Mr. Ginn is a well-respected Actor, Musician, Businessman, Investigative Reporter and Editor, Black Historian, Adjunct Professor, Author and Public Servant with a major emphasis on Mentoring Youth with his Executive Director Position for Al Davies Boys and Girls Club.

He has mentored many of his Club Kids who are Pro Athletes in the NBA, NFL and Olympic Boxers! A Gang Counselor! Many are College Coaches, Non-Profit Executive Directors, Teachers, Lawyers, Small Business Owners and Military Service Men and Women!

Raised by his Grandfather, World Renown, Ragtime Composer Joe Jordan, he grew up immersed in Music, Theater, and all genres of arts from a young age. His first play at the age of nine was Finian's Rainbow as Henry! The Director, Thor Nielson-the Faculty, changed the role from Henrietta to Henry to play the part. He believes that art is timeless and ageless, and has spent his life creating art of all forms from Music, Plays, Acting, Acting Teacher/Coach, Vocal Coach and VO Teacher! His Uncle Lowell Jordan (2nd. Lt.-Tuskegee Airman) who also wrote for Sam Cooke and Lou Rawls.

To receive his College Education, attending Central Washington University in Ellensburg, WA., as a Scholar-Athlete, graduating in 1972 with a Bachelor's degree in Psychology. During the 1969/1970 school year, he was a Varsity Basketball Player with 31 wins and two losses, 2nd in the Nation (NAIA), and inducted into the CWU Basketball Hall of Fame in February 1996 and VP of the Student Government Association responsible for Big Name Concerts and Festivals while also the Manager, Booker, Lead Vocalist for his 10 piece band! He additionally attended Estelle Harmon Workshop, sponsored by Bill Bixby, from 1977 to 1979, achieving a Master's degree in Drama and Dramatics/Theatre Arts. He became a Member of the Screen Actors Guild in 1978 being cast in a Busch Beer Commercial! His Actor training was as an Actor in Master Thesis Films at AFI, USC and UCLA.

Mr. Ginn worked as an executive for about 30 years, his day job, but always concentrated on his art simultaneously. He has acted and written lyrics and scripts and short stories throughout his whole life. He has worked as an artist's and musician's representative, an International Associate for Isagenix in 22 Countries and currently teaches Acting and Filmmaking, as well as, the Business of Acting and the Psychology of the Actor, as an Adjunct Professor with an MFA for his South Sound Actor's and Young Filmmakers Workshop, and much much more.

He remains politically active, is involved with his Church Allen A.M.E where he was Baptized, a Member of Young Life and mentored by Gordon McClain-YFC and is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, the Tacoma Urban League to advocate for Civil Rights from the City, State and to the US Government!

Mr. Ginn is additionally a descendant of the Buffalo Soldiers; Black Collective; Tacoma Urban League; American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers; and Central Washington University Foundation and the Tacoma Rotary!

In his current role, he is the CEO and Founder of Amalgamated Cinema and Entertainment. He is deeply involved in a project about Robert Johnson, a musician of the Great Depression era. He will be creating a two-volume CD set, which he expects millions of blues fans Globally will enjoy very much. A tireless creative, Mr. Ginn is always pitching film projects for short films, indie films, sci-fi films, documentaries, compelling stories and more. He aspires to create union jobs and be the first Black Sag/Aftra Union President. Indicative of his strong work ethic, he says, "There is no ageism in the acting field - it's bop til you drop!" and never give up!
