Beginning her professional career as a performance artist and dancer with her mentor Dianne McIntyre, she performed with the Bill T. She was a founding member of Richard Gonzalez's Afro Cuban Dance Ensemble and as a recipient of multiple grants, her original performance dance/art works toured the U.S. and Canada and were reviewed nationally.
