened. He smiles and notices his laptop and the destiny button BLINKING RED.

He panics and hits the button quickly with the pencil. The pencil breaks.

He tosses the pencil across the room and hits the destiny button with his finger. He keeps pushing the button in desperation.

ON LAPTOP SCREEN

He sees Julie walk past Kirby. Kirby stands there and watches her walk out of the lecture hall.

INT. COLLEGE LECTURE HALL - SAME MOMENT

Kirby slaps himself on the head.

KIRBY

What was that? The one time in my life I can't put a simple sentence together, but I can fluently speak caveman linguistics? She must think I'm the biggest dork.

He slaps himself on the head again and slowly walks out of the lecture hall.

INT. DELBERT'S OFFICE - SAME MOMENT

Delbert looks on in disbelief.

DELBERT

Uh-oh?

Delbert leans back in his chair and slaps himself on the top of his head. The slap accidentally causes him to fall over in his chair again.

EXT. STUDENT UNION - DAY

Kirby walks up the entrance of the Student Union on the center of campus. Various STUDENTS sit outside eating, talking, and studying. Kirby enters the building.

INT. CAFETERIA - SAME

Kirby walks into the cafeteria and grabs himself a chocolate milk and a hamburger. He pays for it and looks around at the tables to find Dave.

He sees Dave sitting in the corner and walks over to the table and sits across from him.

Dave is too busy munching on a chili-cheese dog and doesn't notice Kirby sit down. Dave finally looks up with chili on his lip and notices Kirby.

Dave smiles and dips his chili-cheese dog into a bowl of ice cream and takes another bite. Kirby looks on with disgust.

KIRBY

You really have quite the appetite?

DAVE
What's up Kirby?

KIRBY
I met her Dave.

DAVE
You met who?

KIRBY
The girl I was telling you about
this morning.

DAVE
The chick from your dream?

KIRBY
Yeah, she was in my philosophy class
this morning. She just walked in and
sat down. It was like destiny or
something.

Dave stops eating for a second.

DAVE
I think your parents might have read
you one to many fairy tales while
you were growing up Kirby. This is
way to far out.

KIRBY
I know it sounds crazy.

DAVE
Kirby, there is no such thing as
destiny. You probably saw this girl
somewhere on campus and imagined
this whole thing. A coincidence or
something.

KIRBY
It was not coincidence Dave, and I
did not imagine it.

DAVE
Well if you didn't, then what's this
girl's name?

KIRBY
I don't know. I tried to introduce
myself, but for some strange reason
I couldn't talk.

Dave shakes his head and starts eating again.

DAVE

You have some wet dream about this girl, run into her coincidentally, and you didn't even get her name?

KIRBY

Yes, but I didn't have a wet dream about her.

DAVE

Whatever. The point is that you didn't even get her name, so basically you had more luck with her in your dream, then you did in real life.

Kirby ponders a moment.

KIRBY

Yeah, you're probably right. I don't know. It just seemed so real.

Kirby looks at his hamburger and pushes it over to Dave.

DAVE

You don't want it?

KIRBY

No, I've lost my appetite. I have to get over to the library finish a writing assignment. I'll see you later.

Kirby stands up and picks up his backpack. He starts to walk away.

DAVE

Hey Kirby.

Kirby turns around.

DAVE (CONT'D)

Look at the bright side.

KIRBY

What's that?

DAVE

You can do some great writing with that imagination.

Kirby gives a half smile and walks away. Dave dips the hamburger in the ice cream and takes a bite.

INT. DELBERT'S OFFICE - DAY

Delbert has his feet propped up on the desk and is taking a cat nap. RUTH'S VOICE calls over the intercom.

RUTH (V.O.)

Delbert! It's time for the board meeting.

Delbert wakes up startled and falls backwards in his chair.

He gets back up and presses the intercom.

DELBERT

Uh...Thanks Ruth...I was just about to go. Ten-four.

RUTH

And ten-four to you Delbert. Don't forget your laptop and pager.

DELBERT

Will do...Thanks again...Over and out.

Delbert pushes the intercom button and gets his finger stuck in the process. He tries to pull it out but to no avail.

He then props his foot onto the desk and tries to push and pull with leverage. He pulls too hard and falls backwards onto the floor.

INT. OFFICE BOARD ROOM - DAY

Nick and 7 MEMBERS OF THE ANGEL BOARD sit at a long conference table. They talk amongst themselves and work on their laptop's.

The BIG GUY, a distinguished older looking gentleman dressed in golfing attire, enters the room.

All of the Angels stand up as he passes. Nick stands up and escorts the Big Guy to his chair at the end of the table.

NICK

Good afternoon sir.

Nick pulls the Big Guy's chair out as he sits down.

BIG GUY

Thank you Saint Nick. That's mighty kind of you.

NICK

No problem at all sir.

Nick smirks and heads back to his seat. All of the Angels stand at attention. The Big Guy looks around.

BIG GUY
What is this, a marine convention?
Sit down already.

All of the Angels sit down.

BIG GUY (CONT'D)
I've got a tee time at 3:00 so let's
get started.

The Big Guy notices that there is an empty chair where Delbert is supposed to be.

BIG GUY (CONT'D)
Has anyone seen St. Delbert anywhere?

NICK
He's probably daydreaming again sir.
May I suggest...

BIG GUY
I'm sure he'll be here any second
now.

At that moment, the door flies open and Delbert enters the room at full force.

He slips on the slick floor and trips onto the table sliding halfway down it. He finally stops in the middle of the table.

DELBERT
Good afternoon.

The other Angels look amused as Delbert tries to gather himself and crawl across the table to his seat.

BIG GUY
(Smiling)
Glad you could join us St. Delbert.

Delbert crawls into his seat.

DELBERT
I was running just a little behind
sir. I had a last minute detail to
clear up with my client.

BIG GUY
That's quite all right. I'm glad to
see that you're so committed to your
work.

Nick turns to the Angel beside him.

NICK
He should be committed.

BIG GUY
Well, now that everyone's here, let's
get started shall we?

The lights dim in the room and a computer like image projects onto a screen in the front of the room. It displays a graph depicting numbers of souls lost and saved.

BIG GUY (CONT'D)
As you can see, our competition is
rapidly gaining ground on us.

The Big Guy points to the graph. Nick looks on with anticipation.

EXT. MIDDLE OF COLLEGE CAMPUS - DAY

A large Crowd of Students are gathered around for a rally.

A banner that reads "NATIONAL COMING OUT DAY: SHOW YOUR PRIDE AND WALK THROUGH THE DOOR. BE PROUD TO BE GAY."

Large Speaker's blast Diana Ross song "I'M COMING OUT"

A door-frame painted in rainbow colors sits in the middle of all of the students. A podium is positioned near the door with ALEXANDER, a student gay rights leader, giving an inspirational speech.

ALEXANDER
Come on people. This is 2008. We
don't have to hide in the closet
anymore. Show your gay pride and
walk through the doorway. Prove to
yourself and everyone here that you're
not afraid...but damn proud. We're
all in this together.

The CROWD CHEERS. A line begins to form near the doorway.

At the same moment, Kirby walks along the lawn on his way to the library. He wears his I-Pod and doesn't pay attention to where he is walking and accidentally walks past the people lined up near the doorway.

He walks through the doorway without knowing what he has done. Alexander runs over to him and gives him a hug.

ALEXANDER (CONT'D)

That's great man. You're an
inspiration to us all.

Kirby looks confused. He takes off his headphones.

KIRBY

I'm just going to the library. It's
no big deal.

ALEXANDER

It's no big deal? Can you believe
this guy? So humble and yet so brave.
Just an ordinary guy on his way to
the library. We're all just ordinary
people. I love you man.

The CROWD CHEERS.

Alexander gives Kirby a hug again. Several Photographers
take a picture of this moment. Kirby grins and waves to the
photographers and to the crowd. The Crowd CHEERS again.

Kirby shrugs his shoulders and continues on his way to the
library.

Various students begin to form a small line to walk through
the door. A big FOOTBALL PLAYER looks on, pauses, and then
runs through the door.

FOOTBALL PLAYER

If it wasn't for that brave guy, I
don't think I would have ever walked
through the door.

ALEXANDER

I know. I know. We owe it all to...?
What was his name?

INT. OFFICE BOARD ROOM - DAY

The Big Guy continues with his speech.

BIG GUY

This last quarter alone we've lost
25% of our clients. Our lowly
competition is using whatever means
possible to obtain our accounts. I
want all of you to pay close attention
to your clients until we get a handle
on the situation. So everyone keep
up the good work and let's make life
count today.

Everyone applauds. Nick sneers over at Delbert. Delbert's PAGER suddenly goes off in the VIBRATING MODE. Delbert fumbles to stop the pager. Everyone begins to file out of the board room.

The Big Guy passes by Delbert and gives him a pat on the back.

BIG GUY (CONT'D)

You're doing a fine job St. Delbert.
Keep up the good work.

DELBERT

Thank you sir. I'm trying my best.

BIG GUY

That's all I ask.

The Big Guy smiles and walks out of the board room. Nick walks over to Delbert.

NICK

Kissing up to the Big Guy again heh'
Delbert? You're so pathetic.

DELBERT

No, I was just...

NICK

Save it for somebody who cares wing-boy. You'll be pulling guard duty at the river Styx if you keep this up.

DELBERT

Keep what up?

NICK

All in due time Del-boy. All in due time.

Nick smiles deviously at Delbert and walks out of the board room. Delbert's pager goes off again. Delbert hits his pager and then opens up his laptop.

He sees the destiny button BLINKING RED.

DELBERT

Not again.

Delbert hits the button several times.

ON THE LAPTOP SCREEN

He sees a photograph of Kirby hugging Alexander with the title "BEING GAY IS NO BIG DEAL!" Delbert gulps.

DELBERT (CONT'D)

Oh boy.

Delbert looks around at the empty board room and slowly closes his laptop.

INT. COLLEGE LECTURE HALL - MORNING

Julie sits reading the student newspaper. Kirby walks into the lecture hall and sees her sitting down. He walks up to her and sits in the seat next to her.

KIRBY

Is this seat taken?

Julie looks up from the paper.

JULIE

No, go ahead.

KIRBY

I'm sorry if I made you feel uncomfortable yesterday. I'm just not very good at introductions.

JULIE

No, I thought what you did was extremely brave. It took a lot of courage.

KIRBY

Really?

JULIE

I can see why now. How long have you known?

KIRBY

Well...You're going to think this is kind of weird, but it all came to me in a dream.

JULIE

Wow, that is really interesting. By the way, my name's Julie.

She holds out her hand to shake Kirby's hand. Kirby smiles and shakes her hand.

KIRBY
Kirby. Kirby Falon.

JULIE
That was a great picture of you in
the paper. Would you like an extra
copy for your scrapbook?

Kirby looks confused.

KIRBY
Picture?

JULIE
Yeah, right here on the front page.

Julie hands the paper to Kirby and shows him the picture of
him hugging Alexander with the title "BEING GAY: IT'S NO BIG
DEAL!"

Kirby eyes pop open as he sees the picture.

KIRBY
Uh...This is a huge mistake. I don't
think you understand?

JULIE
You're not having second thoughts
now are you?

KIRBY
Julie, I'm not even having first
thoughts. Excuse me, but I have to
go.

Kirby stands up quickly with the paper in his hand.

JULIE
What's wrong?

Kirby begins to back out of the row.

KIRBY
Oh, just everything.

Kirby rushes out of the lecture hall. Julie shakes her head
in confusion.

INT. KIRBY'S APARTMENT - DAY

Kirby rushes into his apartment and runs directly to Dave's
room. Dave is sleeping with a blanket covering his whole
body. Kirby begins to shake him.

KIRBY

Dave! Dave! Wake up!

Dave tosses off the blanket. His head is at the foot of the bed. Kirby is holding onto his feet. Dave looks up.

DAVE

I'm awake already. What is the problemo?

Kirby turns around to face Dave. He hands him the paper.

KIRBY

Can you believe it?

Dave sits up in bed and looks at the picture.

DAVE

This is the girl of your dreams?

KIRBY

No! Now she thinks I'm gay.

DAVE

This guy thinks you're gay?

KIRBY

No, Julie does.

DAVE

Who's Julie?

KIRBY

The girl from my dream.

DAVE

Oh. I wouldn't worry about that.

KIRBY

Why not?

DAVE

Well, the way I see it, the whole campus thinks you're gay.

KIRBY

Dave, what should I do?

DAVE

First of all, stop hugging guys.
Second of all, get off my bed.

Kirby gets off the bed and paces around the room.

KIRBY
My life is over.

Kirby bangs his head against the wall.

DAVE
Look on the bright side Kirby.

KIRBY
What's that?

Dave points to the picture on the paper.

DAVE
At least this guy thinks you're cute.

Kirby slumps to the floor.

DAVE (CONT'D)
I didn't think the picture was that bad?

KIRBY
My life as I know it is ruined.

DAVE
I wouldn't go that far Kirby. You're life before was never that much to talk about anyway. This actually adds a little flair to it.

KIRBY
I'm serious Dave.

DAVE
I'm just joking. Let me think about this a moment.

Dave ponders in thought while Kirby anxiously awaits an answer. Dave pauses awhile.

KIRBY
Well?

DAVE
Nothing is coming to me at the moment. Let's get some breakfast. I think better when I eat.

KIRBY
It's great to know my life is in the hands of your rumbling stomach?

DAVE
Isn't though?

INT. DELBERT'S OFFICE - DAY

Delbert is startled as he looks up at Nick.

DELBERT

Uh...St. Nick. I didn't know you
were here.

NICK

You see what I mean about paying
attention Delbert? You need to pay
more attention to what's going on
around you, especially with your
client.

DELBERT

How did you know about Kirby?

NICK

I'd hate to be you when the Big Guy
finds out.

DELBERT

You won't tell him will you?

Nick sits on the corner of Delbert's desk.

NICK

Would I do that to you?

DELBERT

I don't know.

NICK

You know what your problem is
Delbert? You're a screw up.

(MORE)

NICK (CONT'D)

The only reason you made it up here in the first place was because you were a walking accident when you were on Earth.

Nick walks around Delbert's office.

NICK (CONT'D)

I can't believe you had the gall to break my record.

DELBERT

I didn't mean to Nick...I mean St. Nick. What record might that be?

NICK

Human lives saved.

DELBERT

Oh, the bus. I was just trying to save the kids. I didn't even have a chance to think.

NICK

That's really not too hard to comprehend Delbert. The only reason you're a guardian angel up here in the first place is because of your blundering heroics.

DELBERT

I was just trying to do my best.

NICK

Well, your best is being a pain in my left wing. Your incompetence cost me my promotion.

DELBERT

I'm sorry, I didn't mean...

NICK

Zip it! Your client is in serious trouble. Do you want me to help or not?

DELBERT

Yes. What can I do?

NICK

There's only one thing you can do. You have to go back down to earth and try to fix what you've brilliantly already screwed up.

DELBERT

But that's against the rules. I
can't go back to earth. I could
lose my wings for that.

Nick stands back up and points to the laptop.

NICK

I don't think you have any other
choice Delbert.

DELBERT

I guess if that's the only way to
help Kirby?

NICK

Trust me Delbert, it is. And don't
worry, I won't tell a soul. This is
all just between you and me.

Nick smiles deviously and pats Delbert on the shoulder.

INT. OFFICE LOBBY - DAY

Delbert walks out of his office with his laptop in his hand.
He walks over to Ruth.

DELBERT

Ruth, can I ask you a favor?

RUTH

You didn't lock yourself out of your
office again did you?

DELBERT

Surprisingly I didn't. It's something
much bigger.

RUTH

What is it Delbert?

Delbert leans forward with a serious look on his face.

DELBERT

(whispering)

I need you to cover for me for a
little while.

RUTH

What on earth for?

DELBERT

How did you know I was going down to
earth?

RUTH

You're going back down to earth?
Isn't that against heaven's policy?

DELBERT

Yes, it is. But, it's an emergency.
I have to fix a problem with Kirby.

RUTH

Is he in trouble?

DELBERT

He will be if I don't get down there
soon. Can you cover for me? Kirby
is depending on it.

RUTH

You know I will Delbert.

DELBERT

You're an angel Ruth.

RUTH

Not for long if the Big Guy finds
out.

DELBERT

I'll be back as soon as I can. Thanks
again.

RUTH

Be careful Delbert.

Delbert turns to leave.

DELBERT

Don't worry about me.

Delbert trips over his feet and falls to the floor. He hops
up immediately and walks into the elevator.

RUTH

Heaven help him.

EXT. OUTSIDE OF DINER - DAY

Kirby and Dave walk into a 24 hour diner.

INT. DINER - DAY

Kirby and Dave sit at a booth eating breakfast. Dave is
dips his pancakes in his chocolate milk.

DAVE

So...You met this chick...Uh..?

KIRBY

Julie.

DAVE

Yeah, okay. Well, the first thing on our agenda is to let her know that you're not gay.

KIRBY

Brilliant deduction Dave. Are you related to Einstein in anyway?

Dave takes a bite of his pancakes and talks with his mouth full.

DAVE

I don't think so, but I did take a half semester of physics once.

KIRBY

So what do I do?

DAVE

Tell her you're not gay.

Kirby applauds Dave and stands up so that everyone else in the Diner can hear him.

KIRBY

This man is brilliant folks. He's an absolute genius.

Dave waves his hand to the Diner. Kirby shakes his head and sits down.

KIRBY (CONT'D)

Tell her I'm not gay...I could have figured that out on my own Dave.

DAVE

Then why don't you do it?

KIRBY

It's not as easy as that.

DAVE

Why not?

KIRBY

I don't know. I just have this incredible feeling about her and I don't want to blow my chance with her again, that's all.

DAVE

Kirby, telling her you're not gay is not going to blow anything with her. Who knows, she might even blow you.

Dave laughs. Kirby doesn't find it amusing.

DAVE (CONT'D)

Lighten up will you. It's not like she's your soul-mate or anything?

KIRBY

I just have this weird feeling about her.

DAVE

It's called being horny.

KIRBY

Funny. Can you please help me out here?

DAVE

Okay. Kirby, you've come to the right man for a scenario such as this. Desperate measures call for desperate actions.

Dave sips his chocolate milk. Kirby looks frazzled.

Delbert magically appears next to Kirby. He sits with his legs on the seat and his rear on the top of the booth.

DELBERT

He's right you know.

Kirby turns and is shocked by Delbert's sudden appearance and jumps. Kirby is the only one who can see him. Dave watches with curiosity.

KIRBY

(to Delbert)

Where did you come from?

DAVE

What do you mean where did I come from? You know I'm from California.

DELBERT

(to Kirby)

I'm here to help you.

Kirby closes his eyes and shakes his head. He then opens them and looks at Delbert again. Delbert smiles.

KIRBY

Who are you?

DAVE

What do you mean who am I? It's me Dave.

Kirby looks at Dave.

KIRBY

Not you, him?

Kirby points to Delbert. Dave sees nothing.

DAVE

There's nobody else here Kirby.

Delbert accidentally falls off the edge of the booth. Kirby looks again and doesn't see Delbert.

KIRBY

He was just here! Sitting right here. You didn't see him?

DAVE

Can't say I did. Go home and get some rest Kirby.

KIRBY

Um...Yeah...I guess I just have too much on my mind right now. A little too much stress. I'll just go home and get some rest.

DAVE

That's a good idea.

Kirby stands up and walks out of the Diner. Dave watches him and then begins eating again.

EXT. UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA COLLEGE CAMPUS - DAY

Kirby makes his way across campus on his way back home when Delbert suddenly appears out of nowhere.

DELBERT

I'm sorry about that. I haven't quite figured out this appearing thing yet.

Kirby jumps back.

KIRBY

It's happening again.

Kirby starts to walk faster away from Delbert. Delbert stays up with him.

DELBERT
I should probably explain something to you.

KIRBY
I'm dreaming right? That's all it is. I just need to get some rest and everything will be just fine.

Kirby does not watch where he is going and walks out in front of a MAN riding a bicycle.

Delbert quickly dives and pushes Kirby out of the way. The Man veers off and runs into a fountain on the middle of campus.

Kirby looks up and sees Delbert smiling.

DELBERT
I'm here to help.

Kirby sits up, shakes his head, and looks back at Delbert.

KIRBY
Well...Thanks, but could you tell me one thing?

DELBERT
Sure.

KIRBY
Where in the hell did you come from?

DELBERT
Well, I can assure you that I didn't come from down there.

Delbert looks up at the sky. Kirby follows his eyes upwards.

KIRBY
You're a ghost?

DELBERT
No...Well...I guess when I appear and disappear, it does confuse things a bit...But I can assure you I'm not a ghost.

KIRBY
Then who are you?

DELBERT
(whispering)
I'm your guardian angel.

Kirby looks at Delbert confused.

KIRBY
My what?

DELBERT
Your guardian angel. My first
assignment as a matter of fact.

KIRBY
Well, if you're an angel, then where
are your wings?

DELBERT
Right here.

Delbert points to his silver wings name tag. Kirby looks at it.

DELBERT (CONT'D)
They're a lot more practical than
the older models.

KIRBY
St. Delbert.

DELBERT
At your service.

Kirby shakes his head in disbelief.

KIRBY
Okay. Well, thank you for all of
your help, but as you know, today
has been the absolute worst day of
my life. I just need to crawl into
a cave and disappear from reality
for awhile, or as the case may be,
fantasy.

Kirby walks away from Delbert. Delbert stands and scratches his head and calls out to Kirby.

DELBERT
Kirby...

Kirby continues to walk away and put his hands over his ears and hums to himself.

DELBERT (CONT'D)
This might be harder than I thought?

INT. ST. NICK'S OFFICE - SAME MOMENT

Nick looks at his computer screen and grins.

NICK
It won't be long now Del-boy. Your
wings are about to be plucked.

Nick laughs and turns off computer screen.

INT. KIRBY'S ROOM - MORNING

Kirby's RADIO ALARM CLOCK GOES OFF. He slowly opens his eyes, pinches himself, and sighs.

KIRBY
Thank God. It was all just a dream.

He sits up slowly and sees Delbert sitting on the edge of his bed.

KIRBY (CONT'D)
Ahhh!!!

Delbert falls off the bed. Kirby stands up on his bed and looks over the edge. Delbert pops up quickly.

DELBERT
Kirby...Man you scared me.

Kirby grabs his pillow and holds it up.

KIRBY
I scared you? Look, I don't know
what you want, but I'm warning you....

DELBERT
It's me Delbert. Your guardian angel.
Like I said yesterday, I'm here to
help you out.

KIRBY
Yesterday? You mean I wasn't
dreaming?

DELBERT
Unfortunately not.

Kirby hits himself with the pillow.

KIRBY
Ahhh!

DELBERT

I know this whole situation with your life seems a little out of hand right now. And most of it is my fault, but that's why I'm here, to help you straighten things out.

KIRBY

Wait a second...Most of it's your fault?

DELBERT

Well...yes and no.

Dave opens Kirby's door and sticks his head in. He sees Kirby standing on the bed holding his pillow and looking down towards Delbert, who he can't see.

DAVE

Everything okay Kirby?

Kirby looks over at Dave.

KIRBY

I'm just talking to Delbert. He's my guardian angel who screwed up my life.

Dave gives Kirby a funny look.

DELBERT

(to Kirby)

I wouldn't exactly say screwed up Kirby. It was just a little mix up.

KIRBY

A little mix up? You hear that Dave?

DAVE

Ummm...Yeah...Whatever you say Kirby. I'm just going to go back to my room now...I'll talk to you later.

Dave shakes his head and closes the door.

DELBERT

Maybe I should have told you before?

KIRBY

Told me what?

DELBERT

You're the only one that can see or hear me.

Kirby falls back onto his bed covering his head with the pillow.

KIRBY

Oh that's just perfect. He must think I'm nuts.

DELBERT

I can assure you that you're not nuts Kirby. I'm your guardian angel, I should know. I'm just here for a little while to straighten things out for you.

Kirby lifts the pillow off his head.

KIRBY

That's what you keep saying. Straighten what things out? My life is that much of a catastrophe, is it?

DELBERT

Well, not really...

KIRBY

What do you mean really?

Delbert gulps and smiles.

DELBERT

I accidentally knocked your destiny off course a little. It's not a problem though.

KIRBY

You knocked my destiny off course?

DELBERT

It's not as bad as it seems. You know that girl Julie?

KIRBY

Of course I do. She's the one from my dream.

DELBERT

She was your destiny, or should I say she still is your destiny.

KIRBY

You mean to tell me Julie was my destiny and now she's not?

DELBERT

Yes...But, don't worry about that Kirby...I know it sounds bad right now, but I'm going to help you get back on track.

KIRBY

I hope so. I knew there was something about Julie. It was the destiny, right?

DELBERT

I'm not supposed to divulge trade secrets, but yes, it was.

Kirby looks at Delbert seriously.

KIRBY

You're not going to screw up my life anymore than it is are you?

Delbert smiles and leans against the door.

DELBERT

Don't worry Kirby, everything is under control.

The door isn't shut all the way and Delbert falls down as the door opens.

EXT. OUTSIDE OF JULIE'S SORORITY HOUSE - DAY

Julie walks up the sidewalk in front of her sorority house.

She accidentally drops her books. SKIP, a fraternity-boy slick talker, is walking by at the same time.

He bends over and picks up her books for her. He grins.

SKIP

A pretty girl like yourself shouldn't be carrying these heavy books.

JULIE

I don't know what happened. I just lost my grip. Thanks.

Skip hands the books back to her. Julie smiles at Skip.

SKIP

My name's Skip.

JULIE

Julie.

SKIP

Well, it's nice to meet you Julie.
I was coming by to drop off these
invitations for the annual Sigma Chi
Halloween costume party.

He holds up a handful of invitations. He looks into Julie's eyes.

SKIP (CONT'D)

I see the Gamma Phi Sorority is
upholding its tradition of having
beautiful girls in it.

Julie blushes and smiles.

JULIE

So when is this party?

SKIP

Right after the football game Saturday
night. I hope you can make it.

JULIE

Yeah, it sounds like fun. I can
take those invitations in for you.
I'm sure all of the girls will want
to go.

SKIP

That's great. Thanks.

Skip hands Julie the invitations.

SKIP (CONT'D)

So, I'll see you Saturday then?

JULIE

I'll try to be there.

Skip smiles and walks away. Julie watches him. She takes
in a deep breath and enters the sorority.

INT. ST. NICK'S OFFICE IN HEAVEN - SAME MOMENT

Nick looks at his computer screen and watches Julie walk in
the sorority house. He smiles deviously.

INT. JULIE'S ROOM IN SORORITY HOUSE - DAY

Julie walks into her room. KAREN, Julie's stereotypical
sorority girl roommate, is looking out the window watching
Skip walk away.

KAREN

So who was that hot commodity?

Julie crosses over and looks out the window.

JULIE

Pretty cute huh?

KAREN

I'll say. So what's the story?

JULIE

He was dropping of invitations to the Sigma Chi Halloween party Saturday night.

KAREN

And?

JULIE

And what?

KAREN

What's his name?

JULIE

Skip.

KAREN

Well, if all the boys in Sigma Chi are up to Skip's standards, we'll do okay Saturday night. You did tell him we'd be there didn't you?

JULIE

You don't think I would turn him down did you?

KAREN

Well, you have been known to have your prudish moments.

JULIE

I just like to be a little more selective with the guys I date, that's all.

KAREN

Julie, if you were any more selective, the human race would become extinct before you actually went out on a date. You just need to lower your standards a little.

JULIE

My standards aren't that high Karen.
I just put studying before boys that's
all.

Julie walks into the bathroom.

KAREN

Studying? College isn't for studying
Julie, it's meant for partying with
boys like Skip. I'm dragging you to
that party Saturday night to show
you what college life is all about.

EXT. BENCH IN MIDDLE OF CAMPUS - DAY

Delbert and Kirby are sitting on a bench. Delbert types
away on his laptop.

KIRBY

What are you doing?

DELBERT

I'm just seeing when a good time to
is arrange an encounter with Julie?

KIRBY

An encounter?

DELBERT

A technical phrase us angels use to
mean point of destiny.

Dave sees Kirby sitting alone on the bench from across the
campus. He walks over to him.

KIRBY

Point of destiny?

DELBERT

It's the point when two souls are
aligned onto the same point of
destiny.

KIRBY

Oh.

DELBERT

I know it sounds confusing. Even I
don't understand how it works
sometimes.

Dave sees Kirby talking to himself.

KIRBY
So you do all of that on you're
laptop?

DELBERT
Bill Gates has nothing on heaven's
technology.

Dave reaches the bench.

DAVE
Who are you talking to Kirby?

Kirby looks up and sees Dave.

KIRBY
I'm talking to Delbert about heaven's
technology. Did you know they use
laptop's to figure out points of
destiny?

DAVE
That's nice Kirby. What do you say
you come with me over to the Psych-
building?

KIRBY
Sure.
(to Delbert)
I'm going to go over with Dave. So,
you'll let me know when the encounter
is going to take place?

DELBERT
Will do Kirby.

KIRBY
All right. I'll see you later.

Kirby stands up and walks off with Dave.

DAVE
You'll see who later Kirby?

KIRBY
My guardian angel.

Kirby smiles as Dave looks at him as though he was crazy.

EXT. FRONT OF PSYCHOLOGY BUILDING - DAY

Dave and Kirby walk up to entrance of building.

KIRBY

Why are we going to the Psych-building?

DAVE

I signed you up for a Psych-lab.

KIRBY

What for?

DAVE

Kirby, you were talking with your pillow this morning, talking to a park bench this afternoon, tonight you'll be professing intimate thoughts to a winebago. That's not normal.

KIRBY

I told you I was talking to my guardian angel.

DAVE

Your guardian angel?

KIRBY

Yeah, Delbert.

DAVE

Delbert? Why didn't I see him then?

KIRBY

That's the funny thing, only I can see him.

Dave puts out his hand and acts like he's shaking Delbert's hand.

DAVE

It's nice to meet you Delbert. How's it hanging?

KIRBY

He's not here now.

DAVE

No wonder his grip is so light.

KIRBY

He's out arranging for Julie and I to get together. She's my destiny.

DAVE

Your destiny? Now it all makes sense.

Dave grabs Kirby's arm and leads him into the building.

DAVE (CONT'D)
Let's go Kirby.

INT. PSYCHOLOGY LAB - DAY

Dave and Kirby enter the lab. SAMANTHA, a psychology major and a acquaintance of Dave's, walks up and greets them.

SAMANTHA
Hi Dave.

DAVE
Hey Samantha.

Dave points to Kirby.

DAVE (CONT'D)
This is my roommate Kirby.
(whispering)
He's the one with the problem I was
telling you about.

SAMANTHA
The one who's delusional? Hi Kirby.

KIRBY
Delusional? Whatever Dave told you
is quite exaggerated I'm sure. I'm
perfectly normal.

SAMANTHA
That's what we're here to find out?

DAVE
Don't worry Kirby. Samantha here
has a C- average in Psychology. She
knows what she's doing.

KIRBY
Wonderful.

SAMANTHA
I'm just going to run a few tests
and ask you a few questions. Is
that alright?

Kirby gives Dave a dirty look. Dave smirks.

ACROSS THE ROOM

Delbert suddenly appears. He motions for Kirby to walk over to him.

KIRBY
Umm...I'll be right back.

Kirby walks over to Delbert. Dave and Samantha look on as Kirby appears to talk to himself.

KIRBY (CONT'D)

What's up?

DELBERT

We have to go over to the library.

KIRBY

What for?

DELBERT

Julie is going to be studying at the library tonight.

KIRBY

How do you know?

DELBERT

It's part of my job to know these things Kirby. Would you stop with all the questions and just trust me?

KIRBY

Sorry, I keep forgetting your my guardian angel.

Kirby looks over and sees Samantha and Dave watching him. He turns back to Delbert.

KIRBY (CONT'D)

They think I'm delusional.

DELBERT

Why would they think that?

KIRBY

Talking to a transparent guardian angel isn't exactly what you would call normal behavior.

Delbert glances over at Dave and Samantha.

DELBERT

I'll keep that in mind for future visits. I'll meet you over at the library.

Delbert disappears. Kirby walks back over to Dave and Samantha.

KIRBY

I gotta be going.
(MORE)

KIRBY (CONT'D)

Maybe we can do this another time,
or not at all? I have to go over to
the library now. Bye.

Kirby walks out of the room. Samantha turns to Dave.

SAMANTHA

Definitely delusional. Has he always
been like this?

DAVE

He's always been off center a little,
but nothing this serious. He says
his guardian angel is trying to help
him with his destiny or something.

SAMANTHA

Very interesting. We'll have to
keep on top of this. Let's see what
he does next.

DAVE

Cool. Psychological undercover
surveillance. Maybe I should change
my major?

SAMANTHA

Dave, spending a decade in college
is not exactly the in thing.

DAVE

I always thought ten years was the
norm.

Samantha and Dave walk out of the room.

INT. LIBRARY - LATER ON THAT NIGHT

Kirby sits at a study table. Delbert walks up behind him
and taps him on the shoulder. Kirby jumps.

KIRBY

Could you not sneak up on me like
that?

DELBERT

Sorry, Kirby.

KIRBY

I thought you said Julie was supposed
to be here?

DELBERT

She will.

Delbert pulls out his laptop and puts it on the table. He turns it on and looks up Julie's file.

DELBERT (CONT'D)

She should be here at exactly 8:06 p.m., which gives us about an hour to plan our approach.

KIRBY

Plan our approach?

DELBERT

You're going to accidentally bump into her at the end of that aisle over there at precisely 8:06. We have to practice to make it look real.

KIRBY

Why can't I just sit here and wait for her to show up?

DELBERT

This will make it look like an accident. Just like the encounter I was talking about earlier. This is it Kirby. Your point of destiny.

KIRBY

Okay. You mean how it was originally supposed to have happened between us?

Delbert looks down at his laptop.

DELBERT

Something like that. So let's get to practicing.

Delbert and Kirby walk over to an aisle of books. Kirby leans on the aisle.

Samantha and Dave peer around the corner watching Kirby.

SAMANTHA

What's he doing?

DAVE

Looks like he's leaning to me?

Samantha gives Dave a blank look. Kirby grabs a book from the shelf.

KIRBY

So what should I do?

DELBERT

Pretend like your reading and walk
around the bookshelf without looking
up. I'll be Julie.

Delbert walks around the other side of the bookshelf.

KIRBY

Now?

DELBERT

On three....One...Two...Three...

Kirby walks around the corner. Delbert walks into Kirby,
but he passes through him as if he were a ghost. Kirby drops
the book in amazement.

KIRBY

What happened?

DELBERT

I forgot I'm still of heavenly matter.
Don't worry though, Julie will run
right into you.

KIRBY

Do you really think this is going to
work?

DELBERT

Sure it will Kirby. With a little
heavenly intervention, anything is
possible.

Delbert lifts up the book and hands it to Kirby.

Samantha and Dave see the book rise into the air and into
Kirby's hands.

DAVE

Did you see that?

SAMANTHA

Only if you did?

DAVE

Nah, couldn't have been?

Dave looks at Samantha. They both turn and look back at
Kirby.

SAMANTHA

Or could it?

(MORE)

SAMANTHA (CONT'D)

I've read that some people are able to tap into their power of telekinesis. Maybe Kirby has that ability?

DAVE

Tele-what?

SAMANTHA

Telekinesis. The ability to move objects with your mind.

DAVE

I don't know about that, but I do know he has an over active imagination. Speaking of over active, my stomach is working overtime. What do you say we blow this stake out and get some food?

SAMANTHA

What about Kirby?

DAVE

Don't worry about him. He'll still be talking to himself tomorrow.

SAMANTHA

You buying?

DAVE

You're not becoming delusional like Kirby now, are you?

Dave smirks at Samantha as they walk away.

KIRBY

When did you say she was going to be here?

DELBERT

Any minute now. Go stand in your spot and I'll give you the signal when I see her.

Kirby takes his position at the end of the aisle and waits for Delbert's signal. Julie walks down the aisle looking at the books. Delbert sees her and motions to Kirby.

DELBERT (CONT'D)

Here she comes. Get ready.

Kirby fumbles a little and takes a deep breath. Julie approaches the end of the aisle.

Kirby turns the corner and runs straight into Julie. Julie's books drop to the floor.

DELBERT (CONT'D)

Yes!

Kirby reaches down to pick up the books the same time as Julie and their heads bump together.

KIRBY

I'm sorry.

JULIE

That's okay.

Kirby reaches down again and picks up Julie's books. He hands them to her.

JULIE (CONT'D)

Hey, aren't you the guy?

KIRBY

Kirby, from Philosophy. I met you the other day?

JULIE

That's right, Kirby. Where did you run off to so fast?

KIRBY

Well, I had to straighten out that story in the school paper, it was all a big misunderstanding.

He glances over at Delbert who gives him a thumbs up sign.

JULIE

You mean about coming out?

KIRBY

That's the one. I wasn't really coming out like it implied.

Alexander turns the corner and sees Kirby talking to Julie.

Delbert sees Alexander walking towards Kirby.

DELBERT

Uh-oh. Kirby!

JULIE

You weren't coming out?

KIRBY

No, not in the slightest.

Kirby turns and sees Alexander approaching. Delbert hides behind a bookshelf away from Kirby's sight.

ALEXANDER

Hey man!

KIRBY

This is not happening.

JULIE

Huh?

Alexander approaches and gives Kirby a hug.

ALEXANDER

Where did you disappear to the other day man? We didn't even get your name.

Kirby looks very distraught.

KIRBY

About that? There is something...

Julie looks down at her watch.

JULIE

I'm late for my study group. I gotta go. I'll see you around Kirby.
Bye.

KIRBY

My destiny walking away.

ALEXANDER

Destiny? That's a funky name?

Kirby looks around for Delbert but doesn't see him. He begins to look a little angered.

KIRBY

Look...

ALEXANDER

Alexander.

KIRBY

Look Alexander, that whole episode
with the door was just an accident.

ALEXANDER

Everyone goes through a little denial
after letting their flower blossom.
It's okay, it's perfectly normal?

KIRBY

Kirby. My name's Kirby.

Kirby still looks for Delbert.

ALEXANDER

Well, listen Kirby I'm having a get
together later on and I was...

KIRBY

I'm sorry, but I have a meeting with
someone and I'm not sure how long
it's going to last.

Kirby starts to walk away.

ALEXANDER

That's okay.

Kirby turns back to Alexander.

KIRBY

One more thing, for future reference.
(whispering)
I'm not gay.

Kirby walks away.

ALEXANDER

Not gay? Kirby, whatever you do,
you gotta get out of denial man.
Hey Kirby.

EXT. PARK IN FRONT OF LIBRARY - NIGHT

Kirby looks around for Delbert. He shouts for Delbert.

KIRBY

Okay, Delbert! Where are you?
I've had it with you! Destiny or no
destiny, I want you out of my life.
Do you hear me?

Delbert appears behind Kirby looking completely rejected.

DELBERT

I understand how you can be upset.

Kirby turns around and faces Delbert.

KIRBY

Upset? I'm beyond upset Delbert. How could you do this to me? You screwed up my life beyond comprehension. You said you worked it all out with Julie. Well, things sure worked out all right. How could you do this to me?

DELBERT

I don't know what happened Kirby. I got the green light on your destiny button.

KIRBY

I'm glad to know my life hinges on a green button on your laptop. One that you can't even press I might add.

DELBERT

Kirby listen.

KIRBY

No, you listen Delbert. I don't want to see you ever again. From this moment on, I don't want you as my guardian angel. You're fired! Can you comprehend that?

DELBERT

Fired? I don't think you can do that Kirby. I think that's the Big Guy's decision.

KIRBY

Who in the hell is the Big Guy?

DELBERT

The man who runs the show. You know?

Delbert looks up to heaven.

KIRBY

Well, why don't you go back up there and let him run it from now on!!!

DELBERT

But, I've got it all set for Saturday night. You see Julie is going...

KIRBY

I don't want to hear it Delbert.
Just leave me alone okay. Take your
little laptop and disappear into the
heavenly cosmos where you came from.

Kirby grabs Delbert's name tag and throws it on the ground.

Kirby turns, pauses, and starts to walk away. He turns around
one more time to Delbert.

KIRBY (CONT'D)

I don't want to ever see you again.
Stay out of my life!

Kirby walks out of sight. Delbert stands looking terribly
hurt. He leans down and picks up his name tag off the ground.

DELBERT

I guess I won't be needing these
anymore.

He looks at them and puts them in his pocket. He looks up
towards the starry sky and sighs. Delbert then hangs his
head in shame.

INT. KIRBY'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

Kirby walks into the apartment. Dave and Samantha are making
out on the couch. Kirby looks over and tries to sneak by
them without them noticing him. Dave opens his eyes as Kirby
is slowly walking by them. He stops kissing Samantha.

DAVE

Kirby. We've been waiting for you.

KIRBY

So I can see.

Samantha gathers herself together.

SAMANTHA

We wanted to talk with you Kirby
about your problem.

DAVE

Yeah, we've been worried about you
Kirby. You've been acting a little
crazy these last few days.

KIRBY

Well you guys don't have to worry
about me anymore. I solved that
little problem tonight by firing my
guardian angel.

Dave and Samantha look confused.

DAVE
You did what?

KIRBY
I got rid of my guardian angel.

DAVE
Oh.

KIRBY
I feel like a new man now. You don't
have to worry about me anymore.
I'll be okay. Well, good-night.

Kirby walks into his bedroom. Dave turns to Samantha.

DAVE
What was that all about?

SAMANTHA
That's a very good sign. Kirby's
been able to differentiate between
fantasy and reality.

DAVE
I don't get it?

SAMANTHA
By firing his so called guardian
angel, he was able to rid himself of
the stress he's been under. He's
finally facing reality in other words.

DAVE
Oh. So, why don't we face reality
once again?

SAMANTHA
I think we can do that.

Dave begins to kiss Samantha.

INT. DELBERT'S OFFICE - NIGHT

Delbert sits at his desk looking very depressed. Nick
suddenly appears behind Delbert.

NICK
Don't be so hard on yourself Del-
boy.

Delbert turns around suddenly.

DELBERT
St. Nick. Where did you...How?

NICK
Tricks of the trade Delbert. It comes with experience. Speaking of experience, how did it go with Kirby?

DELBERT
Not very well. He fired me. I made a complete catastrophe of his life. I don't say I can blame him.

Nick walks over to the front of his desk.

NICK
He fired you huh? I didn't know that could be done.

DELBERT
Neither did I. Just when I thought things were about to turn around.

NICK
Things can still turn around Delbert. That's if you really want them to?

Delbert stands up quickly and walks over to Nick.

DELBERT
You mean there's still a way to help Kirby out?

NICK
There's always a way Del-boy. All you have to do is go back down to earth in human form rather than angelic.

Delbert looks confused.

DELBERT
I don't understand.

NICK
Try to help Kirby out as a human, rather than his guardian angel. Go back down let's say as a student. Your angelic powers aren't exactly up to par you know.

DELBERT
I did confuse things a little didn't I?

NICK

That you did Delbert, that you did.

DELBERT

But if I go down as a human, I can't come back up to heaven unless my human form dies?

NICK

No one said it was going to be easy Delbert. Sometimes we have to make sacrifice's for our client's. This is just one of those sacrifice's.

DELBERT

I'll be breaking all of the rules though?

Nick pats Delbert on the shoulder.

NICK

You've already broken all the rules there is to break Delbert. What's one more?

DELBERT

I guess you're right. I'll do it.

NICK

Good for you.

DELBERT

I just hope the Big Guy never finds out about this.

Nick turns the other way and smiles deviously.

NICK

Oh, he won't Delbert. He won't.

INT. COLLEGE LECTURE HALL - NEXT MORNING

Kirby walks in and sits down in the back row. He sees Julie walk in and sit down towards the front. Kirby sighs and looks down at the floor.

Delbert walks in wearing a college sweatshirt and a backpack.

He is wearing a hat and sunglasses so Kirby won't recognize him.

He walks down and sits next to Julie. Delbert begins to open up his backpack and accidentally spills his books onto the floor next to Julie.

DELBERT

I'm sorry.

JULIE

It's okay.

Julie hands Delbert the books he dropped.

DELBERT

Thank you.

JULIE

Do I know you from somewhere?

DELBERT

I don't think so.

Delbert clears his throat and begins talking in a fake Australian accent.

DELBERT (CONT'D)

I'm new to this learning institution.
Exchange student from Down Under.
They call me Delber...I mean Del.

JULIE

It's nice to meet you Del. My name's Julie.

DELBERT

G'day Julie. That's Australian for it's nice to meet you.

JULIE

It's nice to meet you too.

Delbert smiles and reaches to pull out a pen out of his backpack. He accidentally spills all of his pens onto the floor. He crawls under the seat in front of him to gather up the pens. Julie looks on amusingly.

JULIE (CONT'D)

Did you find them okay?

Delbert crawls back up into his seat grasping several pens.

DELBERT

You betcha.

Delbert puts the pens in his backpack. He then grabs a notebook from his backpack and drops it on the floor. He picks it up quickly and accidentally tears some of the pages out. Julie laughs.

EXT. GOLF COURSE IN HEAVEN - DAY

The Big Guy is looking down at his ball on the fairway. He turns to Nick who is carrying his golf bag.

BIG GUY
What do you think St. Nick?

NICK
I'd go with the 5 iron sir. The wind is blowing pretty hard.

BIG GUY
It is blowing quite a bit. Not a problem.

The Big Guy looks and sees the trees blowing in the wind. He snaps his fingers and the wind stops.

BIG GUY (CONT'D)
That's better.

NICK
I'd go with the 8 iron now sir.

Nick hands him the club. The Big Guy takes the club and hits the ball right onto the green.

NICK (CONT'D)
Excellent shot sir.

BIG GUY
Thank you St. Nick.

They begin to walk toward the green.

NICK
Sir. I don't want to be the one to tell you this, but my conscience won't let me do otherwise.

BIG GUY
What is it St. Nick?

NICK
It's about St. Delbert sir.

BIG GUY
Oh.

NICK
I told him not to do it, I even told him it was against the rules, but he still did it anyway.

BIG GUY

What did he do?

NICK

He went back to earth sir. He said he needed to go back down and help out his client personally. I promised him I wouldn't tell anyone, but I knew it was wrong. I just couldn't hold it in any longer.

Nick pretends to look sad and disturbed.

BIG GUY

It's okay St. Nick. I'm glad you came forward with this. And I thought St. Delbert was doing so well too. It's a pity.

NICK

It sure is sir. It sure is.

EXT. UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA COLLEGE CAMPUS - DAY

Julie and Delbert walk out of the lecture hall.

JULIE

So where about in Australia are you from?

DELBERT

Where am I from?

JULIE

Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide?

Delbert is desperately trying to think of a place in Australia.

DELBERT

Oh, I'm from near the outback. A small little town. You probably never heard of it. Dundee Junction.

JULIE

Dundee Junction? Like the movie Crocodile Dundee?

DELBERT

Oh yeah. It was named after the movie in fact. Quite big in Australia. The movie I mean, not Dundee Junction.

JULIE

That's funny. I've never heard of it?

DELBERT

Well, it wasn't really named until after the movie came out.

JULIE

Oh.

Julie sees Kirby walking by them about 20 yards away. Kirby is wearing his I-Pod and looking down at the ground.

JULIE (CONT'D)

Hey Kirby!

Julie waves over at him, but Kirby can't hear her and he walks away.

DELBERT

That wouldn't be Kirby Falon that you were yelling at would it?

JULIE

Yes, it was as a matter of fact. I guess he didn't hear me. Do you know him?

DELBERT

Oh yeah. Me and Kirby are good mates. We go way back.

JULIE

That's great. I was just telling Kirby the other day that it was very brave of him coming out in the paper and all. So you are his significant other?

DELBERT

Me? No, when I said mates I meant as friends.

Delbert begins to laugh.

DELBERT (CONT'D)

You thought that Kirby and I?

JULIE

But just the other day...

DELBERT

He's just has a problem expressing himself around beautiful women. You know he was even telling me the other day about a girl he just met named Julie. Wait a second, you're the Julie he was talking about.

JULIE

He mentioned me?

DELBERT

Did he mention you? Julie, he couldn't stop talking about you. Between you and me, I think that he's kind of keen on you.

JULIE

Kirby?

DELBERT

Kirby.

Skip walks by and just happens to see Julie. He walks over and interrupts Delbert and Julie.

SKIP

Julie.

Julie smiles broadly at Skip.

JULIE

Hi.

SKIP

You all ready for bash of the year Saturday night?

JULIE

I still have to get my costume. I'm really looking forward to it.

SKIP

Great.

JULIE

(Julie points to
Delbert)

Oh, this is Del. Del this is Skip.

DELBERT

Glad to meet you sport.

Delbert shakes hands with Skip.

SKIP

From the land down under I take it.

DELBERT

You got it.

SKIP

Well, I gotta get to class. I'll see you Saturday Julie.

Skip gives a fake smile to Delbert as he walks away.

DELBERT

So, you're going to a costume party with Skip Saturday night?

JULIE

I'm really not going with Skip. He invited me, actually he invited my whole sorority. His fraternity is having a Halloween costume party.

DELBERT

Sounds like a lot of fun.

JULIE

Yeah, it should be. Well, I'll see you around Del.

DELBERT

Oh, sure. See ya Julie.

Julie walks off.

DELBERT (CONT'D)

Costume party? That's it!

Delbert walks off with determination in his face.

INT. COSTUME SHOP - NIGHT

Julie walks out of the dressing room wearing a Cinderella costume. Karen looks at her and smiles broadly.

KAREN

That's the one Julie. You look like a princess.

JULIE

You don't think it's too cheesy do you?

KAREN

Not at all.

They both look into the mirror.

KAREN (CONT'D)
Just remember one thing?

JULIE
What's that?

KAREN
You have to be in before midnight so
I can have my shot at Skip.

They both laugh.

INT. OFFICE LOBBY - DAY

Ruth is busy at the reception desk. The Big Guy and Nick walk out of the elevator and up to Ruth.

BIG GUY
Good morning Ruth.

RUTH
(nervously)
Hello sir.

NICK
We're looking for Delbert, you haven't
seen him around anywhere have you?

RUTH
As a matter of fact, I haven't seen
him as of late, but I'm sure I can
locate him for you.

BIG GUY
St. Nick has informed me that St.
Delbert has gone back down to earth.
Do you know anything about this Ruth?

RUTH
I would be more than happy to page
him for you sir?

The Big Guy knows Ruth is avoiding the subject.

BIG GUY
Yes, could you do that for me please.
Let him know that I would like to
see him.

RUTH
Right away sir.

BIG GUY
Thank you Ruth.

The Big Guy and Nick walk away towards the elevator.

NICK
Sir, I think she knows exactly where
he is. She's just trying to cover
for him.

The Big Guy puts his hand on Nick's shoulder.

BIG GUY
Everything will be brought out into
the light in good time St. Nick.
Patience is a virtue.

NICK
I try to install that in all my
clients sir, but...

BIG GUY
I'm glad to hear that St. Nick.
What do you say we hit another round
of 18? After all, this is heaven,
and there's not a better place to
play golf is there?

NICK
No sir.

They both get on the elevator. Ruth immediately tries to
reach Delbert on his pager.

INT. DELBERT'S OFFICE - SAME MOMENT

Sitting on Delbert's desk is his laptop and pager. The pager
VIBRATES off the desk and falls to the floor.

INT. KIRBY'S APARTMENT - DAY

Kirby sits on the couch wearing his boxer shorts watching an
episode of the Brady Bunch on TV. He looks depressed. The
PHONE RINGS. Kirby looks over at it and lets it ring.

Dave picks it up in the other room.

A few moments later, Dave walks out of his room. He looks
at Kirby, shakes his head and turns off the TV.

KIRBY
What are you doing Dave? You can't
just shut down the Brady's like that.

DAVE

Jan can't get rid of her freckles Kirby.

KIRBY

I know, but it's fun watching her try.

DAVE

We've got more important things to do today.

KIRBY

What could be more important than the Brady's Dave?

DAVE

Getting you a life that's what. Samantha just called and said we're invited to the Sigma Chi Halloween party after the game.

KIRBY

I thought that was a private party?

DAVE

Samantha's brother's a pledge and he put us on the guest list.

KIRBY

I don't know Dave. I'm really not in the mood to go a party. Besides, I don't even have a costume.

DAVE

Kirby, this is the party of the year. There are going to be so many hot chicks that you might even get a chance to get laid. You never know, that certain person might be there.

KIRBY

Julie might be there?

DAVE

Well...

Kirby stands up quickly.

KIRBY

What are we waiting for?

DAVE

For you to put some clothes on so you can get a costume.

KIRBY

Oh, right.

Kirby runs into his bedroom.

INT. COSTUME SHOP - DAY

Dave and Kirby enter the costume shop. There aren't too many costumes left. The racks are pretty bare.

KIRBY

It doesn't look like they have much of a selection?

DAVE

Lucky for me Samantha picked up our costumes last night.

KIRBY

Oh yeah. What did she get you guys?

DAVE

Cave man outfits.

KIRBY

Well, that definitely fits.

A SALES LADY approaches.

SALES LADY

May I help you?

DAVE

Yeah my friend here is looking for a costume.

SALES LADY

I'm afraid we don't have too much of a selection left.

KIRBY

What do you have?

Sales Lady looks at Kirby measuring him with her eyes. She grabs two costumes from the rack.

SALES LADY

Well, in your size you have the choice of Cupid or Prince Charming.

She holds up the two costumes. Kirby rolls his eyes. Dave begins to laugh.

SALES LADY (CONT'D)

The Cupid costume does come with a
nerf bow and arrow set.

DAVE

What do you say Kirby?

KIRBY

I say I'm not going.

Kirby begins to walk away. Dave stops him.

DAVE

Come on Kirby. A nerf bow and arrow
set. How could you turn that down?

KIRBY

Very easily Dave.

DAVE

Okay. Okay. Then go with the Prince
Charming costume, after all it's not
that bad.

KIRBY

You're not the one who's going to be
wearing it now are you?

DAVE

Kirby, this is the party event of
the year. So you prance around in
tights for a couple of hours?
Barisnokov does it all the time.

KIRBY

He's a ballet dancer Dave. I don't
plan on performing the Nutcracker
Suite anytime soon.

DAVE

Wear a fake sword then.
(to Sales Lady)
You do have fake swords?

SALES LADY

Yes we do. However there is a \$5.00
charge. Accessories are extra.

DAVE

I'll even pay for the sword. What
do you say? Julie might be there?

Kirby ponders the thought for a moment and finally gives in.

KIRBY
I'll take the Prince Charming.

SALES LADY
Excellent choice. Earlier today a lovely young lady rented the Cinderella costume, who knows, maybe you'll run into her.

DAVE
Did you hear that Kirby? Cinderella is out there waiting for you.

Sales Lady begins to gather everything up. Dave pats Kirby on the back.

EXT. UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA FOOTBALL STADIUM - NIGHT

A big crowd is gathered to watch the Arizona Wildcats play football. Kirby and Dave walk take their seats in a very rowdy section of Students. Their seats are very close to the sidelines and the football players.

DAVE
(yelling to Kirby)
Are we going to kick some ass tonight or what?

KIRBY
Dave, we've lost 6 straight games in a row.

DAVE
So?

KIRBY
So were playing the best team in the league? They're undefeated.

The students and crowd let out a big roar as the WILDCATS run onto the field. Dave cheers extremely loud.

KIRBY (CONT'D)
Never mind.

DAVE
What?

KIRBY
I said go Wildcats!

Dave high fives Kirby and yells again.

The VISITING TEAM runs onto the field amongst a barrage of BOOS and JEERS.

At that moment, Kirby looks through his pair of binoculars and sees Julie sitting across the stadium.

DAVE

Hey Kirby, let me see the binoculars,
they're about to kick off?

Kirby keeps focused on Julie.

KIRBY

It's her Dave.

DAVE

Who?

KIRBY

Julie. Section 110 seat number 4.

DAVE

So let me see this so called girl of
destiny.

Kirby gives Dave the binoculars. Dave looks through them and looks at the wrong section. He sees an OVERWEIGHT GIRL with braces.

DAVE (CONT'D)

She's the girl of your dreams? No
offense Kirby, but I think you need
to dream another dream.

KIRBY

What?

DAVE

Don't worry. There's going to be
lot's of primo chicks at the party
tonight.

Dave moves the binoculars to the game.

DAVE (CONT'D)

What happened? They scored on the
kick off already?

Kirby looks up and sees the Football player from the Coming Out Day standing on the bench. He winks and blows a kiss at Kirby.

KIRBY

It's going to be a long night.

Kirby turns away quickly.

EXT. FRONT OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE - LATER THAT NIGHT

Dave, Samantha, and Kirby approach the fraternity house wearing their costumes. Dave and Samantha are both wearing their caveman outfits. Dave carries a big plastic cave man club. Samantha wears a dinosaur bone in her hair.

Kirby looks very uncomfortable in his Prince Charming costume. He wears a funky looking hat with a mask covering his eyes and has a plastic sword strapped to his side.

DAVE

Is this going to be great or what?

SAMANTHA

I like your costume Kirby. You make a great umm....

KIRBY

Ballet dancer?

SAMANTHA

Yeah, like in the Nutcracker Suite.

Kirby looks over at Dave.

DAVE

He's not a ballet dancer Samantha.
Take a look at the sword. Show her
the sword Kirby.

Kirby reluctantly pulls out the plastic sword. Samantha looks at Kirby up and down.

SAMANTHA

Romeo, from Romeo and Juliet?

DAVE

He's Prince Charming.

SAMANTHA

Oh, okay. Now I get it.

Dave talks to Kirby in a Caveman voice.

DAVE

Woman not too bright, but she sure
got great body.

Samantha takes fake club out of Dave's hand and hits him on the head with it. She turns and starts walking.

DAVE (CONT'D)

Ow...I was just joking Samantha.

Dave quickly follows her. Kirby sighs.

KIRBY
(to himself)
Romeo? Maybe I should have picked
the cupid costume?

Kirby follows them from behind.

INT. JULIE'S ROOM IN SORORITY HOUSE - SAME

Karen is walking back and forth impatiently. She is dressed up like El-Vira: Mistress of the dark. She looks at her watch.

KAREN
Come on Julie. Being fashionably
late doesn't mean arriving when the
party is over.

Julie walks out of the bathroom wearing a Cinderella costume.

JULIE
Do you think I look okay?

KAREN
Julie, Cinderella doesn't have a
thing on you, trust me. Can we go
already?

Karen grabs Julie's arm and leads her out the door.

INT. INSIDE OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE - NIGHT

Dave, Samantha, and Kirby enter the house. It is decorated with cobwebs and various Halloween paraphernalia. The place is jam packed with costumed college students. LOUD MUSIC blares throughout the house.

CHAD, Samantha's brother, sees Samantha from across the room.

He runs over to her. His face look's like it's half eaten off with worms hanging out of his cheeks.

CHAD
Boo!

Samantha turns around and hugs him.

SAMANTHA
Hey Chad. Looking good bro.

CHAD
That's what happens when you get
enough beauty sleep.

SAMANTHA

I'd like you to meet Dave and Kirby.

Chad shakes their hands.

CHAD

So which one is banging my sister?

SAMANTHA

Chad?

CHAD

Just joking.

(to Kirby)

Hey, I like your costume. Romeo right?

Dave and Samantha laugh.

KIRBY

Prince charming actually.

Chad puts his arm around Samantha.

CHAD

Everyone says we look alike. I think I'm the better looking one of us both.

DAVE

I can see a family resemblance.

Samantha gives Dave a dirty look.

DAVE (CONT'D)

I know. I know.

Dave takes his club and hits himself on the top of head.

SAMANTHA

Good cave man.

CHAD

So you guys want something to drink?

DAVE

Sure.

CHAD

Follow me to the dungeon.

Chad leads Samantha, Dave, and Kirby down into the basement.

EXT. FRONT OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE - NIGHT

Julie and Karen are standing in line with several girls waiting to get in.

KAREN

(to Julie)

Do my fake boobs look real enough?

Karen points at her open cut dress which reveals a lot of cleavage.

JULIE

I guess so.

KAREN

You guess so?

JULIE

Karen, I know you went from a size A to a size double D in matter of seconds. That being the case, I'm really not the person to be asking.

KAREN

Then how can I find out?

They reach the front door. JAKE, a fraternity guy dressed as Dracula, stands at the doorway with a guest list in his hand. Next to him is ARNIE, dressed up like Frankenstein, acting as a bouncer.

JAKE

(Gawking at Karen's
fake chest)

Welcome to our humble little abode
ladies.

Arnie also stares.

ARNIE

(roaring in a monstrous
way)

Welcome.

JAKE

El-Vira and Cinderella, what lovely
costumes, aren't they Arnie?

ARNIE

(roaring again)

Yes.

JAKE

Please enter.

(to Karen)

And may I say you look ravishing
enough to bite.

KAREN

That can be arranged...Maybe.

Jake and Arnie continue to stare as Karen and Julie enter
the fraternity house.

INT. INSIDE OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE - SAME

Julie and Karen walk inside. Julie and Karen are both
laughing.

JULIE

Karen?

KAREN

Julie.

JULIE

I can't believe you said that?

She fluffs up her fake boobs.

KAREN

I guess they passed the test.

EXT. FRONT OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE- NIGHT

Delbert walks up to the front door. He is wearing a pink
cupid costume and an eye mask. He holds a nerf bow and arrow
in one hand. Arnie holds out his hand blocking Delbert from
entering. Jake looks at guest list.

JAKE

Where do you think you're going?

DELBERT

To the party mate.

JAKE

Not unless you're on the list mate.
What's your name?

Delbert holds up bow and arrow.

DELBERT

Cupid.

JAKE

You're real name?

DELBERT
Oh. It's Del.

JAKE
Del what?

DELBERT
Oh, like in last name? It's Angel,
Del Angel.

Jake looks at guest list again.

JAKE
Sorry, there's no Del Angel on the
list. No name, no entrance, no party.

DELBERT
I don't think you understand. I
need to get into the party. I have
to make a love connection.

JAKE
You have to make a love connection?
Don't we all?
(he laughs)
You're not going to make it here.
Now get lost before I have Arnie
deal with you.

Arnie wraps his fist around Delbert's collar.

ARNIE
Yeah.

Arnie grabs Delbert's bow and arrow and throws it out into
the front lawn. He then pushes Delbert. Delbert falls to
the ground. Jake and Arnie laugh.

Delbert gets up and wipes himself off. He picks up the bow
and arrow and slowly walks out to the street. He suddenly
gets a brilliant idea.

He runs down the side of the fraternity house to the back.

INT. INSIDE OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE - NIGHT

Skip walks down the stairway wearing a devil costume. He
carries a red plastic pitchfork in one hand. He sees Julie
standing talking to Karen.

SKIP
Julie!

Julie looks up and sees Skip sliding down the stairway
banister on his butt. He lands right in front of Julie.

JULIE
Speak of the devil?

SKIP
Glad to see you made it.

JULIE
Skip, this is my roommate Karen.

Julie points over to Karen. Skip looks directly at Karen's fake boobs.

SKIP
El-Vira. Like the costume.

Skip looks back over at Julie.

SKIP (CONT'D)
A princess right?

JULIE
Cinderella actually.

SKIP
That's what I meant. So what do you say we get some drinks?

KAREN
Sounds good.

SKIP
Follow me.

Skip leads Julie and Karen to the basement.

EXT. BACK ALLEYWAY OF FRATERNITY HOUSE- NIGHT

Delbert looks up at a ten foot wall trying to figure out how he is going to get over it. He first tries to climb it like a rock climber. He gets about halfway up it and then falls to the ground.

DELBERT
Come on Delbert, think.

He looks over and sees a big tree next to the wall. A smile comes to his face. He looks up toward heaven.

DELBERT (CONT'D)
Where there's a will, there's a way.

Delbert gets off the ground and quickly heads for the tree.

He starts to climb it without much grace. He gets high enough to see over into the back courtyard of the fraternity.

He sees a branch that leans over the fence.

He starts to crawl out onto the branch and hears a CRACKING SOUND.

DELBERT (CONT'D)

Uh-oh.

The tree branch breaks and Delbert falls to the ground in the courtyard of the fraternity house.

INT. BASEMENT OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE - NIGHT

The basement is packed with costumed students partying. It looks like an medieval castle dungeon. MUSIC BLARES. A coffin is filled with a mixture of alcohol and punch.

Dave and Samantha are dancing in the corner of the room with a group of PARTIER'S. Kirby stands alone next to the coffin filling up his cup.

Julie, Skip, and Karen walk down the stairs into the basement. They walk over to the coffin.

Kirby turns and walks the other way just as they approach the coffin.

SKIP

(to Julie)

Do you like jungle juice?

JULIE

What's in it?

SKIP

What's not in it...You'll love it.
Trust me.

Skip pours two cups, one for Julie and the other for Karen.

They each take a sip. Julie gasps as Karen slams the whole thing.

JULIE

It's strong.

KAREN

I think it's tasty.

Kirby walks over to where Dave and Samantha are.

KIRBY

(to Dave)

I'm going to take a look around.

The MUSIC drowns Kirby out.

DAVE

What?

KIRBY

(yelling)

I said I'm going to take a look
around.

DAVE

Okay.

Dave and Samantha continue dancing as Kirby walks back up
the stairs.

EXT. COURTYARD OF FRATERNITY HOUSE - NIGHT

Delbert gets up off the ground and dusts himself off. He
picks up his nerf bow and arrow and heads towards the
fraternity house. He heads for the back door.

INT. INSIDE OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE - SAME

Kirby comes up from the basement. He looks around and sees
the door leading to the courtyard. He decides to see what's
out back. He reaches for the door knob the SAME TIME Delbert
does and opens the door quickly.

Delbert flies into the fraternity house and across the room.

He hits a wall and falls down. Kirby immediately runs over
to him.

KIRBY

You all right?

Delbert shakes his head. He looks up at Kirby.

DELBERT

No problems mate.

Kirby lends his hand to help Delbert up. Delbert gets up
slowly.

KIRBY

Sorry about that. I didn't know you
were coming through.

DELBERT

No worries.

Kirby looks at Delbert as if he knows him from somewhere.
Kirby can't place him because Delbert is wearing an eye mask.

KIRBY

Do I know you from somewhere?

Delbert doesn't want Kirby to figure out who he is so he fumbles for an answer.

DELBERT

Mum, I don't think so. Wait a second, are you in Philosophy 401?

KIRBY

Yeah.

DELBERT

Me too. That's probably where you've seen me. I sometimes sit next to Julie Monroe.

KIRBY

You know Julie?

DELBERT

Oh yeah. She's a good friend of mine.

KIRBY

Do you know if she's coming here tonight?

Delbert looks at Kirby's costume.

DELBERT

That's a great costume. Prince Charming, right?

KIRBY

Right.

DELBERT

That is such a coincidence, because Julie is wearing a Cinderella costume.

KIRBY

She is? Hey, do you think you could put in the good word for me if you see her?

DELBERT

Oh sure mate. No problem.

KIRBY

How did you know my name?

DELBERT

You're name? Um...

At that moment, Jake and Arnie walk into the house. They see Delbert from across the room. Jake points over at Delbert.

JAKE

Hey! How did you get in here?

Jake and Arnie start to head quickly towards Delbert.

Delbert quickly runs up the staircase to the second floor.

Jake and Arnie stop to question Kirby.

JAKE (CONT'D)

Do you know that guy?

KIRBY

Not really. Should I?

ARNIE

Not unless you like getting you're
ass kicked.

Jake and Arnie go up the stairway. Kirby thinks a moment.

KIRBY

Nah, couldn't be?

INT. HALLWAY UPSTAIRS - SAME

Delbert quickly looks for a place to hide. He tries to open several doors, but they are locked. He then finds an open door and quickly ducks inside.

INT. BATHROOM - SAME

Delbert locks the door behind him. He turns around and sees a DRUNK SORORITY GIRL, who happens to be wearing a angel costume with big wings, trying to fix her halo.

DELBERT

Sorry. I didn't know you were in
here.

DRUNK SORORITY GIRL

Hey, could you help me with this
thing?

She points to her halo.

DELBERT

Yeah, sure. You know angels really
don't wear halo's.

Delbert helps her straighten the halo out.

DRUNK SORORITY GIRL
They don't. How would you know?

DELBERT
Oh, I've met one before.

DRUNK SORORITY GIRL
Like did you have one of those near death experiences?

DELBERT
Sort of.

DRUNK SORORITY GIRL
Wow. Hey, you're supposed to be that cupid guy aren't you?

DELBERT
Yes. Do you like the costume?

DRUNK SORORITY GIRL
I love it.

DELBERT
You do?

Delbert's eyes light up.

INT. HALLWAY UPSTAIRS - MINUTES LATER

Jake and Arnie are walking at the far end of the hallway.

Delbert sticks his head out of the bathroom. He has the halo on his head.

He sees Jake and Arnie's backs. He quickly walks out of the bathroom wearing the Angel costume.

Jake and Arnie turn around and see Delbert walking away. All they see is big angel wings on the back of Delbert. They shrug their shoulders and turn back around.

At the SAME MOMENT Skip and Julie pass Delbert in the hallway.

JULIE
I should really be trying to find Karen.

SKIP
She said she'd meet us in my room.

JULIE
(reluctantly)
Okay.

SKIP
All right then.

Skip takes out his key to his room and begins to open the door. Skip is about to lead Julie into his room until Delbert interrupts Skip's devious plans.

DELBERT
Hey Julie. I thought that was you.

Julie turns and sees Delbert.

JULIE
Del?

DELBERT
It's me all right. Quite a party
heh?

JULIE
Yes, it is. Skip was just going to
show me his room.

DELBERT
That's fantastic. You mind if I
take a gander at it?

Delbert intrudes on Skip's plans by walking into his room.

Julie follows him. Skip rolls his eyes and then enters the room.

INT. SKIP'S ROOM - SAME

Skip enters the room. Delbert stands next to Julie as they enter. The door remains wide open.

DELBERT
Nice little pad you got yourself
here.

Skip is annoyed at Delbert.

SKIP
Thanks. Ummmm...

DELBERT
Del.

SKIP
Yeah, whatever.

Skip puts his arm on Delbert.

SKIP (CONT'D)
Sorry you have to go Del.

DELBERT
Go?
(to Julie continuing)
Oh yeah...Julie, did you happen to
see Kirby downstairs? He was looking
for you.

JULIE
Kirby was looking for me? What did
he want?

DELBERT
He didn't say exactly. But, it
sounded kind of important.

JULIE
I should probably see if I can find
him. Thanks Del.

Delbert smiles at Julie as she walks out of the room.

SKIP
I'm sure it's not that important
Julie?

DELBERT
Nice room mate.

As Delbert begins to back out the door, Jake and Arnie enter.

They stand on both sides of him.

Delbert gulps.

Jake and Arnie don't look at Delbert right away.

JAKE
Skip, have you seen a guy dressed up
like Cupid?

SKIP
Cupid?

ARNIE
He's wearing a pink outfit and is
carrying this nerf bow. He snuck
into the party.

DELBERT
The nerve of some people.

Jake and Arnie both look at him.

JAKE

It's him!

Jake and Arnie both try to grab him, but Delbert ducks underneath their grasp and backs out of the doorway. Jake and Arnie grab each other by mistake. They instantly let go of each other.

SKIP

Let's get him!

Skip, Jake, and Arnie all run out the door at the same time and get stuck in the door jam.

INT. STAIRWELL - SAME

Delbert is at the top of the stairwell. He looks back and sees Skip, Jake, and Arnie run out of Skip's room. He looks at the banister and slides down it. Julie is halfway down the stairs walking down with one of her hands on the banister.

DELBERT

Look out below!

Julie looks up and sees Delbert sliding down the banister.

She moves out of the way as Delbert slides right by her.

JULIE

Watch out Del!

He reaches the end of the banister and flies out the front door.

Kirby happens to be standing underneath the stairwell. Dave and Samantha are standing next to him. He sees Delbert fly out the door.

DAVE

Was that an angel?

KIRBY

That's what it looked like.

At that same moment, Skip, Jake, and Arnie barrel past Julie accidentally knocking her over the banister.

DELBERT (O.S.)

Look up Kirby!

As if in slow motion, Kirby looks upward at that instant and sees Julie. He throws out his arms to catch her and they both fall towards the ground. Kirby holds onto Julie.

KIRBY

Are you okay?

Julie looks over at Kirby. She doesn't recognize him because he is wearing his eye mask.

JULIE

I am now.

They both stare into each other's eyes.

EXT. FRONT OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE - NIGHT

Delbert lies on the ground.

DELBERT

Finally.

Delbert smiles proudly and slowly gets up off the ground. He begins to wipe himself off but his hands go right through his body like he is a ghost or of heavenly matter.

The Big Guy and Nick stand behind him.

BIG GUY

I think it's time we had a little
talk St. Delbert?

Delbert turns and sees the Big Guy not with a serious look on his face. Nick is smiling very deviously.

NICK

What are you doing down here Delbert?

BIG GUY

That is what I would like to know?

DELBERT

(to Nick)

But, you're the one who told me...

NICK

As you can see sir, St. Delbert has
completely gone off the deep end.

BIG GUY

Yes, I can see that. You have a lot
of explaining to do St. Delbert.

DELBERT

Sir, if you would...

BIG GUY

I'm very disappointed in you St.
Delbert. I'm afraid you are going
to lose your wings for this. It's
time to go.

Delbert looks absolutely crushed. The Big Guy snaps his
fingers and all three of them disappear with a flash of light.

The Angel Halo from the costume lies on the ground.

INT. INSIDE OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE - SAME

Skip, Jake, and Arnie, stop at the bottom of the stairs.

Kirby helps Julie up.

SKIP

I'm sorry Julie. We didn't mean to
knock you over like that.

JULIE

It's okay. If it wasn't for...

KIRBY

Kirby.

Kirby lifts up his mask. Julie smiles.

JULIE

Kirby?

KIRBY

I guess I was at the right place at
the right time for once?

JULIE

Thanks Kirby.

Julie looks deeply into Kirby's eyes and kisses him. Skip
shakes his head.

SKIP

(to Jake and Arnie)

Let's go find that angel.

Skip, Jake, and Arnie run out the front door. Julie and
Kirby stop kissing. Kirby helps Julie up off the ground.

Julie looks at Kirby's costume.

JULIE

Prince Charming.

KIRBY
Yeah, how did you know?

JULIE
The sword gave you away.

They all laugh.

DAVE
Didn't I tell you the sword made the
costume?

Julie suddenly remembers that Skip, Jake, and Arnie are going
after Delbert.

JULIE
Oh my gosh! Del.

KIRBY
Who's Del?

JULIE
The angel that flew out the door.

KIRBY
Angel? Del...Delbert!

JULIE
We better see if he's all right.

KIRBY
Let's go.

Kirby take Julie by the hand and leads her out the front
door. Dave and Samantha follow.

EXT. FRONT OF SIGMA CHI FRATERNITY HOUSE - NIGHT

Skip, Jake, and Arnie are walking back up the front entrance
as Kirby, Julie, Dave, and Samantha come out through the
door.

KIRBY
Did you see him?

SKIP
He's gone.

JAKE
Lucky for him. We we're going pluck
his wings.

ARNIE
Yeah, and then stick them back up
his ass.

KIRBY
That wouldn't have been to smart?

SKIP
Why's that?

KIRBY
Because if you did, I'd have to do
the same to you.

SKIP
What?

KIRBY
That angel you were chasing was my...

DAVE
Guardian angel!

Kirby looks over at Dave and smiles.

DAVE (CONT'D)
You never know?
(whispering to Samantha)
It's good for his confidence.

Skip moves closer to Kirby. Jake and Arnie stand right behind Skip just like three bowling pins.

JULIE
Come on guys.

SKIP
Stay out of this Julie!

KIRBY
Don't talk to her that way!

SKIP
I'll talk to her anyway I want boy
wonder.

Skip, Jake, and Arnie laugh.

SKIP (CONT'D)
What are you going to do? Attack me
with your sword?

Skip grabs the sword and breaks it in half.

SKIP (CONT'D)
Now what are you going to do?

Kirby punches Skip in the face. Skip falls backwards knocking Jake and Arnie to the ground with him.

All three of them are out cold.

DAVE
Nice shot Kirby!

Kirby turns to Julie.

KIRBY
Sorry about that Julie. I just didn't
like him talking to you that way.

JULIE
Thanks again.

Kirby and Julie kiss once again.

DAVE
Enough with the kissing already.

SAMANTHA
Dave!

Kirby and Julie enjoy the moment.

KIRBY
Dave, I would like you to meet Julie
Monroe. Julie this is my roommate
Dave.

DAVE
This is the girl you've been rambling
about all this time.

KIRBY
This is Julie.

DAVE
Can I say you look a lot better in
person than through binoculars?

JULIE
Thank you, I guess.

Samantha hits Dave with the fake cave-man club.

DAVE
What? What did I say?

SAMANTHA
You have to excuse him. He's still
in the Neanderthal age.

Samantha leads Dave out towards the street. Kirby takes
Julie's arm.

KIRBY

Would you like to get something to eat?

JULIE

I'd like that. I wonder what happened to Del?

KIRBY

Del? Yeah, I'm sure he's around somewhere.

JULIE

You know he told me all about you. He explained all about the misunderstanding.

KIRBY

He did?

JULIE

He even said you were keen on me.

KIRBY

I'll have to thank him for putting in the good word than.

They start walking toward the street. Kirby looks down and sees the halo Delbert was wearing lying on the ground.

KIRBY (CONT'D)

Hey look. Delbert's halo.

JULIE

It must have fallen off.

KIRBY

Um, Yeah. I'll give it back to him next time I see him.

Kirby looks up at the starry night sky and smiles. He mouths the words.

KIRBY (CONT'D)

Thank you.

As quickly as Kirby mouths the words, he soon forgets everything that has happened to him concerning Delbert. He shakes his head. The same goes for Julie's memory about Del.

Kirby looks over at Julie and smiles. Kirby and Julie walk down the sidewalk holding hands underneath the full moon light.

INT. BIG GUY'S OFFICE - DAY

The Big Guy sits at his desk. Delbert sits sluggishly in a chair in front of him.

BIG GUY

I'm sorry St. Delbert, but going to earth is the one rule that angels cannot break. You knew it was against the rules didn't you?

DELBERT

Yes sir.

BIG GUY

Than why did you do it St. Delbert?

DELBERT

Things with Kirby had gotten out of control and I was just trying to fix them before you found out sir.

BIG GUY

You should have come to me and talked about it. You know I am always here for help if you need it.

DELBERT

I know sir. It's just that I didn't want to disappoint you.

BIG GUY

I'm afraid you already have St. Delbert. I have no other choice but to take your wings from you.

Delbert stands up and removes the silver wings from his chest. He slowly hands them over to the Big Guy.

DELBERT

I'm sorry sir.

BIG GUY

You be assigned a new job duty tomorrow morning. I'd like for you to clear out your office as soon as you can.

DELBERT

What's going to happen to Kirby sir?

BIG GUY

I'll be handling him beginning tomorrow morning St. Delbert.

DELBERT
Does that mean you?

BIG GUY
I'm sorry but I had to take any memory
or recollection he had of you away.
Guardian angels can only work under
complete anonymity, otherwise things
can completely get out of control.
As we have found out.

DELBERT
Yes sir.

Delbert turns and begins to walk out of the office. Before
he reaches the door he turns one more time.

DELBERT (CONT'D)
For whatever it's worth sir, I'm
truly sorry. I was just trying to
do my best.

Delbert walks out of the door. The Big Guy has a look of
dejection on his face as well.

INT. DELBERT'S OFFICE - DAY

Delbert stops clearing his things off his desk and sits down.
He opens up his laptop and turns it on.

ON LAPTOP SCREEN we see Kirby and Julie walking on campus
holding hands. Delbert gives a half smile.

A KNOCK is heard on the door.

DELBERT
It's open.

Ruth walks in.

RUTH
I just heard Delbert. I'm so sorry.

DELBERT
It's okay Ruth. It's not your fault.

RUTH
I tried to page you when you were
down on earth.

DELBERT
I forgot to take my pager with me.
Thank you for trying.

Ruth walks over behind Delbert and looks at the LAPTOP SCREEN.

RUTH

I think you made a pretty good guardian angel Delbert. I'm sure Kirby would agree with me.

DELBERT

At least I was able to get them together?

RUTH

That you were Delbert. I'd say they're heavenly blessed now.

DELBERT

You really think so?

RUTH

I know so. I'm going to miss working with you Delbert.

Delbert stands up.

DELBERT

I'm going to miss you too Ruth. Thanks again.

Delbert hugs Ruth. A tear trickles down Ruth's cheek. They finish hugging and Ruth begins to exit.

RUTH

Let me know if you ever need anything?

DELBERT

I will Ruth. I will.

Ruth walks out the door. Delbert turns and walks over and looks out the window. Nick walks in the door.

NICK

I'd thought you'd be gone by now?

Delbert turns around.

DELBERT

I was just getting my things together. How come you didn't keep your word St. Nick?

NICK

My word? My word on what?

DELBERT

You promised me that you wouldn't tell the Big Guy.

NICK

I said that?

DELBERT

You said you wouldn't tell a soul about me going back down to earth.

NICK

I guess I must have forgotten. Besides Del-boy, you were able to miraculously work things out for Kirby, throughout all of the untimely misfortunes.

DELBERT

What do you mean?

Nick walks over and sits in Delbert's chair at his desk. He props his feet up on the desk.

NICK

I think I like this office. I might move my stuff in here.

DELBERT

What misfortunes are you talking about St. Nick?

NICK

Great views too. Let's just say they could have been avoided with a laptop that actually worked.

Nick taps on the laptop's destiny button.

NICK (CONT'D)

You know Delbert, all it takes is a little know how and a little ingenuity and wa-la...No destiny.

DELBERT

You made it so my destiny button wouldn't work?

NICK

Man, you catch on quickly.

DELBERT

I'm going to let the Big Guy know about this St. Nick. You're not going to get away with this.

Delbert starts to walk out the door.

NICK

You think he's going to believe you Delbert? Everyone's seen you drop that thing a hundred times. Even the Big Guy knows how much of a klutz you really are. Besides, if you do, I'll make sure Kirby's life is a living hell.

Delbert begins to open up the door when all of the sudden it opens up suddenly from the outside. Delbert flies across the room and hits the wall. The Big Guy enters with Ruth.

BIG GUY

I don't think that's going to happen anytime to soon St. Nick.

Nick suddenly stands up.

NICK

Sir!

Ruth runs over and helps Delbert up from off the floor.

BIG GUY

Are you okay St. Delbert?

DELBERT

Yes sir.

NICK

Sir, I was just saying...

BIG GUY

I know all about what you were just saying Nick.

NICK

St. Nick sir.

BIG GUY

Not anymore.

The Big Guy walks over and takes Nick's wings off his chest.

BIG GUY (CONT'D)

You won't be needing these where you're going.

NICK

But how did you find out?

The Big Guy smiles.

BIG GUY
A little help from St. Ruth. Plus,
it helps out that I'm the knower of
all things Nick.

Nick stands motionless.

BIG GUY (CONT'D)
Now get to my office before I lose
my temper. You know what can happen
when I lose my temper?

NICK
Yes sir. Right away.

Nick runs out of the office.

BIG GUY
You flood the earth one time and you
get a reputation for a bad temper?

The Big Guy shrugs his shoulders and walks over to Delbert.

The Big Guy pulls out Delbert's angel wings and hands it to
Delbert. They are made of gold.

BIG GUY (CONT'D)
I believe these are yours Delbert.

Delbert takes the golden wings from the Big Guy's hand.

DELBERT
You mean?

BIG GUY
You've earned these St. Delbert.

The Big Guy pats Delbert on the shoulder. Delbert smiles
proudly and pins the wings back on his chest.

DELBERT
Thank you sir. I won't let you down.

BIG GUY
Keep up the good work St. Delbert.
Kirby's depending on you.

DELBERT
Kirby sir?

BIG GUY
He is your client, isn't he?

DELBERT
Yes sir.

The Big Guy smiles and walks towards the door.

BIG GUY
I'll see you tomorrow at the board
meeting St. Delbert.

DELBERT
I'll be there right on time sir.

BIG GUY
I bet you will.

The Big Guy chuckles and walks out of the office. Delbert
turns to Ruth and smiles.

DELBERT
I guess I'm not going to leave after
all Ruth.

Ruth straightens Delbert's wings.

RUTH
Not for a long while.

They hug each other.

DISSOLVE TO:

INT. HOSPITAL ROOM - DAY

5 YEARS LATER appears on screen.

Kirby sits next to a hospital bed where Julie lies holding a
brand new BABY BOY. Kirby rubs his hand across the baby's
head and smiles at Julie

KIRBY
What do you think we should name
him?

JULIE
For some strange reason, I like the
name Del.

KIRBY
Yeah, so do I. It has a nice ring
to it.
(to baby)
Del. How do you like that name
partner?

CLOSE UP ON BABY seeming to smile.

Delbert stands watching them in the corner of the room.

Kirby and Julie can't see him.

Delbert smiles proudly. He then leans against the door.

A NURSE pushes it open and in turn pushes Delbert across the room.

He runs into a desk with a stack of greeting cards on top of it. The greeting cards all blow off like from a strong breeze.

Kirby and Julie both look. The Nurse looks over as the cards magically place themselves back on the desk.

NURSE

Now how did that happen?

Kirby and Julie look at each other a little confused and then slowly they both smile.

Delbert smiles broadly, looks at camera, and shrugs his shoulders.

FADE OUT:
